

Stress & Anxiety – Healthy Coping Strategies

Stress is a normal part of life, but kids can learn healthy ways to manage it. Deep breathing, movement breaks, and talking to a trusted adult are simple strategies that make a big difference. Encourage your student to notice

the signs of stress in their body, like a racing heart or tight muscles, so they can respond early with calming tools. Practicing these strategies regularly helps students feel more in control and builds resilience for the future.
