## Peer Review to "The Pirate's Mermaid"

- 4. The majority of the crew are singing a sad song about how they miss Daniel, trying to come to terms with his death as Magnus is getting annoyed before interrupting the song to get them to shut up.
- 5. The climax where Daniel as a ghost comes back to help Jodie to stand up on the ground and defend herself against Captain Nickels and Captain Fumus while they're all on a bridge near a volcano until the other crew members come up to them.
- 6. The finale song reprise where Jodie and Melody are given magic powers by the mermaid king to be able to transform into humans so they can return to the pirate crew and join them for more adventures on the high seas; the pirate crew overjoyed as they sing the song as well.
