

Jerusalem's Separation Wall

The Separation Wall in Jerusalem-Al Quds was constructed in the last decade as part of the larger barrier being constructed in the West Bank. It now serves as the new boundary of the city separating it from the neighboring West Bank towns and cities. Since its construction it has become a major point of controversy between its opponents and proponents and a pivotal part of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and life in the city.

Our tour will start with a historical overview of the Israeli –Palestinian conflict focusing on Jerusalem and the Wall. During the briefing we will focus on the discussion and debate surrounding the wall using maps, videos and facts, We will follow this by walking down to Jerusalem's old borderline examining the division between the East and West Jerusalem. From there will travel by Palestinian public bus to the to the Separation Wall in Abu-Dis neighborhood where we will learn of the affects of the wall on the communities where it was built and on the political reality in Israel/Palestine



The tour will provide a great introduction to the Israeli Palestinian conflict and the wall in Jerusalem for those who are new to the conflict and an opportunity for those who are more experienced to deepen their knowledge of the situation and enrich it with meaningful encounters on the ground. The tour will allow us to peak into life in this divided city as well as engage in its hardships, challenges and hopeful possibilities.
