

Sight Word Practice

Level 4

Assignment Purpose

Increase the student's working knowledge of sight words.

Teacher Instructions

1. Make a copy of the activity sheet and fill in the Word Bank and all of the boxes in column #1 with the same 5 sight words. In column #3 write scrambled sentences using 1 of the 5 sight words for each sentence.
2. Print out a copy of the activity sheet for each student.
3. Review the 4-step instructions.
4. Students will start a Paper Live Help session with a Reading/English Language Arts tutor and send a picture of the activity sheet using the Camera in the Classroom.
5. Students will work independently with their tutor to complete the activity.
6. Once a student has completed the entire sheet, they will send another picture to their tutor using the Camera in the Classroom for feedback.
