WHAT TO BRING ON A RESIDENTIAL.

- o Lunch for the first day in a disposable bag
- o Suitable Nightwear
- o Underwear (including enough socks for the activities)
- o T-shirts
- o Long-sleeved tops for activities (such as Archery)
- o Shorts
- o Trousers / Leggings / Jogging bottoms (not jeans)
- o 1 pair of trainers for activities
- o 1 pair of old trainers for water activities
- o 1 pair of dry shoes for evening activities
- o Waterproof Jacket
- o Fleece/sweatshirt for activities
- o 1 or 2 sets of evening clothes
- o Sunhat and sunscreen
- o One old towel for water activities

WASH BAG CONTAINING:

- o Soap, shower gel, shampoo.
- o Toothbrush + toothpaste.
- o Towel for showering.
- o Deodorant.

OTHER ESSENTIALS:

- o Small day bag
- o Bin Bags for wet/dirty clothing.
- o Torch and spare batteries.
- o Water bottle.

CAMPING:

Sleeping in Bunk-style beds.

- o Sleeping bag.
- o Pillow & pillowcase.
- o Blanket (optional).

OPTIONAL:

- o Flip flops for the shower
- o A book
- o Disposable camera

PLEASE DON'T BRING:

- o Mobile phones

- o Jewellery and valuables.
