Young Black Female Entrepreneurs, Inc. (YBFE) collaborates with schools, organizations, businesses, and community leaders to expand access to entrepreneurship, leadership, and economic empowerment opportunities for youth and families.

### **Program Partnerships**

Organizations host a YBFE program for their participants. YBFE provides curriculum, facilitators, and implementation support, while partners assist with space, recruitment, and program coordination.

### **Strategic & Community Partnerships**

Long-term collaborations focused on shared goals, community impact, and aligned missions. These partnerships often involve referrals, joint initiatives, and ongoing engagement.

### **Corporate Partnerships**

Businesses support YBFE through sponsorship, funding, employee engagement, or in-kind resources that strengthen programs and expand impact.

### **Referral Partnerships**

Schools, organizations, or individuals connect youth and families to YBFE programs and opportunities by sharing information and referring participants.

### **Event Collaborations**

Partners work with YBFE to co-host or support events such as workshops, showcases, and entrepreneurship summits, sharing promotion, planning, or resources.
