▼ A Comforting Note to My Clients!

First things first... My digital art career, which started over 12 years ago on DeviantArt, is not just my job, it's my life and whole personality at this point xD. It's part of me and part of who I am. It's my sole source of income, and now supports my family. That means I, more than anyone, must act with total professionalism. Messing up badly with even one client could put everything I've built at risk. Makes sense, right?

This Terms of Service is the first sign that the artist you've chosen is serious, validated, and respects their clients. It's a valid legal document that protects both of us. I understand how anxious it can be to commission art (I buy art too!), especially with so many scammers online nowadays.

But here, everything is discussed, agreed upon, and signaled clearly. Take a deep breath - you're in good hands!

1. Introduction & Agreement

By commissioning me, you accept my artistic style, which includes my specific painting style & approach to shading, lighting, and effects. Minor color variations are normal due to color theory and light interaction and to fit my art style in general. But I always do my best to provide you a high quality artwork, loyal to your OC's designs and refs!

I am a part-time artist, currently pursuing my second university degree, while managing chronic tendinitis and other obligations. My workflow and whole art process are designed for quality and consistency, not rushed output. Reading further, you'll understand! Keep reading. ^_^

2. General Rules & Respect Policy

I reserve the right to refuse any commission for any reason.

Rudeness, harassment, threats, or blackmail will result in cancellation without refunds, blocking, and blacklisting.

Detail-oriented clients are welcome! I understand how special your OC is, and wanting attention to detail is not the same as being "nitpicky." It's all about how you communicate it - kindness and clarity go a long way.;)

Reference Policy:

It is your responsibility to send the correct reference sheet or images of your OC/fursona's current design before the start of the artwork, especially during the sketch stage.

If we're creating a brand new design, please prepare a folder or document containing multiple images and a text description before we start — especially before the sketch phase, which is the correct stage to make adjustments and modifications.

If you send the wrong reference and don't mention it before the end of the sketch approval stage, the artwork will proceed using the reference provided with no refunds. Double-check your references before we begin!

Corrections for my mistakes:

Any errors on my part regarding your OC's design or colors will be fixed free of charge — as long as the correct references were provided before we started.

Post-sketch changes:

After the sketch is approved and I start the official lineart, any change that is not due to my mistake will incur an extra fee of \$10–\$15 per change.

The more advanced the artwork is, the harder it is to change. If the piece is fully painted or with shading and lighting, changes are still possible but very challenging. Please double check all details before I start painting the first colors!

P.S.: Changes will naturally extend the final delivery deadline, anywhere from 1 extra week to several, depending on the size and number of changes.

3. Usage & Ownership Rights

Artist Rights: I retain full copyright. I may display the artwork in portfolios and promotional materials.

Client Rights: You may use the artwork for personal purposes (printing, wallpapers, social media, etc.).

Commercial Use: Requires prior discussion and an additional fee (60–100% of the final price).

4. Content Restrictions

○ I Will NOT Draw:

Illegal content, crimes, Nazi apologia, sexual acts involving minors, sexual/romantic feral x human content.

✓ I WILL Draw:

Almost anything not in the "Won't Draw" list - SFW, NSFW, fantasy creatures, fanart, diverse body types, genders, and even other art styles (like anime - although I'm a bit rusty on that last one, not gonna lie hehe.). This includes 99% of themes, kinks and fetishes too.

I am a highly non-judgemental artist, very open minded, and have worked on many exotic, rare, and creative themes in both SFW and NSFW over my 12+ year career.

A condensed list would be: All genders, Furry, Human, Kemonomimi, Anthro, Feral (only sfw), Vore, Hyper, Watersports, Pregnancy/Breeding, Gore (soft and mild), Breastmilk/other body fluids, Feet Worship, Giantess, BSDM, etc.....

This is a safe space for you to bring your ideas to life through art - as long as they are legal and characters are +18!

Some exotic or highly complex fetishes may have an additional fee (\$15–\$30+).

If you're unsure, please feel free to ask!

5. Communication, Deadlines & Updates

I usually respond within a few hours to a couple of days. I do not work on weekends or Brazilian holidays (except rare cases), this includes answering messages and notes too!

On socials like Telegram, I will also answer clients once (of course, with all informations needed or requested!) every 24h or 48h. It's the same amount of time/timeframe that I need to check all my e-mails, notes, DMs, etc. I usually rotationate between all socials looking for new PMs, it's part of my own process. So don't worry, your message WILL receive an answer shortly! Thanks for your patience!

Progress updates every 9–14 days (screenshot or written).

*Estimated delivery times (can vary a little bit depending on complexity):

Simple pieces or YCHs: ~2 weeks to 4 weeks

Complex pieces: 2–3+ months

Most average commissions: Usually between 4-8 weeks!

Deadlines can be affected by: complexity, multiple versions, revisions/changes needed, health, studies, or family matters.

Everything will be informed via Journals and Tweets and negotiated if anything unexpected happens. In rare cases, very small delays can occur, but if it does, I ALWAYS compensate my clients for the wait with a little gift or extra Alt. Version.

Health note: I have chronic tendinitis in both hands, requiring 30-minute breaks for rest/stretching/ice packs every 1-hour-drawing-sessions, prescribed by ortho doctor. This is why my artworks take a little more time to finish, but trust me, it's worth the wait - said many of my clients over the last years!! <3

Important – September 2025 Surgery

In early September 2025, I will undergo surgery on my right knee (as many of you already know). Until the surgery, I will push as much progress as possible on all artworks. After surgery, I will need at least 2 weeks of full rest, with no art or message replies, as it's a delicate procedure with residual pain. This is temporary! Once I'm able, I will return as quickly as possible. I kindly ask for your understanding, and promise to make it up to you with extra care and detail in your artworks.

***Any small delays or unexpected situations will be announced first via my FurAffinity journals and also on Twitter/X.

It is your responsibility to check these posts for updates at least once per week.

Feel free to politely message me if you need clarification, just avoid spam. I believe respectful communication solves everything. :)

6. Work Process

Work starts after full payment or the first installment (see payment plan policy).

After payment, I will add your name on my Trello Commissions-Board in around 1-2 days, plus the infos for you comm, and start updating the Trello for/post each stage completed on the art process.

I will show you a screenshot WIP of your artwork in the first update, happening around 8-10 days after purchase! During that time, I will study and learn your OC's design and references, look for cool ideas/pose references for your character fitting the client's needs and ideas, test a few initial rough sketches to see which pose will look better visually and refine it a bit. Then, I'll show it to you via screenshot.

If you don't approve it, we'll work on some changes to the design to fit your ideas better. In this stage, if needed, you'll be able to ask for around 3-5 changes, for free. Please remember to be respectful and polite. Artists have feelings, too! xD Just kidding. (Or not..)

(Reminder: All changes needed that involve my own mistake of correctly representing your OC's design BASED ON THE correct Refs you sent earlier (eg.: if I forgot to draw a horn, made the tail too fluffy, or forgot some other details, etc..) will also be free of charge until the end of the art process! But please, inform it to me as soon as you see it! ^_^).

After you approve the sketch, I'll proceed with the painting and clean lines/draw official lineart ->

Sketches are always sent for approval before moving forward. If I don't hear back within several days, I may proceed.

Post-sketch changes follow the rules in Section 2.

7. Waitlist & Reserved Slots

Trello is updated usually weekly (on busy schedules can happen biweekly) with commission status.

There you'll find my workflow divided into sections and cards. I'll move your Commission Card throughout the different stages during the process until it reaches the Finished Section! Then, I'll start preparing your final art image files for delivery!

*Waitlist applies if: slots are full, payment is pending, details are missing, or you've reserved a future slot.

8. Payment & Refund Policy

All prices in USD; other currencies converted at current rate. Please do not send BRL via PayPal, because this will make both of us pay double taxes.

Payment plans:

```
From $100–$209 \rightarrow 2 equal installments
From $210–$299 \rightarrow 3 equal installments
For $300+ works\rightarrow 4 equal installments (max.)
```

First installment payment is due before starting; next payments are due every 15 or 30 days (agreed privately via notes/dms); final payment must be made before delivery of the finished piece.

Examples:

```
$210 artwork \rightarrow 3× $70, final payment before delivery. $300 artwork \rightarrow 4× $75, final payment before delivery.
```

> P.S.: Longer payment schedules will extend the final deadline, since delivery happens only after the last installment is received. Please have that in mind!

Refunds:

No refunds once work has started, except in extreme, rare situations.

No refunds for failure to read the ToS or for dissatisfaction within the stated delivery timeframe.

Rude or abusive behavior cancels the commission without refund.

If I must cancel for personal/extreme reasons, a partial refund proportional to work done will be issued.

9. Alternative Versions / Extras

Additional versions (clothing, expressions, effects, etc.) have extra fees. These below are base prices, final prices will vary from each alt. Version or extra details' complexities.

Clothing: \$15–\$40+ Props/toys: \$5–\$20+

Effects (sweat, fluids, blood, c*m, etc.): \$5-\$10+

Expressions: \$10-\$20+

Wings: 15\$-25\$+

Extra limbs/body parts: 10-22\$+

10. Final Notes

This ToS is a legal agreement that protects both artist and client.

Terms may be updated without notice, but will not affect projects already in progress.

I have 12+ years of experience and a 100% completion rate on paid commissions.
