

Transfer Guide for: Tillamook Bay Community College

George Fox University Bachelor of Science in Education – Elementary Education Track

**Note:** Tillamook Bay Community College is on a quarter system, while George Fox is on a semester system. **Any credit taken at TBCC will be worth 2/3 credit at George Fox.** Remember to take this into consideration when figuring out how many credits will transfer from TBCC.

**Transfer Overview:** A maximum of **135 quarter** or **90 semester** hours will be accepted from community colleges.

- a. Only coursework with a grade of "C-" or better will be accepted.
- b. Courses must be 100-level or higher
- c. One quarter credit = 0.67 semester credit

## **Elective Courses:**

In addition to the credits listed above, a minimum of 19 semester credits of electives will be required in order to meet the minimum number of credits to graduate with a Bachelor's in Elementary Education.

## A note on the AAOT:

Completion of an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree (AAOT) or comparable degree will result in a block transfer to George Fox, meaning all general education courses will be considered complete.
