2 - Upcoming Check-Offs

Check-Offs are music accuracy/memorization assignments to help students master the music that will be on the field in the correct timeline. We work on the music in class and during rehearsal, but students will have to practice in order to have the music in its best shape.

Grades are either 100 (perfect), 85 (4-6 mistakes), 60 (attempted, 6+ mistakes). Past Due grades = maximum of 90%

The #1 key to success for Check-Offs is to ATTEMPT the Check-Off as you can always improve your grade! If you don't attempt, it goes in automatically as a zero. An attempt can happen BEFORE the due date with a FOG or band director. This gives students an opportunity to improve and receive feedback. The goal is that every student is able to perform their music memorized at a high level. The only music they must check-off is music that will be performed for Spirit Show or the Competitive Show.

3 - Sounds of Excellence Marching Competition, Student + Parent Volunteers Needed

We are proud to be hosting the 10th annual Sounds of Excellence Marching Competition at Elkhorn High School on Saturday, October 11th. This event is coordinated by all 3 EPS high schools as well as a group of dedicated volunteers.

<u>Competitive Band Students SUG</u> - Sign up for 1 shift NOT in the 7-9:30 timeslot (we perform at 9:15pm)

<u>Competitive Band Parents SUG</u> - Sign up for a shift or two, but avoid the 7-9:30 timeslot (ESHS performs at 9:15pm)

We will also be asking for donations to help support the concessions at this event - that link will be shared later. Thank you for helping us make this a well-run event!

As you look at the sign up list, you may wonder what some jobs are. Here is a short summary:

Parking crews- help people find spots, keep traffic flowing to the correct entrances and exits, etc.

Band Guide/Host- leading a particular band over to the warm-up field, and then around to the performance field. (students only)

Volunteer check in- check people off on the sheet as they arrive for shifts. Work with trouble shooters, etc. to cover any shifts that are no-shows. Give out t shirts to workers as they arrive

Concessions- work in our concession stand...please make sure to view the Concessions videos linked on the sign-up genius.

Ticket Sales- be in ticket booth, taking money as people arrive to watch (parents only)

Checking stamps- posted at entry gates, making sure everyone has proof of payment (a wristband or mark)

Hospitality- preparing and keeping up our hospitality rooms for directors and bus drivers in EHS.

Shout out sales- just outside the gate, selling shout outs, and bringing them to the announcer

Water Station- filling cups of water and handing out to bands as they get ready to go on the field. (students only)

Field Crew- letting directors/bands know where to go, and exactly when to do it. This is the logistics crew of the event. Helping bands get all their equipment on and off in an orderly and timely fashion. (parents only)

Field Timer- being in the pressbox with the announcer, and keeping official time for the event, letting the field crew know when a band has 90 seconds to take the field, 30 seconds to take the field, and finally when they can actually start moving. You also note at what point the band clears the field, and if any penalty for being overtime needs to be assessed. (parents only)

Audience Management- gating off the steps when a band starts, making sure no one disrupts performances. Not difficult, but you must sometimes be firm with people who think it's ok if "they just slip by".

Critique Guide/Driver- driving the critique judges back and forth on a golf cart from the judge booth to the critique location. (Parent only)

Warm-up field workers- monitoring the warm-up fields, and letting bands know when they have 5 minutes of time remaining, and when they must leave. (parents only)


Clean up Crew- get everything put away and clean at the end of the night.



4. Turn on your App Notifications in the Remind app


a. Select the 3 lines (menu) at the top left of the screen

c. Select Notifications




d. Click the 3 dots to the right of 'iPhone' or 'insert phone name'



6- Pep Band Schedule/Rosters

Linked below is the Pep Band schedule, these have also been added to the <u>25-26 Band</u> <u>Calendar!</u> Next week we will release rosters for the Blue and Gold Pep Bands. A couple of notes about Pep Band:

- The ESHS Band makes a HUGE impact on the atmosphere of events and we take pride in that. Pep Bands are a great way to add to the environment at sporting events and show school pride!
- You must wear your Pep Band polo at games that are indoor. If we are outdoors and it's cold, please wear coats and dress appropriately.
- Attendance at games is required as it is a part of our curriculum. Students are
 ALWAYS welcome to play at games that they aren't assigned to. They can earn
 lettering points by doing so.
- Attendance will be taken via QR code at the beginning of the performance time. If students don't check in, they will not receive credit.
- If there is an unavoidable conflict and a student can't make a game, they can talk with another person in the other band and complete the trade form if both parties agree to a trade. Trades can not occur over the semester (Dec - Jan), but only within the same semester. (Pep Band Trade Form - also on schedule). Only 1 person needs to complete the form after communicating.
- If a trade is unavailable, students need to request that someone who plays the same
 instrument/part subs for them. The sub will receive credit for that game in the form of
 lettering points OR to make up a missed game. Finding a sub does NOT give the
 person missing the game credit. Percussion subs can only occur if you are assigned
 the same part. Talk with Mr. Senff or Mr. Nelsen if you have any questions about this.
- In the event that a student isn't able to make a trade after communicating with their section, they can complete an alternate assignment (practice log for 40 minutes), but this is an absolute last resort to recover credit.

8 - Tardy/Performance Attendance Policy

"It's not personal, it's professional."

Performance Attendance Policy- It is essential that students attend all scheduled rehearsals and performances. All absences are considered UNEXCUSED unless communicated prior to the event.

 Missing performances will not be considered excused unless <u>parental notification is</u> <u>submitted at least two weeks before the performance date</u>. Special considerations will be made for illness or family emergencies, as long as notice is given in a timely manner.

- Unexcused performance absences will receive a zero in the gradebook, and can be PARTIALLY made up through a makeup assignment from the director
- Notifying directors of an upcoming absence does not always make such absence excused. An excused absence may include: family emergencies, another school activity if communicated, or illness if gone from school.
 - Work, dinners, birthday parties, too much homework are all unexcused absences.

Tardies - The expectation is that students will be in their spots with all their materials ready to play at the designated start time. Students not prepared to begin class on time will be docked 2 of their 4 participation points if they arrive after 8:10am and before 8:25am. If students arrive after 8:25am, they are considered truant according to ESHS Policy. Students with repeated infractions may not be allowed to participate in a performance if their readiness has been affected. The points lost for this must be made up via individual practice logs.
