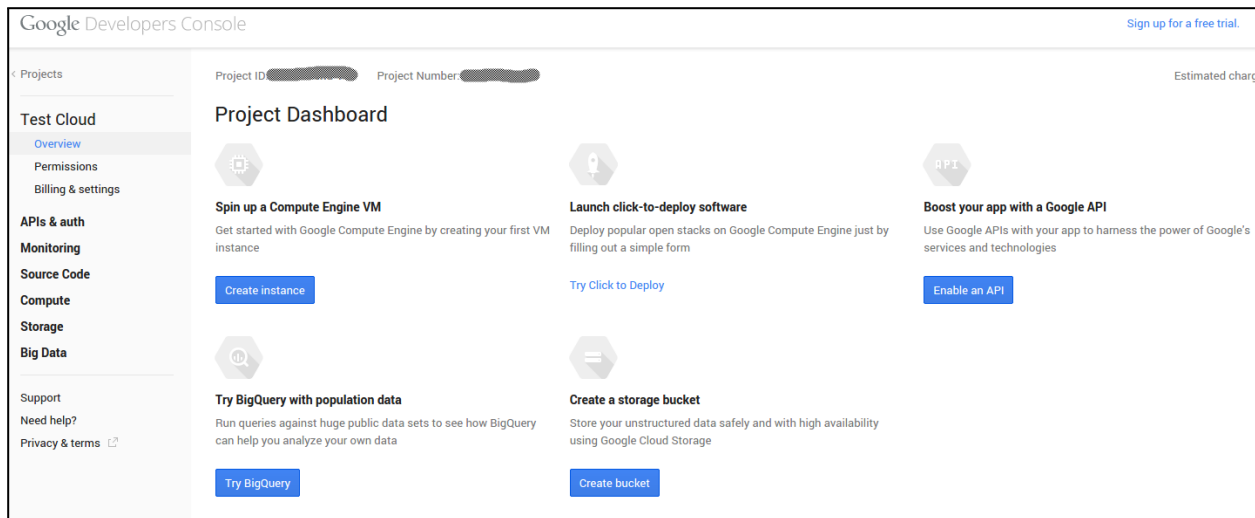
Your Developers Console will look something like below (if you are new to Google Cloud)



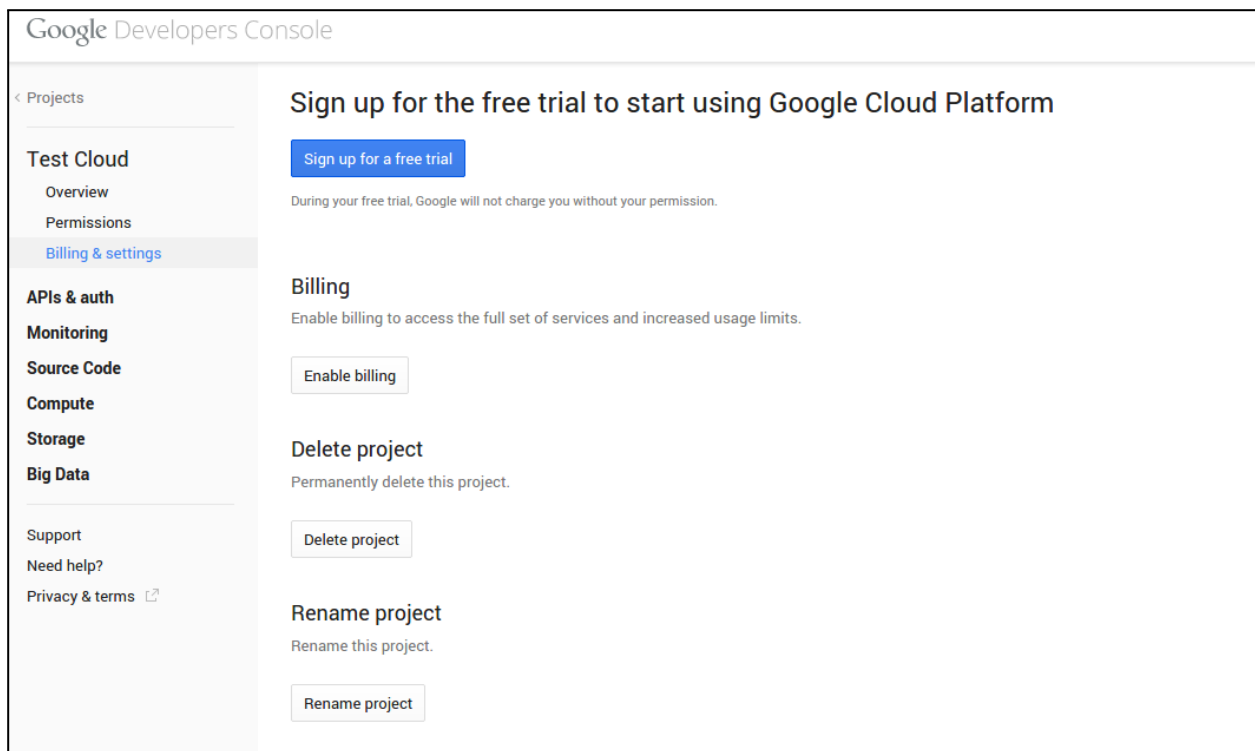
Click on “Create Project” and give any name. You can leave the project ID to whatever shows up (you can change it if you want to). This will take a few minutes.

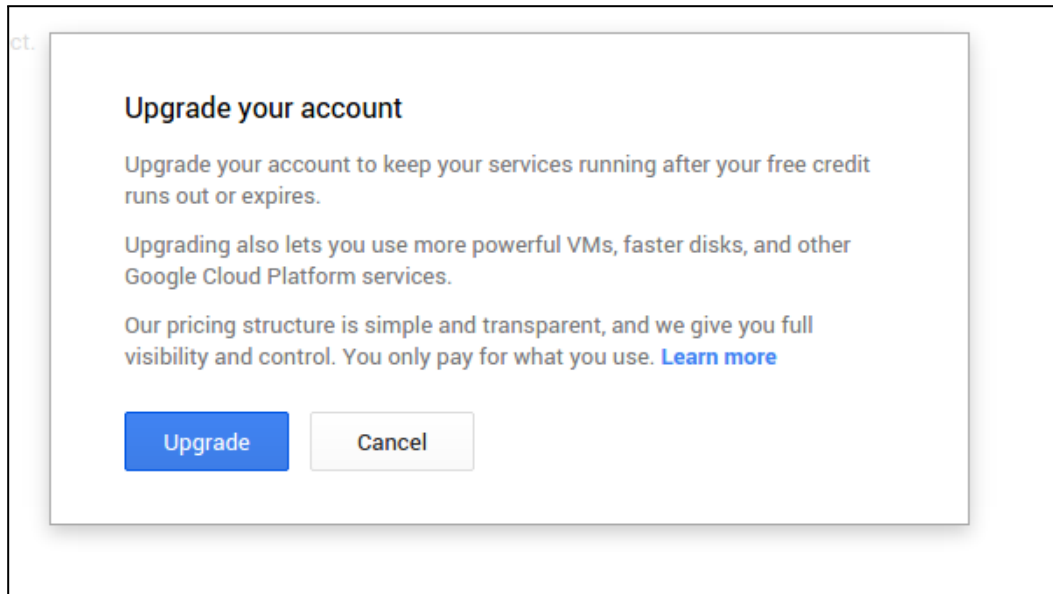

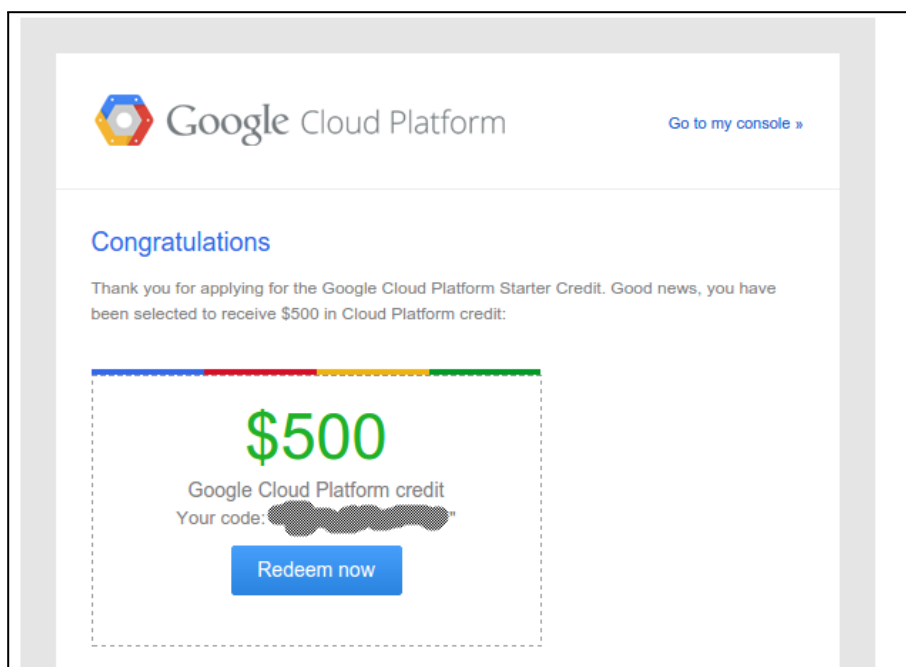
