When you use Google to help you find information, do not just grab information from Google itself, make sure to open the website or article that is giving you the information and make sure that it looks trustworthy before using it.

Things to look for:

- Who wrote it? (a person, and organization?)
  - What are their qualifications? (do they work in that field? Ex: NASA scientist)
- Does the information look up-to-date? (check if there is a date it was written)
  - This is especially important if you are looking at animal populations as they change
- Does the information sound reasonable?
