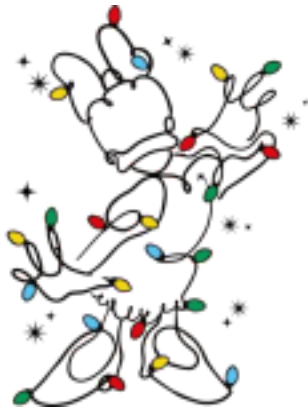




Parade Information



- The Oak Ridge Parade of Lights will begin at the Oak Ridge R-6 School New Gym Parking Lot (with larger entries beginning at the ballfield lot) and proceed east across Highway E and will return to the Oak Ridge R-6 School New Gym Parking Lot. **The parade will start at approximately 5:00 p.m.**
- No other vehicles, aside from parade participants or floats, will be allowed into the new gym and baseball/softball parking lot beginning at 4:00 pm on the day of the parade. **Vehicles that are dropping off parade participants cannot park their vehicles in the new gym or baseball/softball parking lot to make their drop off.**
- Line up for the Parade of Lights begins as early as 3:00 pm on the day of the parade, and all parade participants should have their parade entry in their assigned line up location no later than 4:30 pm.

- Float passengers and walking entries should arrive and be dropped off at the Oak Ridge R-6 School New Gym Parking Lot. ▪ Parade officials will be stationed at the parking lot entrance to

assist participants with directions and instructions.

- Leading up to and on the day of the event, the Parade committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Cancellation for weather will be announced on Facebook and other local media outlets. If canceled, the parade will be held the following Saturday, December 13, 2025.
- No refunds will be given for event cancellation, postponement, or entry withdrawal. Please include contact information for the day of the parade on the entry form in case of cancellation or postponement.
- Payment for the Oak Ridge Christmas Parade of Lights entries must be submitted before a parade spot is secured. ▪ No entries will be accepted on the day of the parade. ▪ No open flames are allowed.
- Entries are limited to the first 50 applicants.
- The parade committee is not responsible for any accidents or injuries.
