Please represent our school with grace and dignity as you contact these organizations in planning your community service fulfillment.

Community Service hours must be done without compensation, at organizations or institutions that are considered *non-profit*.

Please do not submit the following activities to fulfill your community service requirement: babysitting, pet-sitting, yard work, helping a for-profit business, assisting neighbors and friends with chores, sport field snack stand fulfillment, household chores and family obligations. Seek out non-profit organizations and outside organizations that provide assistance to communities in need.

Students may begin earning hours the first day of summer break toward the following school year.

All community service forms (Community Service Hours (log)) must be completed, signed, and submitted to Mrs. Kern (via your classroom teacher) no later than May 15, 2026. No hours will be accepted after the due date.

Students in 5th complete five hours. Students in 6th, 7th and 8th complete ten hours.
