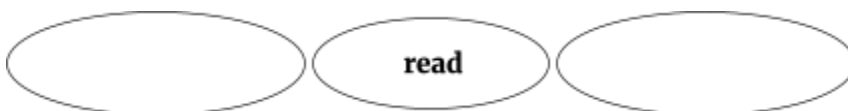

The *Vande Bharat Express*, formerly known as Train 18, is a semi-high-speed, electric multiple-unit train operated by Indian Railways. It was designed and manufactured by the government-owned Integral Coach Factory, located in Chennai.

On 27 January 2019, Train 18 was renamed to *Vande Bharat Express* to honour the fact that the train was manufactured entirely in India for covering distances of 500 kms to 750 kms. It was designed with the vision of low-cost maintenance and cost optimization in mind. It began operations on 15 February 2019. The cost of a single rolling stock is about ₹115 crore (US\$14 million), however, the cost can potentially be reduced if mass production begins.

As part of the "Make in India" initiative, the Integral Coach Factory (ICF), under the direction of Sudhanshu Mani, created and produced the Vande Bharat.^{[47][48]} It was originally called "Train 18". On 26 January 2019, Railway Minister Piyush Goyal announced that the train would be named the Vande Bharat Express.
