ORDINANCE NO. 2024-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, ESTABLISHING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) OF THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$39,100.00) TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Creston wishes to increase the appropriations in the General Fund from \$733,342.80 TO \$772,442.80 and;

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Creston directs the Fiscal Officer to supplement the General Fund in the amount of \$39,100.00 for this appropriation and;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer estimates that \$39,100.00 must be added to the General Fund if a vehicle is to be purchased from that fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. That within the General Fund, \$39,100.000 shall be supplementally appropriated to the following account: 1000-800-550-0077 Motor Vehicle{POLICE CRUSIER ROTATION}
2. That the Report to the Wayne County Budget Commission be provided a copy of Supplemental Appropriations increasing the General Fund.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency to have the ability to purchase a Police Vehicle from this fund, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
