### Clothing/Cosmetics

Rebirth Garments offers "gender non-conforming wearables and accessories centering Non-binary, Trans, Disabled, and Mad Queers of all sizes and ages." In addition to custom-made clothing and accessible face masks, Rebirth Garments also offers free/reduced price clothing for queer, trans, and disabled youth and people in need.

<u>Uncommon Closet</u> is a custom clothing and tailoring service that primarily serves the LGBTQ+ community and those whose body types are commonly overlooked by mainstream clothing industries. Their prices are not advertised but they do say that they will work with you if you are tight on funds.

<u>Brave Space Alliance</u> has a Makeup Room (for cosmetics) and The Den (for trans-masculine gender-affirming items) that are open to BIPOC trans and queer folks and sex workers.

<u>DapperQ</u> is a digital magazine that leverages queer fashion as a form of visual activism. Many of the clothing sites they link to *are* expensive, but they do provide a lot of helpful free information on gender-affirming clothing and suiting.

#### **Gender Affirmation Products**
