

Grizzly

What's up everybody and welcome back to Just Roll With It. I am the DM of this wonderful campaign Riptide named Grizzly and this is the first session with only one.

Bizly

Yes. My name is Bizly. I play Chip. And these are my wonderful fri...oh. [holds up a piece of paper] This is my friend Gillion and [holds up another piece of paper] this is my friend Jay. [wipes tears with paper]

Grizzly

I just wanna-

Bizly

And this is the scariest music I've ever heard in my life.

Grizzly

I was trying to put sad music on. Yes, yes, yes, yes.

Bizly

And I'm ready to die.

Grizzly

Yep. For some reason, unexpectedly, you decided to make the decision to split from the party and go into a dangerous place on your own. So here we are, seeing if you live or if at the end of the session, you're gonna have to bust out a new character sheet.

Bizly

Bro, I would too.

Grizzly

Who you gonna play whenever Chip, you know...

Bizly

I don't care about my life. I'll play Bingo Schmingledink.

Grizzly

Pirate Captain Sschmingledink.

Bizly

He's a shopkeep. He sells trinkets and items. Would you like to purchase this? [holds up a Redbull]

Grizzly

First, let's see how Chip story ends. I'm joking. You're gonna be fine. He's gonna be fine. He's gonna be fine. [laughs] I'm joking.

[intro music by Shady Cicada](transcribed by thelittlestjenna)

Grizzly

Where we last left off after you found Old Man Earl bleeding in an alley that set you up to be ambushed by a hadow blade drow sent by a figure from your past. A past you'd long repressed in your memory. A past you'd later set out on, on your own, to confront. And as you arrived in the Darkport heading for something called the Black Dock, you followed a figure similar to the one who made an attempt on your life into a secret location resembling a black market. And down to an eerie building where you were stopped by a person who warned you to turn back. As everyone who enters here surely has a price to be paid. And so your journey continues as you walk through the entrance formed by a hole in the wall of this run down building. The people lounging on the ground flanking the hallway like path. Also just as worn and tattered as the building itself, illuminated by the slight purple glow emanating from deeper within. As you get closer, you see and smell the fruity purple mist leaking from behind a portiere made of bright string lights. The sound of a bass-y kick drum getting louder and louder as you emerge into a room filled with all kinds of funk. Half dressed people bumping bodies in this crowded dimly lit chamber. Some slumped on the walls or in wooden booths with zombified expressions. The entire chamber filled with this mist and with this live jazz, funk fusion music. So in this room that's kind of filled with this, what sounds like saxophone type instruments and deep bass, as you're sort of trying to find a path through this crowded, through this room of crowded people.

Bizly

I'm just looking around if there's anybody I recognize in the room.

Grizzly

Roll a perception check. It's definitely hot and sweaty in here, but no one seems to care. Everyone seems to literally be lost within this space.

Bizly

That's a natural 20.

Grizzly

Oh, a natural 20. Jesus.

Bizly

Yeah.

Grizzly

Yes, easy enough. You're looking around for someone you recognize. And just because of the amount of faces, there doesn't seem to be anyone who resembles a face from back when you were at Skullslice Port if that's what you're looking for. But do see, what immediately attracts your eye, just a bit further down into this chamber, into this room near what looks to be almost like a bar, is this very, very beautiful woman. It seems that the second that you see her, your eyes make contact. As you're walking forward, she begins to start walking towards you as you're sort of being bumped in that direction. As she seamlessly makes her way through almost like water through a path of rocks towards you. You get face to face with this dark skinned elf with golden designs on their face mixed with the glowing paint that patterns their body and you both get bumped up right in front of each other.

Elf Woman NPC

You're not from around here, are you?

Chip

Maybe I am.

Grizzly

She starts to rub her hands around your shoulders and then like back beneath your neck and underneath your hair. Very, very close and a bit sensual, more than you were expecting.

Elf Woman NPC

This is a place you have to let go, darling. Free yourself from your own mind. Get lost with the rest of us.

Chip

Getting lost isn't really on the agenda today, but maybe I could make some time. No, no..

Grizzly

Go ahead actually, as you say that and make a wisdom save, she starts to stare deep into your eyes.

Bizly

That's a 16.

Grizzly

Everything around you begins to blur together except for this woman's face, as if the entire background behind her is just radial blur. And now she's the only thing in focus. And her words sink deep into your mind as she says,

Elf Woman NPC

Let go. Let go with the rest of us.

Chip

Let go...

Elf Woman NPC

Whatever you seek, I promise you'll find it if you just let go.

Chip

Whatever you say, pretty lady.

Grizzly

And your perception distorts more and more as even her own face begins to smear with the lights and colors of the area around you before it goes completely dark.

Chip

Is somebody erasing the world?

Grizzly

It goes completely dark and you fall unconscious. It feels, in a sense, and you would know this experience before. The mist around you has a familiar drug like smell. And the sensation is almost like blacking out from an intense influx of intoxicating substances. And it feels like you're on the Big Chipper, sailing by yourself, the waves around you gently swaying. And then it suddenly feels as if your boat has been hit by a large rock as you thud onto hardwood floor and you come back into consciousness unsure how many moments later in a new interior.

Bizly

Do I like, am I abruptly brought into consciousness or am I just like slowly kind of fading in?

Grizzly

Your eyes open abruptly, but everything is still blurry and it sort of comes in and out as you're trying to gain your bearings and get a sense of your new surroundings, which is slightly quieter. You can still hear the bassy thuds of the music coming from what, actually go ahead and roll perception one more time.

Bizly

Oh, that one's a four.

Grizzly

You're unsure at first if the music is coming from below or above or if it's mixing in with the much more calmer, almost like road keyboard sounding tunes that are coming from within this interior. And after a few more moments it does clear up. And you look up to your left and you see you're in a circular room much more dimly lit by this kind of like purplish hue with booths on both the

left and the right, with like poles in the middle and, and the, in these both male and female and in between dancers that are just provocatively providing services to these like special patrons who are getting, you know, drunk but, but calmly they look important. As you notice they're all kind of wearing the same sort of black feathered clothing, like the assassin wore that tried to jump you and your friends prior. Your eyes meet the middle, which is this large centerpiece platform and a much larger couch. It's kind of like a red velvet couch with golden ornaments or golden design and sitting on it, sort of hugged on by two figures, is a much more recognizable, though slightly different figure. Your vision starts to come much more clear and you can see them. They stand up and lean towards where you are, or sorry, they don't stand up, but they lean more towards where you are. You can just hear them say,

Reuben Price

Come on now, wakey wakey. I don't got all damn night.

Bizly

Would I recognize this to be...

Grizzly

Absolutely. The voice is, is it eerie? Unmistakable. The voice is unmistakable. Your old leader, Reuben Price and-

Bizly

Looking around at the room that he's kind of got around him. All these dancers, the feathered outfits. I'll look up to him.

Chip

You always did have a flair for the dramatic, Reuben, I'll give you that.

Reuben Price

[laughs] Oh, you can tell I've upgraded much since we last spoke.

Chip

I guess you kind of had to.

Grizzly

And who you are actually looking at, his outfit is much, much different. He has a much different body type. I'm just going to describe what you're looking at. Reuben Price. Captain Reuben Price is a bit scrawnier than you are, but his muscle definition is, like, inhuman. He's only a little taller than you are, but you know that he is a year older than you. He's always been a year older than you. He has this jet black swept back, sort of like spiky hair that gets all the way swept back to the neck with one of these long braids that comes down. Two strings of hair that flow just over the forehead. You also notice that he has new facial features as he has this long scar that goes from one cheek to the other over the bridge of the nose. And another scar, a much uglier gash that is just a blotchy scar that covers one side of the face and keeps one of his eyes permanently closed.

Bizly

Is that new to me?

Grizzly

Very, very new. Both scars are new. He's also wearing this black, sort of long, leather jacket with studs and designs on the shoulder pads and the same kind of raven feather collar that is like, much larger. Almost acts like the beginning of a cloak, in a sense. He has chains wrapped around his arms and these black leather fingerless gloves. And the leather jacket itself is completely open, revealing these two tattoos that start from somewhere in his red leather pants, and then climb all the way up the two sides of his torso and then up to his neck. And then you imagine it also climb or it also climbs down his arms as well. Seemingly both, like this kind of almost like Japanese dragon in our in our world, like Japanese dragon design. And just layered over those tattoos on his body, he has, like multiple chains, very long chains. The same kind of chain that's wrapped around one of his forearms. And he has this really nice stupid dress shoes. Like Stupid pattern dress shoes.

Bizly

[laughs] Awesome. Am I tied up right now?

Grizzly

No, actually. But you are basically surrounded. Yes.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

You're not tied up or anything. You are still kind of coming off of this foggy drug trip. That kind of puts you into a slumber. But you aren't tied up. You get the sense that there is no need to tie you up as you are outnumbered.

Chip

I like the place. Definitely an upgrade. Alright, where'd you get that one? That one looks new.

Reuben Price

Now we're getting right into the personal history. Why don't we catch up a little bit? Chip, my favorite kleptomaniac. It's been a while, hasn't it?

Chip

Not long enough.

Reuben Price

I am interested to hear what you've been up to.

Grizzly

And he kind of like the same hand that's holding the cigarette. He reaches into his back pocket and then flicks this like paper airplane or this parchment paper that's been folded into an airplane at you. And as it hits you, hits the ground. It is your wanted poster, essentially.

Chip

Little of this, little of that. You know how it is.

Reuben Price

You run away from the gang and suddenly become some kind of big shot. Making moves in the seas, causing ripples in the waves

Chip

By the looks of this. I'm not the one who thinks I'm a big shot. The Darkport? Why don't you just say evil place? Come on, man.

Chip

I didn't name this port. This port is actually what became after a certain ocean turned to black tar. You see, no one comes down here anymore since no one's allowed to exit into that ocean. I took that as an opportunity to set up new base after, well, [chuckles] you know what happened to the old one, don't you? Well, I'll cut right to the chase. I'm not here to be buddy buddy anymore, Chip.

Chip

Oh, but I was hoping maybe we could go out and get a pizza or something.

Reuben Price

The time for any kind of forgiveness for your betrayal have long passed. Although I did consider it, as I am a generous guy. Considering I took you under our wing and taught you everything you know. Kept you alive, scared, babbling little boy.

Reuben Price

Reuben, you only protected yourself and you know that.

Grizzly

And everyone just kind of like their eyes widen as the dancers stop. And he just stands up. And then flicks the cigarette onto the ground and steps on it. Like very aggressively, but trying to stay passive.

Reuben Price

It's Price. It's Captain Price now.

Chip

Oh, sorry, Captain Price.

Reuben Price

You will do well to learn the respect you never did. Before you open your stupid mouth again, I'm gonna cut to the chase now. You see, I knew the second you stepped into Allport. And while I am kind of shocked and surprised that you even survived on your own. The second I knew I could use you. I need something retrieved by only a master thief as yourself can acquire. And if you don't do it, everyone you love and care about will be dead before you ever step foot out of Allport.

Chip

Okay, okay, okay. Captain Price-

Grizzly

He sits down.

Chip

With all your vast resources, you need my help? That's what this is about? I was sure you were just gonna kill me.

Reuben Price

Oh, I absolutely could just find someone else to do it. But you see, Chip, this one's personal. The person you have to steal from, I know you're friends with. And anything I can do to get even with what you did to me...

Grizzly

He just kind of, like, sweeps a little bit of hair back around where the scar is.

Reuben Price

Well, I could kill you, that would be no fun.

Chip

Okay, what's the job?

Reuben Price

[laughs] That was easy. Care this much about people, don't you?

Chip

I didn't say I would do it. But anything to keep you away from me is probably worth it.

Reuben Price

Well, I'll consider leaving you alone if you actually manage to pull this off. There is an item in a particular magic shop my people have witnessed you enter and exit. An old dog runs the shop and is keeping something away from common folk not sold. And usually we just do a little bit of thieving ourselves to get things onto the black market. But this one I want for myself, and I want to make sure it's done right. It's an eye. That's what they say it looks like, you know, one of these.

Grizzly

He just kind of, like, opens up his eye, like, really wide and then lets it snap back down.

Chip

Yeah, I got the picture.

Reuben Price

Should be really easy for you.

Chip

Okay.

Bizly

I want to stand up at this point, if I was just kind of leaning down, is there anywhere around here that would have, like, a drink that I could grab? Water or anything like that, maybe somebody holding a drink?

Grizzly

Yeah, like I said in this sort of, like, circular-ish room, I mean, the wall behind you is like a straight wall, so it's more like a half circle. But yeah on the left and the right of Captain Price's platform, there are people drinking.

Bizly

So I want to kind of just walk along the room and as I'm walking, grab a drink out of just somebody's hand and continue speaking to him.

Grizzly

Sleight of hand check.

Bizly

Twenty-three.

Grizzly

You're able to just swiftly grab a drink and start drinking it before anyone even has a chance to react and when you do that, you see a smirk just creep across Captain Price's face.

Chip

So you want me to sneak in to Roofus' shop. He has a name by the way. And steal an eye for you. I guess that one you have under there is not working so well.

Reuben Price

[laughs] We got a funny guy. Yeah, I'm looking for a replacement. You don't need to know more about what it is or what it does. Just need you to get it from me.

Chip

Well.

Reuben Price

Whether you gotta lie to your old friend or take it right up from under his canine nose.

Chip

Here's what I don't understand, and hang with me here. Roofus is an old friend, you know, he could get a deal for me if I wanted it. And I'm sure it wouldn't even cost so much. And with all

your vast resources. I don't understand why you'd need me to steal it if you couldn't just buy it yourself. Unless you don't have it.

Reuben Price

I really hate having to repeat myself. I'll put it in terms your little bastard monkey brain can comprehend. This item isn't being sold. There is no price and therefore you're gonna take it from me. Or I am gonna take from you.

Chip

Let's get one thing straight Price, you're not taking anything from me. I think we both know that.

Reuben Price

Anything? What about that small child boy you walked the streets with? I recall him being there when one of...Crow, Crow. I sent Crow after you just to send a message. I'm actually quite surprised you had the balls to come meet me yourself. They said that cowering little boy was there helping you.

Chip

This isn't a problem of theirs, okay? You keep them out of it.

Reuben Price

Well let's not make it a problem of theirs.

Chip

We were all there. And Ollie, which is his name, was there too.

Reuben Price

Who you keep around you is none of my concern. Chip.

Chip

No, but it should be. Cause if you lay a finger on them you won't have either eye.

Reuben Price

Chip, you don't get it.

Grizzly

And he starts to walk down his platform and just get a little closer.

Reuben Price

I learned a lot from our experience together. And I learned that whenever there is someone as disloyal as you, an example has to be made so that the new people you keep around you don't make the same mistakes. And you can bet I've made plenty examples.

Chip

I know you don't have any problem with it. You betrayed me and yourself.

Reuben Price

I tire of rehashing old memories. What's it gonna be? I can have my people attack your ship before you even step out of this building. Or you can get on your little boat that you came in with and go do this easy job for me. Bring it back and have a good night's rest. Safe from any kind of me.

Chip

Seeing as you already know me well enough, what stops me from coming back with my crew? I know where you are now.

Reuben Price

Chip, if you don't return with that eye by yourself in the next hour, I will make sure your little child friend and anyone else who dares to get in their way lies cold and lifeless. People are watching you and I will know. You don't have many options here. Sure, you can come back after you've done the job for me, but I'd like to think that I'll be ready since you've so graciously given me your potential plan away.

Chip

If you know me so well, you already know what I would do. Yeah, I'll get you your eye.

Grizzly

He gets right up to your face and he's just like a little bit of an eye level above you and he just looks down and he puts his hand right where your stomach is.

Reuben Price

After this, all is forgiven and maybe we can one day share that drink.

Chip

For now I guess I have a date with an eye. So thank you.

Grizzly

You shake his hand.

Chip

I don't know, I didn't get your name.

Bizly

I'm just looking around at everybody.

Grizzly

Yeah, one of the people on the left is this like, it's another dark skinned elf, but it's a more masculine guy. He's very big, very built, very sharp, pointy ears, bald head. And he's got like tattoos that are covering the head and go down the face. And he's also wearing one of these coats with like raven feathers on it. But it's not leather. It's not like a cloak like the one that the other one that you met. And he just looks massive big. He's got these dark sunglasses. And then the one on the right or one of the notable figures on the right is actually another one of those drow elves that attacked you. Possibly the same one. But their hood is much over their cloak and they just have their legs crossed, arms crossed, kind of just keeping a watchful eye.

Chip

I'll be back, I guess. So stay big and scary while I'm gone and try not to kill anybody Reuben.

Reuben Price

[laughs] Always loved that sense of humor.

Grizzly

Do you shake his hand?

Bizly

No.

Grizzly

Okay.

Bizly

No way.

Grizzly

He wipes it on his torso.

Reuben Price

All right.

Grizzly

And you go, I guess, right?

Bizly

I just, I wanna...

Chip

See you around cyclops.

Bizly

And I go,

Chip

Ohhh.

Bizly

As I shut the door. If there's a door. If there's a door.

Grizzly

So-

Bizly

Or I sneak around the corner and say that.

Grizzly

It's more like around the corner, kind of like spiral staircase thing. And you head down and you actually make your way through the same kind of a club like interior. And at this point, because you've already failed to save, you have a bit more of an immunity to the gas or the mist that's kind of just surrounding the room. Everyone in here is like still succumb to the drug essentially. But you make your way through and you don't actually see...I will say that you would have seen the dark skinned elf that sort of kind of seduced or attempted seduction on you in the upstairs room where you were taken. And you head back out through the black market which you would gather at this point, it's the Black Dock, the whole market is the Black Dock. And you make your way through that little crevice that kind of has to duck under a secret wall and then through a tunnel or through an alleyway and then you're back into the normal streets of the Darkport. You head back to your little boat unless you say otherwise.

Bizly

I'd look around for any other possible ways to get here from the main area besides just any way, any entrance to the Darkport that's not water based. Like I wouldn't have to take a ship, but just take a stroll around, see if I can find anything.

Grizzly

Make an investigation. Actually this is looking around, so perception.

Bizly

You sure it couldn't be investigation? I'm investigating the area, looking for another way.

Grizzly

I'll let it be investigation.

Bizly

Yeah, big day, 18.

Grizzly

So like I said, these ports, these Barnacles, these suburbs are fairly big as it is, you know, like little mini cities around the big capital. But you would know that it would be a much longer walk than just taking a boat down one of the water lanes and then docking on the side of the Barnacle and making your way inwards on the town. But if you had the means, you could scale the wall that supports the Golden Circa Market that is the second level above all of the suburbs. But you wouldn't be able to use like, you would have to scale it like some way, like either rope or climbing or whatever because there is no pulley system, elevator or ladder that leads from the Darkport to the Golden Circa Market because they don't want anyone coming up there from the Darkport.

Bizly

So there is a way from the Golden Circa Market down to the Darkport?

Grizzly

Yeah.

Bizly

With like a rope or something.

Grizzly

Yeah, it's a pretty long climb, that's all. It's doable. I mean it's not too dangerous if you plan well.

Bizly

I'll just take note of that and go..

Grizzly

Yeah.

Bizly

With the boat.

Grizzly

Yeah. The walking would be like a few hours of time to get from this part of the city to the top again. And then just doing the boat, I'm gonna say it works like a car because of the water lanes, like flowing in the direction you want to go, making the boat much faster. I'll say it takes about 30 minutes to get from this part to underneath the hull again. You, I will say because the Riptide Pirates currently aren't at their boat or you don't actually have to sail past your ship, so you don't really get seen by anyone. And where are you heading?

Bizly

Probably back up to the boat right now, just real quickly.

Grizzly

Okay. If you're going back to your ship, then I definitely will say that they are still at Bed, Bolts, and Beyond.

You, you dock, get to the ship. Your friends aren't there.

Chip

Hey, guys. I'm back? Guys?

Grizzly

Except obviously you hear,

Alphonze

Captain Chip, Is that you?

Chip

Oh, shit. Oh, yeah. Yeah, it is. Where's Captain Jay and Captain Gillion?

Alphonze

Last I heard, they went on a search party for you. You's been gone for quite some time.

Chip

It hasn't been-

Alphonze

Old Man Earl is still in his comatose state, not waking up from the events that had happened.

Chip

All right. You know how long ago they left?

Alphonze

It has been approximately 1 hour and 12 minutes since they left the ship and went on a search party for you.

Chip

If they ask, they come back. Let them know I'm all right, just taking care of some things.

Alphonze

Will do, Captain. I will continue to watch the ship

Bizly

And I just like smack his metal body like [mime smacking Alphonze]

Grizzly

[dink, dink]

Chip

Thanks.

Alphonze

Yup.

Bizly

And I want to head off to, oh, shit, okay. I'd like to go to the Divine Barkanist.

Grizzly

Yep, you take the normal path, sort of heading up from underneath the hull here and emerging onto the second level, the streets of the Circa Market. And you take the curved street all the way down to the Divine Barkanist. It's very late right now, middle of the night, you don't pass your friends on the way.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

You don't even know where...I mean, we in meta know where they are, but like, you Chip wouldn't even know where they are or where the shop they went to is so. You don't pass them and you just head back to the Divine Barkanist, and it is closed. It's dark, dark interior, no lights.

Bizly

Okay, I'll slip in.

Grizzly

Alright, front door or...?

Bizly

So what I want to do is disguise myself as Roofus and pretty much lockpick the front door.

Grizzly

Brilliant. Go ahead and make stealth check.

Bizly

Yeah, it's a 24 on the stealth check.

Grizzly

Twenty-four is perfect. Now go ahead and roll, we're gonna do a lock picking. So you make a dex check with your proficiency bonus.

Bizly

Twenty-one.

Grizzly

Click click. You hear the mechanisms inside the door just open up and the hole it quietly just [errrr] and you're able to make your way in. And you quietly shut the door and you assume you're being as stealthy as possible. And you look just like Roofus. You're inside the interior of the Divine Barkanist.

Bizly

I want to look around for this eye.

Grizzly

You spend a while looking in the glass display case that is on the right side of the room and all of the shelves and different baubles that are hanging from metal grates on the ceiling. You're walking through, through this almost like jungle of magic items. It's so beautiful. I don't say you love this place, but his place is wondrous, like I've described. There's tables in the middle of the room. It's almost kind of this like two rectangles of the layout but like placed on top of each other to make it. It's hard to describe, but you look around and make investigation.

Bizly

That's a ten.

Grizzly

And nowhere around here does there seem to be some kind of eye. But you do know that behind this sort of like hanged curtain which I called a portiere earlier, which leads into like the back almost the office space of the Divine Barkanist. That's the only place you haven't looked. But in the actual shop front area, the floor, there is no eye or anything resembling an eye.

Bizly

I'll kind of like sneak behind the curtain.

Grizzly

So you start to walk into the back room of the Divine Barkanist where you have seen both Amber and Roofus kind of go back and forth from dealing with you as a customer and you walk down this narrow hallway. To the right there's like a little bathroom that's in a room. It's almost like an RV bathroom. It's so small. And then it opens up into the square room. And just before you enter you hear the sounds of [snoring]. And as you look you see in this wooden chair at this wooden desk that's mounted to the wall with this like these like beautiful, almost like firefly lights that are just kind of like floating around the room above a sleeping Roofus who has his hands or forearms on the desk and his head just kind of like conked out and tongue partially hanging out. He's got these two small little glasses that are hanging on the, the bridge of his snout. And then you do see he is kind of cuddling this magic item that resembles the eye.

Bizly

I drop the disguise self. Is there a way to cut on a light or something? Light a torch.

Grizzly

Yeah, there's like these oil lamps where you can twist and [whoosh].

Bizly

Yeah, I'll twist that and go up to him. Is he awake? Does he wake up to this light or is he just out?

Grizzly

He's out bro. He looks like he's like working overtime.

Bizly

I'm like, I start like,

Chip

Roofus.

Bizly

I start poking him.

Chip

Roofus.

Bizly

He doesn't wake up, so I start scratching behind his ear.

Grizzly

Yeah, yeah. At that point he's like leg starts to slam the floor a little bit. Dunk, dunk, dunk, dunk, dunk. And he's like,

Chip

Roofus.

Roofus

[yawns] Oh.

Chip

Hey buddy.

Roofus

[yawns] Chip is that...what are you doing here

Chip

Uh, in a little bit of a pickle. I was hoping you could help me out.

Roofus

[big yawn]

Chip

Oh, don't do that, okay. [yawns] Don't do that.

Roofus

You know, it's not very nice to break into someone's home.

Chip

Yeah, but I needed some help, and you're the only one who can help me.

Grizzly

And then he like, notices what he's working on and then just kind of like pushes it a little bit behind him and he like, stands in front of it.

Roofus

What can I do for you, young Chip?

Chip

Yeah, pretty sure it's got a lot to do with that, actually.

Roofus

I don't, I don't know what you're talking about.

Chip

The eye.

Roofus

The, huh? The what?

Chip

Captain Price?

Roofus

Who?

Chip

Or Reuben.

Roofus

Who? Rooo?

Chip

Oh sorry, Rooben.

Bizly

He starts to like, get a little closer and sniff. And then as he sniffs around your exterior, he comes back with this puzzled kind of concerned face.

Roofus

What you been doing around the Black...the Black Dock, Chip? Is everything okay?

Chip

Roofus, after the black Rose, I made some friends, just like we all did. Some of us made some nice friends. Some of us, some not so nice friends. I made some not so nice friends with a Captain Price, who you might know as scary guy down there in the Black Dock. He's gunning for that eye, Roofus and he wanted me to get it.

Roofus

Oh, no, no, no Chip.

Chip

Oh, yeah, yeah.

Roofus

Most people don't know. Rumors are spread around. Around about this Captain Price. But we don't get involved with those who are in the Darkport. Oh, no, no, sir we don't.

Chip

Roofus, he's involved with you. He sent me to take that from you.

Roofus

I guess the ruse is up.

Grizzly

And he like, just like pushes it from behind him.

Roofus

What would he want with this, our little doohickey?

Chip

Um, he might be missing an eye and I might have something to do with that.

Grizzly

You can see like on the desk, Roofus has this sprawled journal of notes and drawings and...

Chip

What is it? Why does he want this one so bad?

Roofus

Well, if he's from the Darkport in the Black Dock Chip, he's probably a very sinister person. And this is a very sinister item. And I'm afraid that it has a lot of dark power I can't seem to ascertain with my little snout, though. I've been studying and sniffing it out per request of Amber to try and figure out its capabilities and what we should do with it. That's part of our job, you know, Chip, we get these dangerous and powerful magic items-

Chip

Yeah, yeah, I understand, Roofus. I understand. I'm not going to take it from you and I'm not going to give it to him. Don't worry. That is safer in your hands than it ever would be in his but he's coming after my crew. I have to do something, and I can't show up there empty handed. I was hoping you could help me. Is there? You know, I at least wanted to understand what it was. But if you don't know, you know, you don't know.

Roofus

Well, its power seems to be quite dormant. Not very active, though I sense bits of, I smell scents of necrotic, but it isn't very powerful at the moment.

Chip

Well, Reuben's kind of a prick and power is something he gets off on. So if that thing's got power, he'll figure a way out to use it.

Roofus

I appreciate you telling me, but I shouldn't be involved. I almost wish you just took it from me. Though I understand-

Chip

No, you don't. Not after what he'll do. Look, I understand you don't want to be involved in anything. And I'd hate to, you know, involve Amber in anything either but we don't have many other options. I've got an idea, but it's kind of a long shot. I don't know what you're capable of. I don't know what Amber's capable of, and I don't have much time. Is there any way to fashion something else that's not this? A fake?

Grizzly

He's rubbing his eyebrows.

Chip

Or a way to take the power from this one?

Grizzly

Roll a persuasion check.

Roofus

If he doesn't get what he wants, he'll come and take it no matter what. I-

Chip

Roofus, we have the upper hand right now.

Roofus

I don't want Amber to be in danger.

Chip

We won't have that for long.

Bizly

But I did only roll a 12.

Alphonze

Well, Amber is the magical one. I just have the senses and the knowledge after traveling so long with the Black Rose, I just. Maybe there is a chance she could seal some of its power, cause it to curse the user. But that's a lot to ask out of dear Amber and I'd have to go retrieve her. It could work, I just, if he finds out what what we do. He'll come for all of us.

Chip

Then I'll handle it from there. Okay? I can take him if I need to. And he's not gonna stop after sending me.

Roofus

Hmm Chip, I believe in you, Chip. Whatever you'd like to do, I always put my crew first. So what is the plan?

Chip

Uh, well, we need Amber.

Grizzly

He nods and he sets the little sort of like box case that's almost like a ring holder, but it's holding the small spherical eyeball down on the desk. And then walks past you and puts his hand on your shoulder and says,

Roofus

You know, you're starting to remind me a lot of Mr. James, though, I think he would have tried to take them all himself. [laughs]

Chip

Oh, he would have. He would have got his ass handed to him. He would have looked really cool while he did it. Maybe I would look cool if I did that.

Roofus

I'll return here shortly.

Grizzly

And he softly walks.

Chip

Roofus,

Roofus

Mmh hmm?

Chip

Thank you.

Alphonze

Don't thank me yet.

Bizly

Did he leave the eye? I want to look at it. I just want to pick it up and take a peek.

Grizzly

Okay. Yeah, it's like this purplish, it's almost like a glass eyeball for people who don't have an eye, a replacement eye, except it has this purplish hue to it, but it's foggy.

Bizly

So I can't get anything off of it any way I could see-

Grizzly

Depends on what you're trying to discern.

Bizly

I want to know, like, what it can do if possible.

Grizzly

Go ahead and roll an arcana check.

Bizly

Never good at these, seven.

Grizzly

Yeah, well, you're not a magic person, per se, so your knowledge about the lore of magic items and whatnot is very, very small. I mean, it's really just anything that you might have heard growing up but...

Bizly

What about the writings in the book that he was writing down?

Grizzly

I'll say it's a different thing you're looking at. Go ahead and roll another investigation.

Bizly

Fourteen.

Grizzly

So Roofus seems to do a lot of, like, messy notes, kind of like scattered ideas and theories. And if something, one of his ideas is wrong, or if he gets a certain sniff wrong, it's scratched out. But what he has right now on the few pages that you kind of flip through, this eye has, like, he said, a necrotic, arcane presence. And it seems to be almost useless at the moment. The similar smell as he writes to other cursed or evil or objects that hold evil secrets, if you will. He's still keeping an eye, no pun intended, on it and trying to discern how you can either activate it because it hasn't been able to be activated. One of the theories is by having, like a another eye with it in order to activate it. Like, there's a pair, and this is just one of the pair. But at the moment, it's just. It doesn't do much other than exude that kind of arcane presence and that's about it. They both walk in and walk through the hallway one after another and you're just kind of sitting there twiddling your thumbs or whatever. Playing marbles with the eyeball.

Bizly

Yeah, just kind of playing around as they come in. I'll stand up quickly.

Chip

Hey, I'm so sorry. it's late.

Amber

To wake me up for something like this. If you're gonna put us all in danger, at least pay us first, jeez.

Chip

Well, hopefully I'll pay you in not letting this place get ruined.

Grizzly

And as she walks in, actually following her is little Apple, the bluebird, who flies onto your shoulders and just kind of sits.

Chip

Hey, did you figure anything out about Apple?

Amber

We'll get to that in a little.

Chip

Oh sure.

Amber

What do you want to do with this?

Chip

So I don't know how much Roofus explained to you, but we've got a bit of an issue.

Roofus

Well, Chip, I got quite the earful. She thought I was retired and then I told her about the evil man and she's-

Amber

Let us just get the problem fixed and we can all go to bed happy.

Chip

Yeah, we can have it be over with. But you're one of the best. I figured you...if anybody knew what to do, it would be you. Help me stop him.

Amber

Oh, dear boy, you don't need to worry about our safety. I have covered that plenty of times in the past. This is not the first time that someone's willing to rob the Divine Barkanist.

Chip

Okay, then.

Amber

I'm not just a creator of magic items. I'm also a mage. I can take care of ourselves. Though we are getting older, it is you I am worried about.

Chip

Maybe you don't do yourself a favor and just do me one. Got a lot of guys down there. A lot of them, a lot bigger than me. I am not that big. Amber, I'm really small compared to that guy. He was so big and he was bald and tattoos all over the head. That's gotta hurt, Amber. Think of the pain tolerance you have to have for tattoos on the top of your head.

Amber

Hush your mouth, boy as I think a little.

Chip

I got it on my neck and it really hurts.

Amber

It's not the size that matters anyways. You'll do well to remember that. We don't know enough about what this eye is. And I wish we had more time to study it before we attempted any sort of magics on it. But in this pressing time, desperate measures during desperate needs. I can put an enchantment on it that hopefully, if he ever uses it, causes severe backlash. I'm not really looking to kill a man...

Chip

No, no, just keep him from using it, that's all.

Amber

No matter what this power is that lies within this small eye like orb, I think if I can enchant it so that when used, it causes the user to essentially fall into permanent paralysis.

Chip

If the eye gets removed, will he be able to move again?

Amber

Think of it like driving a stake into a vampire's heart. I'm not sure how much lore you've read on the different beings of our world.

Chip

Yeah, totally, I've read those.

Bizly

I'm gonna roll history check.

Grizzly

[laughs] Roll history.

Bizly

Twelve.

Grizzly

Many documented monsters, bro. And you've seen. You've seen some when you were nine years old on the Riptide Pirates, like there are tons and tons of beasts and different monster-like humanoids. And that includes vampires. That also includes vampire pirates, though you've never met any.

Chip

Yeah, I understand the concept, but it's not. It's not going to kill him, is it?

Amber

He'll be able to see and hear, but he won't be able to move or talk. He won't be able to use his magic or his weapons. And since-

Chip

But he'll still have a life of some kind?

Amber

No, he won't be able to do anything with it. As soon as he uses it, the magic will wear off eventually. It'll just take some time.

Chip

So after a while he'll be okay. Okay, that's, yeah, let's do that.

Amber

Well, let's hope that the enchantment works, as I assume this is a rush order. You're going to be paying later?

Chip

As soon as possible. I'm sure Jay's got me.

Grizzly

You kind of watch as she sits down in this little wooden chair and you and Roofus both kind of look over her shoulders as she begins to crack her knuckles. And her fox-like ears just kind of

move in and out as she begins to work and this beautiful arcane green magic starts to flow within the air. And the fireflies that were illuminating the room also grow brighter. And more of them kind of go around all of you, as she draws these runes in the air and then implants it onto the desk. They create this almost like alchemy circle around the orb and she casts this as like a rushed ritual. And I have to roll, see if it works, though that information will not be disclosed to you.

Bizly

Oh, damn.

Grizzly

[laughs] Another half an hour or so maybe exactly an hour passes and she finishes up. Her forehead seems to be, or I guess the furrow is slightly damp as she's sweating from exuding so much power. And it finishes and she says

Amber

Okay. Okay, dear boy, I wish you the best of luck. I must return to sleep.

Chip

Yeah. Yes.

Amber

The incantation has taken hold.

Bizly

I give her a big hug.

Chip

Thank you so much. My crew thanks you. Probably. I don't know. They have no idea what's going on actually. Maybe I should tell them that. Eh, later. Thank you.

Amber

Just, we'll put it on your tab. If that is ever such a thing.

Chip

Yeah, yeah. I'll be back by.

Roofus

Not to worry. I'm sure they'll be back and they're very reliable people. I can sniff reliable people from a mile away. You have no...get some, let's go back I'll walk you home. I'll walk you home, dear.

Chip

You guys walk safe.

Roofus

I'm glad that you haven't grown into a guy like that.

Chip

Oh, me too.

Roofus

That warms my heart to see that you did a good job raising yourself. I wish we could have kept doing it for you.

Chip

Things happen. But hey, no time like the present. I could always become evil now.

Grizzly

[laughs]

Bizly

I just look at him for a second.

Grizzly

It's like dead silent.

Chip

Roofus, Roofus, I'm joking. I'm joking. Not gonna become evil. All right. Thank you again.

Roofus

Hasta luego.

Bizly

I leave.

Grizzly

Yeah. Which way are you heading back to the Darkport.

Bizly

I'd want to use rope to maybe tie around something sturdy.

Grizzly

Roll stealth again and then-

Bizly

Probably survival. Twenty-four on stealth, by the way.

Grizzly

Excellent. You are with the night, one with the shadows. You don't catch anyone notice you and you-

Bizly

Chip is the Batman.

Grizzly

Yeah. No, you feel very much in your element doing what you are doing being alone and stealth-ing. It feels natural. Go ahead and roll sleight of hand to see how well, you knot the rope.

Bizly

Thirteen.

Grizzly

Okay. And then for this, I mean, you have a climbing speed. So you'll just be climbing down with no check.

Bizly

Okay.

Grizzly

We'll do it like that. It's not a hard climb. You're just descending a rope.

Bizly

Yeah, I'll climb pretty slowly, carefully.

Grizzly

How long is your rope?

Bizly

I'm pretty sure 50 feet.

Grizzly

Thirty feet, this presents a problem because eventually you do run out of rope.

Bizly

Is there like a building I could get to from there?

Grizzly

Sure.

Bizly

Yeah, just like leap over to a building.

Grizzly

All right for that, make acrobatics.

Bizly

Yeah, 14.

Grizzly

So 14, the acrobatics is not to not take damage because this is going to be a far drop. It's just to reduce the damage. Instead of taking 14 damage, you'll take seven damage. Now, I assume you are making your way through the town of the Darkport and returning to where the Black Dock is. Eventually you do find it.

Bizly

Do I pass the old man again?

Grizzly

You do. And they. They reach out to grab you once again.

Bizly

Just kind of look over at him.

Chip

Second time's the charm, right?

Old Man NPC

Has your price been paid?

Chip

Uh, we're getting there.

Old Man NPC

I thought that once too and yet here I am.

Grizzly

He just kind of like sinks back into that corner that he's sitting on and you walk down the same path and into the same chambers. And you make your way right back in front of Captain Reuben Price, who is, you know, on one side, this beautiful tiefling and the other a drow.

Bizly

I wanna-

Grizzly

This room is now heavily filled with like cigarette smoke and stuff, tabacco smell.

Bizly

As I'm walking in.

Chip

All right, I did [coughs] I did it. Damn Reuben.

Reuben Price

Oh, Robin Hood is returned.

Chip

[coughs] Not for long.

Reuben Price

A few hours. I s that some kind of new record or...

Chip

Well, I work quick. That's why you wanted me, right?

Reuben Price

Curious. Did you have any trouble running into your old friends?

Chip

I took care of them.

Bizly

And I want to hold it in my hand. Are there still just as many people around?

Grizzly

It's just the, there is like two menacing figures on each side. And then like, what looks to be like, VIP patrons that fill up the rest of the couch. So only three or four like, goons, we'll put it that way.

Chip

You know, Reuben, you could have been so much better. You could have been so much more than this. There was a time when I looked up to you.

Grizzly

And you're saying this while, like, walking up the platform and now looking down on him.

Bizly

And I say,

Chip

Now you're just so small.

Grizzly

He takes this long drag. Just kind of brushes off what you're saying to him.

Reuben Price

If I valued your opinion, I would have asked for it.

Grizzly

And he takes the little orb and holds it up with his one eye.

Chip

I know the only opinion you ever valued was your own.

Reuben Price

Why don't you step back for me a little bit there, buddy?

Chip

I'll probably just stay right where I am.

Reuben Price

Okay.

Grizzly

And then he, like, opens that eye, that eye socket that's been, like, carved shut. And you can see now, like-

Bizly

Ugh.

Grizzly

That scar seems to be from a combination of a burn mark and, like, some heavy bludgeoning. And it is disgusting as he opens it up. I mean, it is like this red cavity. And he sort of like, basically bleeds crying a little bit. And you watch him as he's like, tilting his head back and the two figures next to him aren't even, like, budging. And he just starts to insert that eye into his own eyeball. And he presses it in, and as he does, he blinks a few times. He opens his eye, and this kind of like, what is like a cloudy with a little bit of purple hue then takes this form right in

front of you as you're looking of this natural purple with a reptilian slit of an eye, and it glows just a bit. And he smiles this, like, the most sinister smile that creeps across his face. And he looks at you and he says,

Reuben Price

Brilliant, just wonderful. Who knew the one who would take my sight from me would be the one to bring it back?

Chip

Eye for an eye, right?

Grizzly

You can almost see, like, these small little purple and green veins that go into the eye at that point. And he says,

Reuben Price

Yeah. [sniffs]

Grizzly

It's almost like he took a hit of cocaine as he's just, like, really, really-

Bizly

Bro took a bump. Bro's going crazy right now.

Grizzly

He's, like, really taking in this almost like, influx of energy. And he just sort of stands up, and you have to, like, meet his eyesight as he does. And as you guys, he's just a little bit above your eye level, and he's really close.

Reuben Price

What do you think? How do I look?

Chip

Still really gross, actually.

Reuben Price

[laughs] I'm gonna give it a little test, huh?

Grizzly

And then he quickly looks over to his left, and you watch as this purple eye glows. And then within an instant, this beam of black and purple energy fires out from it and strikes with one of the people sitting on the couch who are drinking from their drink and enjoying the dancing. And as that happens, this loud blast just [grssssh]. And you look and your head snaps over to watch, and you see this patron who wasn't a part of his own crew, but just someone who, like, one of the VIP patrons, disintegrates into dust. And at that very moment, as that happens, there's shock amongst everyone's face. And he begins to cackle.

Reuben Price

[cackling] Oh, this is great.

Grizzly

And then his whole body [wccch] locks up as you see his veins pulsate out of his neck and his cheeks, almost like, puff out and turn this bright purplish red. And then he sort of stands there, unable to move. But then the eye, the one eye, like, looks down towards you, and you can just see, like, this crazed, almost anger. And as he locks up the people, the two goons, or the three goons that are on the couches stand up in this sort of like panic, oh shit. something's happened to the captain. And they're about to start to rush towards you and attack.

Bizly

And attack?

Grizzly

Yes. They look like they quickly get up and just kind of like they see that their, their captain locks up and then he begins to like fall backwards in this straight almost stiff as a board and all the veins are like popping out of his neck and on his arms and he looks like he's just been completely locked up from the inside.

Chip

Whoa, whoa. I just gave him what he asked for. Are you not gonna help him?

Grizzly

They immediately like one of them rushes over to try and catch him from falling and they're like,

Goon NPC

Captain, captain!

Grizzly

And he's just not moving. He's just like, like his teeth are gritted. He can't move any muscles in his body. He just looks and all you can see is his eyes moving. All that happens is his eyes move and they're just dead locked staring at you as you're trying to back away. And then go ahead and roll a dexterity saving throw.

Bizly

Okay. Oh, it was just cocked, 12

Grizzly

The large dark skinned man rolls a natural 20 to fucking hit you.

Bizly

Dude, what the fuck?

Grizzly

At this point you're gonna take the damage, but I won't roll initiative unless you say you're running or staying okay?

Bizly

I'm...I'll stay.

Grizzly

Take 24 points of bludgeoning damage.

Bizly

Can I...you know sometimes when people lie.

Grizzly

Yeah, you're good. What's good?

Bizly

You know, so I just did one of those. I just lied, I'm gonna leave.

Grizzly

Alright so as soon as you get this burly terrifying man comes up and just strikes you with almost these kind of like studded gloves and it fucking almost caves in your chest cavity as you get sent flying back towards that flat wall. And you still see the glaring eyes, the one purple one and the one almost kind of like silver-ish grayish eye of Reuben Price as you, he's staring directly at you. And it just looks angry but he's completely paralyzed, can't say, can't move anything. And you dart around that corner and down the steps and you are making a break for it.

Bizly

I would actually like to...are they chasing me? Do I notice?

Grizzly

I mean if you're running for a little while, just make acrobatics again.

Bizly

Getting away, that's a 17.

Grizzly

Because of your nimbleness you're able to, you're able to dart away and out of this building if you want without anyone following.

Bizly

Yeah.

Grizzly

I mean like he goes for a strike but as soon as you dip like you gather that these, goons pretty much their attention goes right to their man, who's been downed. And you're able to get away if you want.

Bizly

Yeah, I wanna...I kind of wanted to dart away from this specific area and disguise myself as a random person from the crowd I would have seen. And I really just want to know what's going on in that room afterwards. Maybe get an idea.

Grizzly

So you want to try and disguise self and then go back up to where Reuben is?

Bizly

Pretty much.

Grizzly

For this, you know what I'll say, just roll one last stealth check.

Bizly

Natural one.

Grizzly

Oh a natural one.

Bizly

I walk back in [whistles] and I'm like looking at Reuben just trying to see what's going on. Very like nervously, walking "casually".

Grizzly

You try to disguise self. And as soon as you walk in, the person who you disguise yourself as looks up and sees you as they're kind of like routed around Reuben. And then they point and shout and the same big man gets his attention.

Bizly

They point and shout, what?

Black Dock Patron

Imposter!

Chip

Imposter! Shit.

Bizly

And I run.

Grizzly

Pretty much at that point as you walked back in, it looked like they were crowded around Mr. Price, Captain Price, as he's just like laid on that couch. The two companions next to him were just like looking around fearfully. And the dancers had all run away. And the other patrons, because they didn't want to get disintegrated like the VIP patron, they also ran and they kind of bummed at you as you like walked back in. You run away, I'll say with your same check you're able to escape. Looking behind, you don't think you were followed and you make your way...where do you go after you run out of the building and out of the black market.

Bizly

I want to lose any kind of tails on me and see if there's a ferry that can take me back.

Grizzly

Yeah, easy enough. For a ferry out of the Darkport, it's just four silver pieces.

Bizly

Okay, that's fine.

Grizzly

By some, guy who's trying to make his way from the port across and either removing the cloak you stole or keeping it up.

Bizly

Probably just leaving it in the water.

Grizzly

You ride this boat as a like a little taxi cab back to the hull, the center of Allport. Doing, done something to hopefully reunite with your friends. And that's where we end the session.

Bizly

[claps] Yes.

Grizzly

Yes.

Bizly

That was cool. That was fun.

Grizzly

It was cool and it was fun. I agree.

Bizly

But we won't talk about it on Just Rolled With It. We're not doing that for this.

Grizzly

Nope, nope. I don't even know if we should tell the other guys what's happened.

Bizly

No, I mean, I would maybe as Chip.

Grizzly

Yeah, I think you can do that.

Bizly

Yeah, we'll leave that for an in character.

Grizzly

If you say everything as Chip, then we can talk about this in the next Just Rolled. But anything you leave out, we just won't talk about. I hope you guys enjoyed this special Chip episode. You know, if the other party members do something stupid like go out on their own, maybe they'll get their own.

Bizly

[laughs] I thought I was kind of smart this time.

Grizzly

Yeah, no, it was cool.

Bizly

Like a little bit.

Grizzly

It was really cool.

Bizly

It ws really cool.

Grizzly

I mean, if you hadn't had Amber wake up in the middle of night and try and, like, put enchantment on this eye. Ooof.

Bizly

There's, like, no other way I could have taken this guy.

Grizzly

I don't think you really made amends this way but we'll see.

Bizly

No, fuck that guy.

Grizzly

[laughs] For sure.

Bizly

Fuck that guy.

Grizzly

No, all good. All good. It was really interesting and super cool.

Bizly

Reuben. Imagine being named Reuben.

Grizzly

I know, right?

Bizly

You come out the womb, your mama name you Reuben. Damn.

Grizzly

Bro I almost named him Robin. I switched it.

Bizly

Robin would have been cooler than, like, no, it fit him so perfectly. That motherfucker is a Reuben.

Grizzly

I know. Like, he's so close to having the perfect thieves name Robin Price.

Bizly

Robin Price, he was so close.

Grizzly

I switched it to Reuben because I was like, that sounds more like a dickhead name than Robin.

Bizly

Oh he's such a prick. I don't like him.

Grizzly

Yeah, yeah.

Bizly

In the best way possible.

Grizzly

I'm glad, bro.

Bizly

Alright, thanks for watching.

Grizzly

I hope you guys enjoyed.

Bizly

See you on the next episode.

Grizzly

Make sure to go to Patreon. Bye.

Bizly

Go there, give us money. Goodbye.

Grizzly

See ya.

Charlie
