



**\$500 High School Senior and
College/Technical Student
SkillsUSA Nebraska Alumni Association
Scholarships**

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded at the state conference. One will go to a high school senior and the other to a post-secondary student. Students who are not state officers may apply for these scholarships.

Scholarship Details and Criteria:

1. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded:
 - a. High School Senior Scholarship: Awarded to a high school senior who plans to pursue post-secondary education.
 - b. College/Technical Student Scholarship: Awarded to a student currently enrolled in a college or technical institution.
2. Eligibility Requirements:
 - a. The applicant must be a SkillsUSA national member.
 - b. The applicant must register and attend the upcoming SkillsUSA Nebraska Leadership and Skills Conference.
 - c. Scholarships must be used at a post-secondary institution with an active SkillsUSA Chapter.
3. For High School Seniors:
 - a. Must enroll in and attend an associate degree program at a post-secondary institution or a four-year college.
 - b. Upon completing their first semester of coursework, the student must submit proof of enrollment and a grade transcript.
 - c. Once proof is submitted, a \$500 check will be sent directly to the student.
4. For College/Technical Students:
 - a. Must currently attend a college or technical institution.
 - b. After receiving the scholarship at the state conference, the student must submit a grade transcript for the following semester.
 - c. Once proof is submitted, a \$500 check will be sent directly to the student.

Application Process:

5. Complete the application form and upload the advisor's recommendation using the [SkillsUSA Nebraska Alumni Association Scholarship Form](#).

Important Notes:

6. Failure to meet the stated requirements will result in **disqualification**.
7. **No exceptions** will be made to the March 7 submission deadline for the application year.
