

Student Guidelines:

Before your scheduled POL, you must...

- Turn in the [seminar entrance ticket](#) to your [assigned mentor teacher](#) and earn at least an 8 in each rubric category.

The day of your scheduled POL, you must...

- Be **on time** for your scheduled seminar.
- Be **prepared** with your completed [seminar entrance ticket](#) (written reflection) and "[Beautiful Work](#)" text for reference.
- Be prepared to join the Google Meet link: meet.google.com/xti-vskw-nzx. In case of emergency, dial in via phone: (US) +1 317-936-9585; PIN: 989 340 729#. However, you are expected to join with a working camera and internet. (See following guidelines.)
- Have a **working webcam** that is kept on for the duration of the discussion. If your webcam has been a problem, please make arrangements to borrow a device or consider downloading the Google Meet app on your phone.
- Situate yourself in a setting with **reliable internet**. If your internet connection has been a problem for you, please make arrangements to relocate (for instance, to AHS). Reach out to your teachers if you need support with this!
- Keep background sounds to a minimum. Keep yourself muted when you are not speaking.
- Do your best to ensure that people, pets, ghosts, or other ambulatory distractions don't enter the screen space.
- Consider the professionalism of your setting and background choice.
 - Are you well-lit?
 - What is behind you?
 - Is the area clean and tidy?
 - If using a generated background, is it appropriate to the context?
- Be in **professional dress from the waist up**: button-down shirt and tie, shirt with finished neck, sweater, blouse, or dress. *Please check the positioning of your webcam if you are taking the "waist up" thing literally!*
- Participate in the seminar at a "mild, medium, or spicy" level, as defined in the Socratic Seminar Grading Rubric in your [2020 POL Document](#).

Family Guidelines:

- Family members are invited (but not required) to attend your child's POL seminar, if you and your student believe this will not interfere with honest reflection. If joining, you will be invited (but again, not required!) to share your thoughts/perspective at the conclusion of the seminar. We look forward to seeing you.
- **Observation guidelines:** We do ask that you keep your camera and microphone off so as not to distract our student participants, until we invite you to share your own thoughts at the end of the seminar.
