Emberfest is a vibrant celebration of Pyropa's fiery power and its role in forging the spirit of resilience and strength among the dwarves of Dorgesh-Kaan. Held on Goldenleaf 9, during the height of summer as the leaves turn golden and harvests are abundant, the festival honors the balance between the heat of industry and the generosity of the land.

Traditions and Rituals

As dusk falls, a procession of flamebearers marches through the streets, carrying torches, lanterns, and glowing ember-filled braziers. This parade is accompanied by songs of Pyropa and the rhythmic pounding of ceremonial drums, culminating in the lighting of massive bonfires in the town square.

4. The Ritual of the Anvil:

A sacred anvil is placed in the festival's center, and each family contributes a small piece of metal imbued with their hopes for the year. These pieces are melted down and forged into a ceremonial artifact by the High Forgekeeper, symbolizing collective strength and community.
