How can I search for the latest material in StarPlus? Video Accessibility Transcript

The user starts in StarPlus, and searches 'biodiversity'. They navigate to the Refine My results filters on the left-hand side of the page search, then expand the New Records filter drop-down menu to show the options available. They are "New From Last 3 Months", "New From Last Month", and "New From Last Week".

Caption text & voiceover: There are several ways to find the latest material in StarPlus. Once you have entered your search term, you can use the Refine My Results menu to filter via New Records. This gives you the option to view results that are new to StarPlus in either the last week, the last month, or the last three months.

The user removes the "New Records" filter and scrolls down to 'Date' in Refine My Results. They expand this dropdown menu, and enter 2020 under "From" before clicking "Refine" and scrolling to browse results.

Caption text & voiceover: Another option for finding the newest material in StarPlus is to use the 'Refine My Results' menu to filter by date. You can use this tool to filter results between certain dates.

The user scrolls back up to the top of the page to click on the "Sort By" dropdown menu under the Refine My Results filter on the left hand side. The user clicks on "Date Newest".

Caption text & voiceover: You can also sort your results by "Date Newest" using the "Sort" dropdown menu. You can use these filters in combination with any other filters available in the Refine My Results menu.

The user navigates back to the StarPlus homepage by clicking on the StarPlus logo at the top of the page, and scrolls down to click on the Database A-Z. They click on E and scroll the results.

Caption text & voiceover: If you're looking for the latest research published in your subject area, consider expanding your search using a database.
