

# Privacy Policy

### 1. Who we are

This Privacy Policy applies to Device Nova, Android package name *com.rtnova.devicenova*

This policy explains what information the app accesses, how it is used, how it is handled, and what choices users have.

### 2. Summary

Device Nova is a device utility app that helps users view internet speed, data usage, battery, storage, RAM, installed apps, cache-cleaning guidance, and basic device health information.

Most information shown in the app is processed locally on the user's device. The app does not require users to create an account.

The app does not sell personal or sensitive user data.

The app does not collect contacts, SMS, call logs, photos, microphone recordings, camera images, precise location, payment card details, or government IDs.

### 3. Information the app accesses and why

Usage Access / PACKAGE_USAGE_STATS	Shows recently used or unused apps and usage-based cleanup suggestions after the user grants Usage Access in Android Settings.	Only available after the user grants permission.	Not uploaded by Device Nova.
Network state and data usage	Shows live internet speed, mobile data usage estimates, and data-limit progress.	Accessed from Android network APIs.	Not uploaded by Device Nova.

Internet speed test / INTERNET	Runs an optional in-app speed test when the user taps Test Speed.	Temporary download/upload test data is generated only during the test.	HTTPS requests are sent to speed.cloudflare.com for the test.
User preferences	Stores dark/light theme choice and manual data-limit setting.	Entered or selected by the user.	Stored locally on the device.
Cache cleaner	Clears Device Nova's own app cache and guides users to Android storage settings for system-level cleanup.	No personal files are read or uploaded.	Not shared.

## 4. Internet speed test and third-party network requests

The Internet speed test is optional and runs only when the user taps the Test Speed button.

During the test, the app makes HTTPS download and upload requests to Cloudflare speed test endpoints at speed.cloudflare.com. The test uses temporary data to estimate download and upload speed.

Cloudflare and network operators may receive standard technical connection information, such as IP address, request time, network route, and connection metadata, because this is necessary for internet communication.

Device Nova does not use the speed test to create user profiles, sell data, or collect account information.

## 5. Installed apps and usage information

Device Nova may access the list of installed apps on the device so it can display all apps, downloaded apps, system apps, storage/cache estimates, and cleanup recommendations.

If the user grants Android Usage Access permission, Device Nova may read app usage timestamps and usage duration to identify rarely used or unused apps.

This information is used only for app functionality and is processed on the device. Device Nova does not upload the installed app list or usage history to our servers.

## 6. Data storage and retention

Device Nova stores only limited local settings such as theme preference and manual data-limit preference using Android app storage.

Device Nova does not maintain a user account database and does not store personal profiles on a remote server.

Users can delete local app data at any time by using Android Settings > Apps > Device Nova > Storage > Clear data, or by uninstalling the app.

If a user contacts support by email, the email address and message content will be retained only as long as needed to respond to the request and maintain support records.

## 7. How we use information

We use accessed information to provide user-facing features such as live internet speed, speed test results, data usage display, battery and storage summaries, installed app lists, cleanup suggestions, device information, dark/light theme, and user-selected data limit.

We do not use this information for advertising profiling.

We do not sell personal or sensitive user data.

## 8. Sharing and disclosure

We do not sell user data.

We do not share installed app inventory, usage history, device readings, or local preferences with advertisers or data brokers.

The optional speed test sends technical HTTPS requests to speed.cloudflare.com as described above.

We may disclose information if required by applicable law, legal process, or enforceable governmental request, or to protect the rights, safety, and security of users, the app, or the public.

## 9. Security

Device Nova uses Android platform security and HTTPS for internet speed-test connections.

No method of electronic transmission or storage is completely secure, but we aim to access only information needed for the app's stated functionality.

## 10. User choices and controls

Usage Access permission is optional and can be enabled or disabled in Android Settings at any time.

Users can manage app permissions from Android Settings.

Users can clear local app data or uninstall the app to remove locally stored preferences.

Users can choose whether to run the speed test. The speed test does not run unless the user starts it.

## 11. Children's privacy

Device Nova is not directed to children as defined by applicable law. The app is intended as a general device utility for users who can manage Android device settings and permissions.

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If you believe a child has provided personal information through support communication, contact us so we can review and delete it where appropriate.

## 12. Changes to this Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy when app features, data practices, permissions, or legal requirements change.

The updated policy will show a new "Last updated" date. Users should review the policy periodically.

## Appendix: Play Console publishing notes

### Suggested Data Safety wording summary

- No user account creation in the current app version.
- No ads or analytics SDKs in the current app version.
- Installed apps inventory is accessed for core app inventory and cleanup features.
- Usage Access is optional and used for app usage insights and cleanup recommendations.
- Speed test transfers temporary test data to speed.cloudflare.com only when the user starts a test.
- Theme and data-limit preferences are stored locally on device.

### Before submitting to Google Play

1. rnovatechsolutions@gmail.com, Thungesh S, Ravanth KV, and Channavadeyanapura village, Begur hobli, Gundlupet TQ, Chamarajanar – 571109.
2. Host the policy as an HTML/web page, not as a PDF or editable document.
3. Add the same privacy policy URL in Play Console > Policy > App content > Privacy Policy.
4. Add a link to the privacy policy inside the app if possible, for example in Tools or About.
5. Complete QUERY\_ALL\_PACKAGES declaration because the app uses broad app visibility for all-app list and cleanup functionality.
6. Complete the Data Safety form consistently with the hosted privacy policy.
