IRB Steps

Welcome!

All research involving human participants conducted at Gustavus Adolphus College, or under its sponsorship, must be reviewed and approved by the Gustavus Institutional Review Board (IRB). Details about the process are available in the <u>Gustavus IRB Policy Manual</u>, but below are the basic steps to get you started.

Basic Steps

- 1. Determine if your project qualifies as human subject research.
 - a. The IRB would happily have a pre-application video chat if you are unsure.
- 2. Complete the CITI Social & Behavioral Research Basic Course.
 - a. All personnel working on the project, including the faculty/staff supervisor, must complete this training. Once you have successfully completed the training, your certification is effective campus wide for 3 years.
- 3. Submit your CITI completion certificate, Form F, and any additional documents (e.g., consent documents and surveys) to the IRB for review using the online submission form.
 - a. All documents should be submitted at the same time.
 - b. For consent documents, please use the IRB's <u>Consent Template</u> as a starting point.

Note: It is often helpful to consult with the IRB during the study planning process before you request formal approval of a project. The IRB may be able to help you identify minor changes that could facilitate approval. We also maintain an FAQ that may answer some questions you have.
