What to consider putting in your presentation (please note you can add more information, here are just a few ideas to get you started!)

- Consider what inspired you to enter your career
- Education and training required (please emphasize importance of lifelong learning)
- Skills needed (Examples include: writing skills, interpersonal skills, proficiency in technology)
- Personality traits that help you excel at your job (introvert/ extrovert, analytical, creativity)
- Future Job Prospects
- Salary and benefits
- Challenges you face at your job
- Your favorite parts about your work
- How you balance work- home life
- Classes or extracurricular activities that led you or helped you in your career
- A day-in-the-life of you at work

## Other aspects you may choose to include

- How do you think your job will change in the next 10 years
- What shadow/ volunteer opportunities are available
- Future courses/ extracurriculars students interested in your field of study should take
- What are the demands (physical, mental, emotional) of your job
- What are the normal hours of your job (nights, days, weekends, holidays)
- If you were looking to hire someone in your field, what characteristics would you look for
- What are specific tools or technology is needed for your job
- Is your specific career limited to a geographic area or can it be done anywhere
- Advice you have for students interested in entering your field
- Products, examples, gear, or various work setting props or images
