We are about seventy-five percent through Federal/State CAASPP Exams. The students take the exams seriously and we look forward to receiving results over the summer. Many thanks to parents for prioritizing punctual attendance, to teachers for leading this big task, and to our dedicated students for giving it the best. Instructional Assistants and volunteers help teachers to run small project-based learning centers that truly engage our young learners. More funding is key to maintain our IAs in 2023 -2024. ### **Student Birthday Parties**

May 19th - submit Nomination Form

Nomination Forms may be turned into the office or to the Election Committee.

The Election Committee will list all nominees on the ballot.

May 22nd - The ballot will be sent in the Principal's Newsletter the week of May 22nd.

May 31st - Paper ballots are due. Ballots may be turned into the office or to the Election Committee. Ballots will be tallied by the Election Committee and the winning nominees will be notified first and then announced to the school in the Principal's Newsletter.

### **Guidelines:**

Each parent/guardian seeking election must be nominated or self-nominated in writing, must have a child enrolled in the school and must declare that he or she is not employed at the school.

Each parent/guardian of a student enrolled in the school shall be entitled to one vote for each vacant

parent/community membership on the School Site Council.

For the 2023-24 school year, there are two parent/guardian vacancies. The Election Committee consists of three members of the current SSC, none of which are currently up for election, (Erin Garnero, Melanie Heseker and Jennifer Owhadi). (FAQ: What has SSC done the last year?)

Thank you to the seventeen (17) families who were able to voluntarily donate to the 5th Grade Overnight Trip to Pali Camp for the 2023 - 2024

school year. **We have already collected \$7,130!** We need \$6,847.50 by June 20 to keep our

reservation. We made our first goal!

We have secured our spot from October 18th-October 20th. Make your donation via the <a href="https://example.com/PTA website store">PTA website store</a> in lieu of fundraising for now.

This will help us to know which families are attending MES next year and which families are able to donate. The voluntary donation amount per student is \$460. This covers the bus to the camp, lodging, meals, instruction, and supervision personnel. You may make two installments of \$230 if that works better for your family. The first payment to the camp is due June 20. The last installment of \$6,847.50 will be due September 18. Therefore please make your donation by May 31 and August. ### **Private School Recommendation Letters**

As a district we are respectfully declining to write letters of recommendation for students applying to private schools. We want to best use our limited time and resources for activities that impact all of our students in our schools. Writing letters takes us away from our work with our students.

If you are applying to a private school for your child, we will send a form letter to the school explaining our reasoning, and that the district's lack of recommendation letter in no way suggests a negative reflection of your children. Teachers will not be completing recommendation letters nor will they be completing any checklists. We can provide report cards, and any information already in your child's file; however, teachers will not create any new information or provide anytype of recommendation for private schools.

We believe students who have attended MES are well positioned to be a positive addition to any school community— and we hope you will all continue to consider SMMUSD school options as wonderful learning environments for your children.
