Student Behavior Expectations

At Farm Discovery at Live Earth we want you to have a great experience exploring your! School chaperones and professionally trained Farm Discovery at Live Earth staff are here to support and keep you safe 24 hours a day. At Farm Discovery at Live Earth, we support all participants' physical and emotional safety and provide culturally responsive and inclusive programs. The agreements below will ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time on their Farm Discovery at Live Earth program.

All participants agree to:

- Respect other participants, their privacy, and their property.
- Respect the Farm Discovery at Live Earth farm.
- Not discriminate against people because of their race, culture, religion, sexual orientation, gender, language, talents, or special needs.
- Not to cause physical or emotional harm to myself or any other person.
- Not to bring or use non-prescription drugs, cigarettes, weapons, and/or alcohol at Farm Discovery at Live Earth.
- Be on time, prepared (have suitable clothing and equipment), and to be an active participant in Farm Discovery at Live Earth programming.
- Stay with my school group and be under the supervision of a chaperone at all times.
- Only enter and use my cabin/dorm/room; and refrain from entering other participant cabins/dorms/rooms.
- Be quiet and respectful in the evening and morning so that everyone can get enough sleep to participate and stay healthy.
- Keep food out of my cabin/dorm/room.
- Look out for the safety of myself and others and follow all safety directions.
- Follow the cell phone policy of my school. If my school does not have a cell phone policy,
 I will follow the Farm Discovery at Live Earth policy: cell phones should be set in airplane
 mode and used only for taking photos, video or specific school projects. I understand
 that student participants may not use cell phones in Farm Discovery at Live Earth dorms,
 dining halls or bathrooms.

Student Behavior Support System:

If a Farm Discovery at Live Earth staff member or school chaperone determines that a student is not following the above agreements, the following sequential steps will be taken with recurring misbehavior:

- Verbal warning and reminder about Farm Discovery at Live Earth agreements.
- Behavior discussion with Farm Discovery at Live Earth staff and school/group leader.
- A student/Farm Discovery at Live Earth Behavior Contract is drafted and parent/guardian is alerted.
- Removal from program and/or sent home.
