bilingual. AJ is very famous in school, kids love to talk with him. So this bilingual program in our countryside school is very appreciated. Thanks.

Now, I will present the bilingual administrative report of Pu Ding Elementary School to date. The report will be divided into three sections: basic school information, curriculum planning, and the current implementation status.

The school has a history of 55 years (established in 1970, with the area previously part of Xin Wu Elementary School's Pu Ding branch and campus). The school campus covers an area of 0.9 hectares. The school currently has 3 buildings with 4 sections, consisting of 6 regular classes, 1 special education class, 1 non-categorical itinerant pre-school class, and 2.5 kindergarten classes.

The student population is 161, with 82 boys and 79 girls. The staff includes 19 teachers, 5 part-time teachers, 6 administrative staff, 1 janitor, 2 special education assistants, 3 childcare workers, and 1 contracted assistant.

As for the curriculum planning, our school offers 18 English lessons per week. The school's designated English curriculum includes 1 lesson for the lower grades, while the middle and upper grades each have 2 lessons. For the foreign teacher's bilingual highlight courses, the lower and middle grades each have 1 lesson, while the upper grades have 2 lessons.

Our bilingual curriculum planning includes integrated activity courses for grades 1-6, physical education classes for grades 5-6, as well as reader's theater and extracurricular activities led by foreign teachers.

Regarding the current implementation of our bilingual program, we have organized a Bilingual Curriculum Committee, with Principal Chiang responsible for leading the meetings and guiding the execution of the plan. I am responsible for three main areas: 1. Overseeing the implementation of the plan, performance management, and drafting plans. 2. Promoting various bilingual initiatives and regulations. 3. Recording and compiling the results of the bilingual program.

Additionally, Teachers Zhang and Zhou have been involved in the planning of the teaching activities for the program and assisting with the promotion of collaborative teaching activities. Each grade-level teacher also contributes to the implementation of collaborative teaching activities for this program. Furthermore, Director Lai handles the procurement of related materials for the plan, while Director Lin Xiufen and Teacher Chiu Li-hui manage the allocation of funds for the program-related activities.

We hold regular bilingual meetings and conduct internal observation lessons every month. The teachers participating in the bilingual program within our school are those shown in the picture. At the start of the semester, AJ held a meeting to let all the local teachers know about culture shock and different languages.

After joining the bilingual program, we have added bilingual signage in our school environment, including English-language signs for classrooms

and bilingual learning boards in the stairwells. We also have bilingual classroom nameplates, a bilingual calendar, and information equipment for foreign teachers displayed in English.

As for the curriculum, the integrated courses are taught entirely in English and co-taught by the homeroom teachers. The physical education classes for the upper grades are also taught entirely in English and co-taught by subject teachers. Additionally, Foreign Teacher AJ helps us by serving as an instructor for our school's Reader's Theater, co-taught with the senior teacher.

We also have a weekly English sentence practice, which helps students practice English conversation and improve their daily conversational skills.

Foreign teachers use various teaching aids during their lessons, utilizing the school's sports equipment and touchscreens in each classroom for instruction. Additionally, in all courses, we have local teachers co-teaching—this includes physical education, integrated courses, and extracurricular activities. The interaction between the foreign teachers and the students is very positive, and the students are eager to learn. And we also make sure the local teachers do not translate but just help students understand the classes.

When the foreign teacher was injured previously, we provided care and assistance with daily life. Moreover, we invited the foreign teacher to participate in our school's curriculum and activities, including field trips and Christmas events, alongside the students. We don't actually have good English for the kids in the countryside school. So we try very hard to let them understand what we want them to do. And uses lots of hand gestures with many pictures.

With the enthusiastic teaching of the foreign teacher, the students are very eager to participate in the bilingual courses. They are able to focus in class and engage in the teaching activities and tasks arranged by the teachers. The students have also participated in many extracurricular English activities. AJ designs many different activities, and all the kids loved them.

That concludes my report. Next, let's have Director Xu from Yung An Elementary School present their report.

永安國小主任 徐 永相 / Director **Xu** of Yung An Elementary School

Hello everyone, I am Director Xu from Yung An Elementary School. It's my turn to report on the highlights of our school's administration. First, I will introduce the school overview, followed by an explanation of the current implementation status.

The school has a history of 105 years (founded in 1920 as a branch of Da Po Elementary School). The school campus covers an area of 2 hectares. The school consists of 3 buildings with 3 sections, including 10 regular classes and 2.5 kindergarten classes. The student population is 171, with 83 boys and 88 girls. The staff includes 18 teachers, 3 part-time teachers, 4

administrative staff, and no janitors.

Regarding the weekly English lessons, the school's designated English curriculum includes 1 lesson for the lower grades, while the middle and upper grades each have 2 lessons. For the bilingual highlight courses, we have arranged 2 physical education classes for the middle grades, and 3 physical fitness classes for the upper grades.

In terms of the curriculum arrangement, we have scheduled physical education classes for grades 4, 5, and 6, which align with the foreign teacher's area of expertise. Additionally, we have added English club courses, allowing the foreign teachers to freely arrange their lessons. Sometimes it'll be handmaking, others would be video watching, those activities let the kids listen to more English.

Regarding the current implementation of our bilingual program, we have organized a Bilingual Curriculum Committee, with Principal Xu responsible for leading the meetings and guiding the execution of the plan. I am responsible for three main areas: 1. Overseeing the implementation of the plan, performance management, and drafting plans. 2. Promoting various bilingual initiatives and regulations. 3. Recording and compiling the results of the bilingual program.

Additionally, Teachers Chen and Wang have been involved in the planning of the teaching activities for the program and assisting with the promotion of collaborative teaching activities. Each grade-level teacher also contributes to the implementation of collaborative teaching activities for this program. Furthermore, Director Chen handles the procurement of related materials for the plan, while Director Xu and Teacher Chen manage the allocation of funds for the program-related activities.

We hold regular bilingual meetings and conduct internal observation lessons every month. The teachers participating in the bilingual program within our school are those shown in the picture. And also, we have another meeting at the end of the semester and talk about the things that we can improve.

After joining the bilingual program, we have added bilingual signage in our school environment, including English-language signs for classrooms and bilingual learning boards in the stairwells. We also have bilingual classroom nameplates, a bilingual calendar, and information equipment for foreign teachers displayed in English. And since our school is also promoting marine education, we are using it as the theme to create these new English signs.

Our physical education classes are taught entirely in English by the foreign teacher, who also utilizes various teaching aids. Senior teachers assist with co-teaching, and we encourage them to avoid direct translations, allowing students to practice listening to English. The interaction between the foreign teacher and students is excellent. We often invite the foreign teacher to participate in activities, and we take great care to support them in their daily life. We provide various forms of work-related support and

help the foreign teacher solve any issues that arise.

The students enthusiastically participate in the bilingual courses and love the foreign teacher's lessons. They are able to successfully carry out the teaching activities and tasks arranged by the teacher, and the foreign teacher often organizes group work for the students. The students can understand and use what they have learned in class. They also engage in various extracurricular activities. We even held an internal English-speaking competition to increase the students' competitiveness. Additionally, we set up an after-school English club and asked the foreign teacher to assist students who want to improve their English skills.

We also participated in the certification activities with Taoyuan City and Cool English. Additionally, we air ICRT news broadcasts at regular intervals during lunchtime to provide students with more opportunities to listen to English. At the same time, the school has introduced a weekly English sentence practice, allowing students to practice their speaking skills more frequently.

# 教案翻譯 Lesson plan translation

# 主要學習目標:

學生應該了解越野賽跑的基本知識!

#### 學習目標:

學生需要了解越野賽跑與其他跑步運動的區別,並記住一些有關越野賽跑的新術語和資訊。

學生將在小組中與同學討論並辨識一個典型越野賽跑賽道的特徵。 課堂的最後學生必須按照老師的指示慢跑完成賽道,並完成任務卡上的任務。

## 學生的先備知識:

學生已經學過跑步的重要性。

學生也學過如何在不同的方向上移動, 並運用正確的跑步技巧。

# 教學材料:

PPT、跑步賽道(學校操場)、[賽道標誌,如圓錐或旗幟—第二堂課才需要使用]、哨子、任務卡、鉛筆。

## 熱身與介紹:

基本問候並回顧上一堂課(移動)。

老師會向學生介紹學習目標。

老師會告知學生下一堂課的內容,告訴學生他們需要準備什麼(跑步鞋、水瓶和運動毛巾)。

老師會先播放一段越野賽跑的影片(00:55-10:40),並在影片中進行講解。

# 展示與進行:

老師會根據影片中的內容進行講解:

- 1. 首先, 強調越野賽跑與其他跑步運動的區別。
- 2. 其次,介紹越野賽跑的術語和重要概念給學生。
- 3. 最後,帶領學生進行慢跑,熟悉賽道,為下週的實踐課程做準備。

在跑步小組中:

學生將有機會在慢跑過程中通過完成任務卡來達成學習目標。 他們需要在任務卡上標註典型越野賽跑賽道的特徵。

## 複習與總結:

如果有剩餘時間,老師會與學生討論本堂課的學習內容。

下一堂課將會是今天課程的回顧及練習課,學生將以慢跑的速度再次跑過賽道,熟悉賽道的情況。

老師會告知學生下一堂課的內容,告訴學生他們需要準備什麼(跑步鞋、水瓶和運動毛巾)。

我計劃在賽道沿途放置帶有關鍵詞彙的塑封卡片,學生跑過時可以閱讀。例如, "Hill"(坡道)、"water"(水)、"obstacle"(障礙物)、"woodlands"(森林)等。

課後,我會問學生他們看到多少塊塑封卡片,並詢問卡片上寫了什麼內容。

大坑國小 林惠萍 校長 / Principal Lin from Daken Elementary School	I think AJ might be a bit misunderstood for being bilingual. Asking the LT to translate for me is bilingual but it isn't.  Some of the other school's students can speak in Chinese. But answering the answer right.  So not only let the students know the Chinese, but let them know what the class is about.  But still, thanks AJ, I think you bring great classes to the students. The countryside students don't have many chances in English, but you are great and you give them chances to have English classes.  I think AJ is very serious about preparing and teaching. The teacher speaks a lot but the students might not understand.  So hopefully, AJ you can speak slower, teach slower, even in the city

schools we hope the FTs can be slower. Let the students understand more than just the teacher speaking.

Aj uses Chinese in his PPT. Maybe we can take a bit of Chinese out of the PPt, because the students have listened to English for many weeks already. So maybe like the warm up etc, you can take out a bit of Chinese on your PPT.

And also, make some questions to let the students answer, so that you can check if they really understand those words, but not just the teacher talk and talk the whole class.

You don't have to tell the students what your topic is today, but throughout the class to let the kids know what the topic is.

So please let the LT help our FT. I think the FT gives a lot of effort in preparing the classes, so let the LT help with it.

Even in singWu, there is an ocean running event, maybe put it in your classes.

With your checking paper, maybe you can use your map to let the kids check, so that they really know where they run on the paper. Please the kids don't know what they are checking.

So I suggest that teacher AJ look more to other schools' classes. to combine your class to the school's courses. So that the classes are more related to the school's bilingual classes. This is what I want to talk about in class today.

And about the bilingual program for school. The school is small, you only need a little resource to help the students to have more chances to learn English. ICRT, etc will be a great thing for the students to use. And Cool English has lots of resources for the kids to use. And also, these days, Fung Shu eES, has activities for kids to read and speak. Students can talk about their family, their community in the event. And letting the students participate in this event is very important.

埔頂國小校長 姜 禮琪 / Principal Chiang of Pu Ding Elementary School Good morning everyone, I really thank Teacher AJ for coming to our school this year. AJ usually teaches PE class in our school most of the time. I am also a PE teacher, I think usually in Taiwan, Many schools actually overlook the essence of teaching physical education. Most people just pick up a ball and start playing, but the theoretical aspect is often missing. This is what I appreciate most about AJ. If I had taken the class outdoors from the start, I might have ended up talking too much. But in fact, I really like the way he incorporates teaching theories—it's very appropriate. We usually think PE class would include War-up and some activities. But AJ told students in the beginning, you need to respect yourself. I think I learned a lot today from teacher AJ. because so many professors and teachers come to observe our class in school, so students also get used to it. They can behave really well in class. I think Teacher AJ combines our school environment with class very well. and also, how do

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	we check students' understanding of class. We taught students how to test their heart beat before. If the student's pulse is correct for exercising, this is also an important thing for students to understand.
