	A policy of extending a country's power and influence over other areas through government or military force.	
	An area under the complete control of another country and settlers from the mother country come to the colony to live.	
	A region in which a foreign nation has control over trade and other activities (the area does not officially belong to another country).	
	A country that is independent (sovereign), but under the protection of another country (military).	
	A meeting in 1884-1885 at which representatives of European nations agreed upon rules for the European colonization of Africa.	
	A policy in which a nation forces or encourages a subjected people to adopt its institutions and customs.	
	The supposed responsibility of the white race to provide care for their non-white subjects.	
	The application of Charles Darwin's ideas about evolution and "survival of the fittest" to human societies. Made the claim that some races are biologically superior to others.	

	The act of making some area of land or water more profitable or productive or useful.	
	The policy of granting equal trade opportunities to all countries.	
	A process by which regional economies, societies, and cultures have become integrated through a global network of communication, transportation, and trade.	
	People and/or businesses depending on or helping each other.
