The flourishing tree represents continuous growth, expansion, immortality, regeneration, wisdom and stability. The Tree of Life is directly associated with the concepts of evolution, strength and results. It is also a symbol of nourishment, with many animals feeding on its leaves, living in its branches and enjoying its shade. Peacocks represent happiness, and spread the message of peace, passion, and harmony.

The painting is done in Kalamkari style, which is an ancient art form from Andhra Pradesh in India. It often depicts mythological stories, religious figures, epic scenes from the Ramayana and Mahabharata, as well as floral and nature-inspired motifs.
