Pan into another view of a large, lavish looking house situated before the dropoff of a waterfall

ACT 1: The Note Desolation Plays

[ Fade into the next Scene ]

NARRATOR (as the scene continues): It is this young man's 13th birthday, the 13th of April, 2009, and today, he will play a video game with his online friends.

Fade into a room, multiple shots showcase a bookshelf with his computer, a dresser, multiple movie posters on his wall, a chest in the corner with a calendar above. Finally, a teenager wearing glasses with a slight overbite shown sitting on his bed reading a book about data structures.

A middle-aged man wearing a fedora with jeans, a polo shirt and a tie walks into his room.

DAD: Happy birthday John! I'm gonna be out to the grocer to get baking supplies for your birthday cake. In the meantime, I got this poster for you.

He waves it a little in the air before putting it on his dresser.

John puts down his book and hugs his dad.

JOHN: Love you dad!

His dad pats him on the back.

DAD: I love you too, son.

He lets go of John, walks downstairs and closes the door behind him.

John proceeds to unfurl the poster from his dresser

JOHN: Sweet, a Con Air poster!

He then proceeds to curl it back up and captchalogues it in his sylladex.

NARRATOR (as the scene continues): People in this world have a thing called a sylladex, a place for people to store objects on them without physically carrying them. Putting something in a sylladex is called captchaloging. Each one has a set of rules it needs to follow called a modus, making no two the same as the other.

John picks up a hammer and some nails on the floor and merges them into one card in his sylladex, and then proceeds to use the hammer and nails on the poster to put his poster up on the wall above his dresser.

Shortly after, he gets a video call from turntechGodhead ( or just tG) on his computer, and walks over to his desk to answer it.

tG is also 13 and his room is a mess, but we don't see much of it however. He's seen sitting at his desk, wearing aviator glasses with a T-shirt of a Metallica record. There's an open bottle of apple juice at his desk.
