4. **RULES**
 - Each match is 2 games only: Two games to 25 pts – win by 2 no cap.
 - The standings will be kept by keeping track of the number of sets won, not the number of matches. If 2 or more teams are tied in the total number of sets won – head-to-head record and then points for/against between the tied teams will be used to break the tie. If the teams are still tied, then the total number of points for/against will be used as the final tiebreaker.
5. **OFFICIALS**

6. **GATE**
