Troop presenter preparation:

- 1. Read and familiarize yourself with the Troop Anti-Drug material
- 2. Read material on the website https://drugfreeworld.org
- 3. Print out enough "Troop 201 Drug Free Family Contracts."
- Print out the "Troop Pledge Poster Truth About Drugs"

Troop Lesson Plan

- 1. Small introduction of what we are going to discuss over the next couple of weeks.
- Read the KEY WORD DEFINITIONS FROM THE MARIJUANA DOCUMENTARY AND PSA. These keywords are important for the Scouts to understand before they watch the ads.
- 3. With the DVD watch the ads section or download the videos from a drug free world website.
- 4. Play all the (a series of 13 public service announcements on different drugs will play in sequence for 12 minutes.)
- 5. Discussion: After the ads play, have a short discussion. You can ask:
 - 5.1. Which ads struck you the most?
 - 5.2. Did you see or hear something that was new?
 - 5.3. Other than movies, have you seen others affected by drugs? If so, what did you notice?
- 6. Watch selection 2 "Marijuana (9 minutes)."
- 7. After the marijuana chapter plays, have a short discussion. Questions you can ask:
 - 7.1. What stood out most in your mind watching the video?
 - 7.2. Do you think marijuana is addictive?
 - 7.3. Can marijuana abuse lead the way to abusing other addictive drugs? If so, why?
 - 7.4. What are some of the ways marijuana can harm you?
 - 7.5. What would you tell your friends about experimenting with marijuana?
- 8. Guest speakers from the Maywood drug program to give their experiences. May be able to connect with Maywood's drug program to ask for speakers.
 - 8.1. Give their experiences of what got them into drugs.
 - 8.2. What were some triggers and how should they be avoided?
 - 8.3. What are the real consequences?
 - 8.4. Give scouts what they should hear at their age about drugs.
 - 8.5. What would the speaker wish someone would have told them about drugs and how to avoid them.
 - 8.6. Give practical examples of when they are in a situation where they are pressured to use drugs and what should they do?
- 9. Hand out the Troop 201 Drug Free Family Contracts.
 - Have scouts return the contracts signed by themselves and their parents.
- Have scouts and leaders sign the "Troop Pledge Poster Truth About Drugs"
