

Rhenish German Coldblood / Rhenish Draft

Description: Endangered breed of German draft horses. Breed derived from the Ardennais but also has Belgian Brabant heritage. Due to the split of Germany after WWII the breed almost died out.

Characteristics: Strong hardy, double sided mane. Between 16-17hands.

Color: red roan with black points, chestnut with flaxen mane or bay
