How to Interpret Your Birth Chart: The Three Pillars Method



Introduction:

Many people live their lives without examining the "why" of what makes them act the way that they do, and oh how I envy this group of people! Imagine going about your daily business, being perfectly content, not constantly examining yourself, worrying about work and relationships, and being able to completely focus on the task at hand.

Well sorry to burst your bubble, but this group of people doesn't exist. Everyone has their share of worries to some degree, even those who are great at pretending like they don't. For every trip abroad or party you see people at, there's jet lag or a hangover after, and the cycle just repeats itself. Nothing you see in this world is perfect no matter how it may look. The bottom line is no one truly knows what we're doing on this rock floating through space, and most people go through their daily ins and outs without thinking about this question.

I started looking up astrology about a year ago. At first I read daily horoscopes for just my sun sign (Capricorn), and found some of them to be shockingly accurate. For example, one day my horoscope was along the lines of "you will be put off by an obstacle early on, but the adventure awaits". What happened that day was my roommates' alarm went off at 10 AM, and he had left and locked the door so I couldn't turn it off, but then I got myself together, walked into a random party by myself, and had a blast. At that point, I felt as if there was something true about astrology, and continued to go further down the research rabbit hole.

After a year of being in the rabbit hole, I will say that most astrology articles online are BS and give it a bad reputation. To get accurate results from astrology, you not only have to know your sun sign, but which signs and houses all of your celestial bodies lie in. You also have to know what all of the signs, bodies, and houses represent. The astrological signs, celestial bodies, and 12 houses are the three pillars of knowledge you need to learn to correctly interpret your birth chart.

In the zodiac wheel, there exists 12 signs, and wherever your birthday is reveals your sun sign. This is a table of each sign and their corresponding birth dates.



I was born on December 25th, so I am a Capricorn. My symbol is "the goat" (LeBron James is also a Capricorn. Coincidence? I think not), and I am an earth sign. Since I was born on the 25th, that means I am an early Capricorn and may exhibit some qualities of my neighboring sign, Saggitarius. If you are born on the 21st, 22nd, or 23rd of a month, you are "on the cusp" which means that you may exhibit qualities of two signs. One of my first memories dealing with astrology was when a couple of conceited girls asked me when my birthday was, and they told me Capricorn was a "bad" sign, which probably delayed me from getting more into it at the time. Throughout this reading, please keep in mind that each sign has both pros and cons, and no signs are inherently "bad" or "good".

The qualities that influence each sign include their elements (fire, earth, air, and water) and their modalities (cardinal, fixed, and mutable). Fire signs (Aries, Leo, and Saggitarius) are passionate and enthusiastic, but can be reckless. Earth signs (Taurus, Virgo, and Capricorn) are matter-of-fact and productive, but can be dull and stuck in reality. Air signs (Gemini, Libra, and Aquarius) are curious and can come up with great ideas, but have the tendency to escape reality. Water signs (Cancer, Scorpio, and Pisces) are great on picking up others' emotions and compassionate, but can get caught up in their own feels.

Cardinal signs mark the beginning of each solstice. They are Aries (beginning of Spring), Cancer (beginning of Summer), Libra (beginning of Fall), and Capricorn (beginning of Winter). Cardinal signs' best qualities are leadership and being energetic, but they are much better at initiating plans and projects than seeing them through. Fixed signs mark the middle of each solstice. They are Taurus (middle of Spring), Leo (middle of Summer), Scorpio (middle of Fall), and Aquarius (middle of Winter). Fixed signs' best qualities are their focus and determination to see projects through, but they have trouble being adaptable once they have an idea. Mutable signs mark the end of each solstice. They are Gemini (end of Spring), Virgo (end of Summer), Saggitarius (end of Fall), and Pisces (end of Winter). Mutable signs' best qualities are their ability to adapt to new situations and to be diplomatic, but they can be unreliable and flaky.

After reading about the elements and modalities, you might think "Oh no! I'm an earth sign so I must be boring!", or "Oh no! I'm a cardinal sign so I'm not able to finish any projects!". This is why the most common misconception in astrology must be weeded out, which is your sun sign isn't the only thing that influences you. Each person has separate signs in their birth chart that correspond to each planet, so you are not only your sun sign. Not every trait of your sun sign may apply to you because of other celestial influences. To fully understand your birth chart, you will have to read this whole guide, but I will provide an example of a birth chart at the beginning to show how there are many other influences than just your sun sign.



The image above is my birth chart. As you can see, I am more than just a Capricorn although that's my sun sign. I have two planets each in Aries, Saggitarius, and Aquarius, so I have a lot of influences from those signs as well. This is why it is a horrible thing to judge someone only based off of their sun sign- because the complete birth chart is necessary in order to tell the whole story.

However, when they feel as if no one is listening to them, they can get upset and withdraw. They are definitely not a boring sign and when they are absent, things can seem dull. Aries high-energy personality may not work as well in some situations, such as completing longer tasks or dealing with routines, as they can become restless. If they are not seeing immediate results from their work or a project, they might abandon it easily. Most Aries love competitions, and playing a sport or game can be a great way for them to blow off steam. However, if you upset them, they are not afraid to tell you how they really feel. Art, music, and movies are generally some of these signs' favorite activities, and many have great artistic talent themselves. However, in mundane situations, they tend to zone out and daydream. When someone befriends a Pisces, they can be clingy and overly rely on them. And when something bad happens to a Pisces, they can have a hard time getting over it and withdraw themselves until the pain is healed. At their best, Pisces can bring everyone in a room together with their unconditional, selfless love.



Having knowledge of each signs' traits is one of the three pillars of what it takes to truly know astrology. The next pillar is figuring out the meaning of each celestial body!

In my birth chart below, each symbol represents a celestial body. Many of them are the planets we know and love (and yes, Pluto is a planet for astrological purposes), but other important celestial bodies include your ascendant, moon, chiron, true node, and midheaven. Your sun, ascendant, and moon signs are the most significant celestial bodies in your birth chart.

Depending on what signs your planets are in, they can either be in domicile, exaltation, detriment, or fall. Domicile means that the planet is ruled by the sign that it is in, so its influence in your birth chart will be strengthened. Exaltation means that the planet is "at home" in the sign that it resides, so its influence in your birth chart will also be strengthened. The opposite of domicile is detriment, and the opposite of exaltation is fall, so if a planet is in detriment or fall it may function in an atypical way.

Before reading about the placements of celestial bodies, go to www.astro.com and enter your date, time, and location of birth to calculate your natal chart like the one I have below. It will tell you which signs each celestial body of yours is in so when reading about the placements, you know which ones apply to you!



Sun:

In astronomy, the sun is a giant star that is at the center of the solar system that all of the other planets orbit around. It takes one year to go through all 12 signs, and stays in each sign for about a month. Think of your sun sign as the leader of your birth chart, so it has the most influence your identity. It represents your sense of self, and is the mode in which all of your other celestial bodies operate. For example, let's say your sun is in Capricorn and your Mercury is in Sagittarius. Mercury (the planet of communication, learning, and thought) being in Sagittarius (the sign of philosophy and looks at the bigger picture) means that you will have an interest in learning and thinking about philosophy-based topics. With your sun being in Capricorn, being an earth sign and the sign of professionalism and hard work, you may be interested in philosophy-based topics that have a practical use (earth sign) and use this knowledge in a professional realm while working hard at it. Basically, your celestial bodies will all function in a "Capricorn" way if your sun is in Capricorn.

While the sun signs' traits were all described earlier, the sun is in domicile in Leo, exaltation in Aries, detriment in Aquarius, and fall in Libra. Therefore, your celestial bodies will operate in more of a "Leo" or "Aries" way if your sun is in either of those signs, which takes some of the emphasis off of the sign of each celestial body. For example, if you are a Leo or Aries sun with your Mercury in Scorpio, there might be a little more Leo or Aries influence on your Mercury than if you were a different sun sign. If your sun is in Aquarius or Libra, they will have less influence on your celestial bodies. For example, if your Mercury is in Scorpio and you are an Aquarius or Libra sun, there would be less Aquarius or Libra influence on your Mercury and it would operate in more of a "Scorpio" way.

Ascendant:

In terms of astronomy, your ascendant is what the sign was on the Eastern horizon when you were born. It changes signs every two hours, the quickest out of any celestial body, so knowing your exact birth time and place is key to calculating a correct ascendant sign. Your ascendant sign controls how others perceive you and the type of energy you give off. When you are in a situation that involves meeting others for the first time, you may exhibit more traits of your ascendant sign than your sun sign. In addition, it can control your physical features and the type of look you want to portray. As people get to know you, your rising sign may become less and less of an influence and the rest of your chart will show more. Because the ascendant does not rule any signs, it is not considered to be in domicile, exaltation, detriment, or fall in any sign.

Aries Ascendant:

People with an Aries ascendant come off as energetic, independent, direct, and hasty. They will speak and walk quickly and go through things at an accelerated pace. They tend to be fans of exercise, have masculine-looking bodily features, and their skin has a tendency to become red.

Taurus Ascendant:

People with a Taurus ascendant come off as relaxed, responsible, cautious, and take things at a slower pace. They value material possessions and enjoy sensual pleasures. Some physical features of Taurus ascendants include a full and strong figure like an oak tree, deeper voice, and large eyes. Unlike an Aries ascendant, Taurus ascendants are content with staying in one place for a while and do not need much movement.

Gemini Ascendant:

People with a Gemini ascendant come off as curious, analytical, impatient, and they ask lots of questions. They may speak quickly, use a lot of gestures, and speak in a higher pitched voice. Physically, Gemini ascendants may have a narrow face and can be prone to nervousness

and twitching. Unlike a Taurus ascendant, they are more focused on intellectual than material pleasures and as a result may be slimmer and weaker than your average person.

Cancer Ascendant:

People with a Cancer ascendant come off as sympathetic, nurturing, gentle, and can be shy. They may be more feminine in appearance with rounded cheeks, pale skin, tender bodies, and they are prone to indigestion. Since they are ruled by the moon, they can be moody and have a tendency for cozy home-like environments. Unlike a Gemini ascendant, they prioritize food which can lead to being talented chefs.

Leo Ascendant:

People with a Leo ascendant come off as loyal, theatrical, generous, and can yearn to be the center of attention. They tend to have robust, masculine-looking bodies with broad shoulders and strong foreheads. Since they are ruled by the sun, they enjoy showing off and socializing, have natural confidence, and do not mind looking in the mirror. Unlike Cancer ascendants who tend to be pale, Leo ascendants tend to have wheat or tan colored skin.

Virgo Ascendant:

People with a Virgo ascendant come off as analytical, pensive, perfectionist, and can be cynical. Being ruled by Mercury, they are very thoughtful like Gemini ascendants, but do not speak as much because they are busy filtering and analyzing the details that come their way. They tend to dress on the plain side, have smaller faces, average height and weight, and they like to stick to a certain routine regarding eating and exercising. Unlike Leo ascendants, they prefer to go incognito instead of being the center of attention.

Libra Ascendant:

People with a Libra ascendant come off as agreeable, peace-loving, idealistic, and see the world through a filter of romanticism. Being ruled by Venus, they enjoy sensual pleasures and beauty much like Taurus ascendants. Appearance-wise, they tend to be very attractive, have good quality skin and teeth, and are slim in their earlier years but can gain weight later in life. Unlike Virgo ascendants, they use their analytical ability to compromise rather than pointing out details.

Scorpio Ascendant:

People with a Scorpio ascendant come off as mysterious, intense, sexual, and can be suspicious and reserved. Scorpio ascendants are the most seductive rising sign, and their mere presence can frighten or stimulate other people. Until they are provoked they might stay quiet. They tend to have Mediteranean profiles, dark hair, and dress in dark colors. Unlike Libra ascendants who are peace-seekers, Scorpio ascendants will seek truth and won't tolerate BS.

Saggitarius Ascendant:

People with a Sagittarius ascendant come off as cheerful, optimistic, high strung, and independent. They enjoy talking about broader subjects and opinions rather than trivial matters, and they like to travel and change things up as opposed to having a routine. They tend to be on the taller side, walk very upright, and have oval-shaped faces. Unlike Scorpio ascendants who may not react until they are inclined to do so, Saggitarius ascendants will freely express themselves regardless of the situation.

Capricorn Ascendant:

People with a Capricorn ascendant come off as serious, quiet, professional, and have a long-term view on life. They can have a cold disposition at first, but during projects, professional events, or games, they are who you want to have on your side. Being ruled by Saturn, the planet of contraction, they will be on the shorter and skinnier side with darker skin and hair, and they tend to live to an old age. Unlike Saggitarius ascendants who place an emphasis on optimism and shared activities, Capricorn ascendants can be pessimistic and prefer alone time.

Aquarius Ascendant:

People with an Aquarius ascendant come off as thoughtful, unconventional, rebellious, and they will be fond of joining groups. Ruled by Uranus, the planet of innovation and rebellion, Aquarius ascendants may struggle in traditionalist environments while enjoying more unconventional ones. Physically, they may have an interesting walk, clear complexion, be tall and strong, and dress unconventionally. Unlike Capricorn ascendants who focus on material gain through hard work, social and emotional satisfaction may be at the forefront of an Aquarius ascendant's needs.

Pisces Ascendant:

People with a Pisces ascendant come off as empathetic, hypnotizing, dreamy, and are heavily affected by external stimuli and the emotions of those nearby. Ruled by Neptune, the planet of mysticism and transcendence, Pisces ascendants can be disconnected from reality and big fans of all art forms. Physically, they tend to have fragile bodies, be on the pale side, and have smaller hands and feet. Unlike Aquarius ascendants who can be detached and form original thoughts and ideas, Pisces ascendants are like psychic sponges and draw inspiration from their surrounding environments.

How we find comfort

In terms of astronomy, Earth's moon is the easiest celestial body for us to see and goes through different phases. It changes signs every 2 to 2.5 days, and takes about 28 days to go through each sign, so it moves rather quickly. The moon rules our feelings and subconscious desires, and the quick movement of the moon helps explain why our emotions change so often. It governs our intuitive responses, how we find a sense of comfort, and feelings we get that we cannot explain. It may take a while for others to see your moon sign, as it comes out in situations that involve letting your inhibitions and emotional walls down. If your moon sign has different qualities than your sun or rising sign, you may act one way normally but a completely different side of you comes out when emotionally stimulated.

Aries Moon:

Ruled by Mars, Aries moons have fiery emotions. They react impulsively to both good and bad events which can lead to reckless behavior. When they are happy, they feel rushes of exuberance. This can translate to doing some sort of movement or dance or telling everyone they see about their happiness. However, when they are upset, they definitely turn more angry than somber. Their upset behaviors can be cursing, pacing, or physical violence- they need to take some kind of action to express their emotions, whether they are happy or sad. Aries moons feel strong emotions but do not hold grudges and are able to move on rather quickly. Being a competitive sign, they often get emotional over sports and competitions.

Taurus Moon (exaltation):

The moon is exalted in Taurus, so its qualities can be hyper-present in one's birth chart. Fortunately, having a Taurus moon brings calm, steady emotions. They are able to balance reason with emotion very well and do not overreact at things that aren't that important. Unlike the fiery Aries moon whomst it does not take much to provoke, it takes a lot to make a Taurus moon feel emotion, but when they do, they feel it very deeply. Therefore, they like stability and value

people that they can trust. However, when a stable situation that had previously brought them happiness falls apart, they can become reclusive, somber, and hold a grudge.

Gemini Moon:

Ruled by Mercury, communication is an essential part of Gemini moons' emotions. Gemini moons feel the happiest when surrounded by chatter and information. Similarly to how Geminis can be indecisive, their moods can fluctuate based on their recent communications and they can become easily irritable. They are more attracted to others' words than physical beauty, and prefer to be in the company of others who are talkative. Although they can become irritable over trivial matters, it only takes a small positive burst of communication to have them feeling like themselves again.

Cancer Moon (domicile):

Since Cancer is ruled by the moon, expect Cancer moons to be strongly in touch with their emotions. They feel strong nostalgia, and are at their happiest with people who make them feel safe. In relationships, they feel deep affection and since they are so in touch with their emotions, they tend to base most of their decisions on intuition rather than facts. However, they can feel deeply melancholy as well, especially when triggered by family or romantic struggles. Cancer moons possess almost psychic emotions that cause them to feel very deeply in both times of happiness and sadness.

Leo Moon:

Being a fixed fire sign, Leo moons feel passionately and intensely. In relationships, they may try to wow their partners and make it feel like a movie. They love recreational activities and rely on them to express their emotions. Leo is the sign of royalty, so they have an innate sense of nobleness that they choose to radiate to others who they feel deserve it. However, if they feel that someone else does not like them, they can become salty and let it get in their heads. If they are able to disregard their naysayers rather than offer them real estate in their heads, they can create circumstances that bring them perpetual happiness.

Virgo Moon:

Virgo moons are emotionally tied to work, routine, and find security in the smaller details of life. When they are in situations that do not require their mind being put to use, they can lack self-confidence. On the flipside, being in complicated situations can cause them to worry a lot. Having a balanced routine and stable job that they enjoy is key for a Virgo moon's emotional health, and although they may be reserved at first, they can become quite communicative around those who they trust. Their best qualities are their reliability and trustworthiness, and they are the types to show their affection in practical ways rather than deep love letters.

Libra Moon:

Libra is the sign that rules relationships, so Libra moons are emotional when it comes to their friendships and romantic interests. Like Taurus moons, the other sign ruled by Venus, they enjoy sensual pleasures but do not place an emphasis on possessions like Taurus. Codependency to others can be an issue for Libra moons, as they rarely do things by themselves and need others to tag along with them. They like to be the ones that start new bonds between their friends, and often make great partners. Libra moons are not the most straightforward people, and prefer to win others over with charm and diplomacy.

Scorpio Moon (fall):

The moon is in fall in Scorpio as it is the sign opposite Taurus where the moon is exalted. Therefore, the moon's qualities will be diminished if it is in Scorpio. Scorpio moons will try to be secretive regarding their emotions, but they possess great intuition and can see right through people. They do not get scared easily and are definitely the truth-seeking type, but they may be too blunt and hurt others in their pursuit of the truth. Although they are suspicious, once they trust someone they are very loyal and protective and have a fear of being betrayed. Scorpio moons' psychic intensity may be too much for some to handle, as they possess an alluring power.

Sagittarius Moon:

Sagittarius moons crave freedom and the ongoing pursuit of new experiences. They can be wild with the expression of their emotions and hurt others, but they often have a cheerful and optimistic nature which draws others back to them even after a wild display of emotion. It is tough to tie them down to a repetitive routine, and this can manifest by having trouble keeping the same friendships or relationships. They are free-spirited and adaptable, and tend to dive head first into things without ironing out the details first. Their fondest memories would be of things like trips and concerts rather than their grandparent's house.

Capricorn Moon (detriment):

Being the sign opposite Cancer, Capricorn moons are in detriment. This manifests as them being emotionally detached. This can be a blessing, as they make decisions with their heads and not their hearts. However, it can also be a curse as they lack empathy in situations that require it and are prone to hurting others' feelings. Their emotions are tied to whether others respect them and if they are achieving their goals or not, and when these two aspects are not going well for them, they can be prone to low moods. While being emotionally detached is not necessarily a bad thing, some emotions will still come out whether they like it or not, so it is best for Capricorn moons to have a safe emotional outlet to confide in.

Aquarius Moon:

Aquarius moons have independent and detached emotions. They dislike messy emotional displays and can try to be "above" basic emotions. Humanitarianism and compassion are good traits of an Aquarius moon, but they apply these values on a broad scale and can be insensitive when dealing with others' personal issues. Groups and social organizations are emphasized, and if they are to become hot-headed it will be over them and not over personal issues. Sometimes, because Aquarius moons' feelings are based on groups and humanitarian ideals rather than what happens to themselves, they can lack self-care and let themselves waste away. They may fight for the rights of unfairly treated groups of people even if their struggles do not apply to them personally.

Pisces Moon:

Pisces moons can be out of touch with reality, but have great intuition and ability for compassion- they can easily put themselves in others' shoes. Therefore, if something doesn't feel right to them, they won't do it regardless of what conventional wisdom suggests. Being a rather vulnerable sign, Pisces moons can be affected heavily by others' emotions, so in order to be happy, it is best for them to keep a tight circle of positive people. Their vulnerable emotions can make them feel deep love or have great inspiration for artwork, but it can make them bored with practical affairs. Boundless compassion makes Pisces moons suckers for movies like "The Notebook"

Mercury:

In ancient folklore, Mercury represented a winged messenger that passed information from the gods to mortals. The top of the Mercury symbol represents wings. The sign that your natal Mercury is in determines how you pass on your thoughts into written or spoken word. It also relates to how you learn and what subjects you may be interested in. Mercury takes about a

year to go through each sign and can spend 14 to 30 days in a sign dependent on its motion. Usually, planets move forwards through the signs, for example, going from the sign of Aries to Taurus. However, retrograde periods indicate that a planet is moving backwards, and when this occurs, delays and complications in what that planet controls are expected. When Mercury is in retrograde motion, expect delays and misunderstandings in communication.

Aries Mercury:

When Mercury is ruled by fiery Aries, expect honest, quick communication and an alert mind. They make decisions quickly and have the tendency to start new projects before finishing old ones. People with Aries Mercury enjoy learning to be active and hands-on, and will be interested in subjects like engineering and exercise science.

Taurus Mercury:

When Mercury is ruled by steady Taurus, expect quieter people who think before they speak. Pisces Mercury (detriment and fall):

While being in detriment and fall will hinder a Pisces Mercury's ability in hard sciences and critical thinking, they excel in thinking abstractly and compassionately which can lead to artistic talent. Pisces Mercurys make great artists and humanitarians.

The sign that your natal Venus is in determines what you will be attracted to and how you love, as well as what you perceive to be beautiful. It controls how we view and spend money as well. Venus takes about 1.5 years to transit through all of the signs, but this is only an estimate due to the fact that it can go through periods of retrograde motion. When Venus is in retrograde, it can cause love and relationships to cool off and hidden issues to arise.

Aries Venus (detriment):

People with Aries Venus will be straightforward with affairs and look for partners who are as dominant as they are. Being in detriment, instead of looking for romantic, sensual lovers, Aries Venus causes those with this placement to look for aggressive, fiery lovers. They will be passionate, but jump ship when a relationship gets boring. In terms of how they spend money, Aries Venuses have a tendency to buy things on a whim and then stop using them.

Taurus Venus (domicile):

Mars takes about 2 years to go through all of the signs and spends about 2 months in each sign, but can get stuck in a sign for a while if it is in retrograde motion. People with Mars in Aries are competitive warriors. Being in domicile, they will likely be the first to try new things and have little fear. Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto are known as outer planets. Their sign placements in your birth chart have little impact on your personality and a large impact on generational values since they spend 6-20 years in a sign. Therefore, there are no blurbs for outer planets in signs.

However, the house placements, which constitute the third pillar of reading your birth chart, are very important for all planets.

Your natal Saturn placement represents how you face fears and learn lessons. Saturn spends about 2.5 years in each sign and takes 29.5 years to go through all of the signs. When Saturn is in retrograde, procrastination and assessment of progress occurs.

Saturn in Aries (fall):

The biggest life lesson for those with Saturn in Aries is to be self-confident and assertive. Aries Saturns are patient and risk-averse, but they can have difficulty standing up for themselves as well.

Saturn in Taurus:

For example, as of 2020, Uranus is in Taurus, so new ideas about areas such as banking and agriculture could emerge.

It is also associated with forms of escapism such as the arts and drug use, which can lead to dissolution of ego but also dependence and burnout. Neptune is all about the unseen and life's mysteries. It takes quite a while to go through each sign, and spends about 14 years in a single sign so it influences a wide generation. The sign that Neptune is in determines the collective values of society at a given time period. As of 2020, Neptune is currently in Pisces, so the collective values of society are spirituality and finding hidden truth, but drug abuse and other forms of escapism are on the rise.

Pluto was discovered in 1930, and named after the Roman god of the underworld (also known as Hades). In order to have a fresh start, death is needed, which will be rather intense and destructive. However, it is also said to be the most powerful planet, as its influence can be like an atomic bomb. It takes a very long time to transit around the sun, and spends 14-20 years in each sign. Its sign represents areas of society that need to be destroyed and reinvented. As of 2020, Pluto is in Capricorn, so areas of society associated with Capricorn such as government and social hierarchy could be destroyed and reinvented.

Nodes of the moon:

North Node in Aquarius, South Node in Leo:



The next pillar of astrological knowledge is the house system. Each person's birth chart is cut into sections numbered 1-12.



1st House:

For example, someone with Uranus in their first house will have qualities such as rebelliousness, free thinking, and collectiveness very apparent in their personality. Planets that are in the first house may be of greater importance for a person than planets in other houses, because since they are hyper-present in your personality, they can affect any area of your life.

2nd House:

For example, someone with Venus in the 10th house would want to put on a public image of someone who is charming and beautiful, while possibly engaging in a career that involves art or fashion.

11th House:

- Social groups
- Blending into society
- Humanitarian efforts

The 11th house deals with how you view being part of a social group, how you blend into society, and your feelings on humanitarian efforts. Having planets in the 11th house will affect

how you view these areas and what social groups you might look for. For example, someone with Neptune in the 11th house may look for passive, dreamier, artistic social groups, while someone with Mars in the 11th house may look for active, competitive social groups that might involve sports.

12th House:

Keywords:

- Subconscious
- Secrets
- The unseen

The 12th house is often the most difficult to understand in astrology because of its inherently secretive nature. If someone has planets in the 12th house, they may try to hide that planet's influence, and it can come out at opportune times. Yet a lot of planets in the 12th house can indicate potential for psychic abilities.

For example, if someone has their moon in the 12th house, they may normally seem like an emotionally detached person, but when their emotions come out, they are strong. It takes a lot of inner work and perhaps being more introverted to make use of 12th house planets correctly.



Virgo Ascendant:

Robby is a rising Virgo which means he can come off to others as a perfectionist and a detail oriented person.

Mars in Scorpio in Second House:

Mars determines how you take action and handle challenges. Robby's Mars is in Scorpio (exaltation) which means he will do what it takes to get the job done. When he sets a goal he relentlessly pursues it, but the extent of this pursuit can sometimes lead him towards danger. Robby's Mars is in the second house which deals with accumulating your own resources. When Robby takes action, his purpose is to gain resources for himself. This can come in the form of friends, wealth, academics, any resources he can use that can help him get by. With Mars being exalted, there is potential for a lot of resources to be accumulated throughout his life, as long as he doesn't go too far with dangerous methods of accumulating these resources.

Pluto in Sagittarius in the Third house:

Pluto is in Robby's Third house which deals with communication and communities. Pluto's placement in a chart indicates an area that may be difficult for you, but if harnessed properly can turn into an area of great power. Robby may have had difficulty with areas such as early education and short communications in his life, yet can also have somewhat of a hidden talent in this area as well. In order to harness this talent, a transformation must occur in the way he thinks, communicates as well as short travels.

Uranus and Neptune in the Fifth house:

Uranus and Neptune, two social planets in the 5th house indicate that Robby looks to Uranian qualities (rebellion, invention, sense of collectiveness) for pleasure. In terms of how he enjoys himself, he focuses on if the collective atmosphere is one where everyone is free-thinking, "hip", rather than whether his personal needs are met at the time. He takes a collective view on "fun", so if there is an issue with someone else that ruins the overall atmosphere, that will lead to issues with himself, as well as someone who were to not encourage free thinking and rebellion. Neptune is in the Fifth house as well, so he also enjoys qualities such as escapism and dreams and views them as leisure. This can lead to problems with addiction as he enjoys using substances, yet since he views them as leisure, he can handle them quite well. This again leads there to be a collective atmosphere of no issues in order for him to experience pleasure rather than if his personal needs are met at the time. Yet with Neptune in the Fifth house, he isn't immune to personal needs and they often include things such as movies, music, and substances. Neptune in the Fifth house isn't a death sentence by any means though, as moderation of substances to a healthy level can actually raise his quality of life.

Sun in Aquarius in the Fifth house:

Robby is an Aquarius sun, which means that he is a collective-thinking, intelligent, and rebellious person. He has great qualities on a theoretical level as in that he loves to have fun and make sure others are too. However, when things don't go well, he can attack others from the standpoint of "why aren't you doing what's best for the collective good" rather than looking into the emotional and personal causes that underlie these issues. He would suit best to surround himself with people who are rebellious thinkers that do not attack others for bringing up game-changing ideas and can handle their emotions well, yet needs to learn that some issues do require empathy and a general emotional understanding rather than being standoffish and attacking from a higher plane. The best way for him to mix these approaches to life would be to take charge of situations that he is in, yet learn to concede and be humble himself in his leadership by acknowledging the presence of emotion and "attacking from a higher plane" not at others but by expressing his ideas about games and fun in a way that could not cause any harm to other people. With the sun, Uranus, and Neptune in the 5th house, Robby could be described as dreamy yet rebellious and a fun-loving person. His satisfaction includes others' satisfaction, and likes to keep in touch with a lot of people at an acquaintance level.

Mercury in Pisces in 6th house:

The 6th house of detail, organization, and daily service is what Robby thinks about. This makes him someone with strong daily routines and hygiene, and he can have great capabilities in the scientific and mathematical realms. However, with it being debilitated in Pisces, there is another aspect to his numerical and systematic knowledge, one where he thinks about compassion, art, music, and dreams. This placement gives him strong theoretical knowledge of numbers and systems, yet a strong urge to think about more artistic and abstract ideas and values. He needs to understand that in order to create the collective mosaic, each piece in it must be well-crafted. The best way for him to mix these aspects of what he thinks and communicates about would be to focus on the details and make everything look "perfect" so the message, or what he tries to get across as a whole is beautiful. The only hurdle is a tendency for his mind to get lost, but Pisces' quality of enjoying being with others makes it so that if others are at stake as well from his work, he will have to finish it to please the group.

Moon in Pisces in 6th house:

With his Moon in Pisces, Robby is empathetic and heavily affected by the environment around him. If an event occurs that makes him out of sync with someone, then that will surely take a toll on his emotions. He is a big fan of movies, music, and the arts and consumes these resources on a routine level. An issue for Robby is that he loves being around people, but the more people you get, the more of a chance that one of them causes the environment to be out of sync to Robby's taste. He has an inner tendency to want to escape through movies, games, and substance use. Partaking in these events at a routine level that is in accordance to how Robby wants to manage

his health is key for him. Music, art, and nature can be implemented into Robby's daily routine and also not damage his health. Philosophy and higher education is another aspect of Robby's moon sign, and the nature in which he decides to partake in these activities will play into his health and daily routines. While higher education may conflict with his inner urge to escape routine through parties and substance use, making the most of the experience, socially and academically will provide another outlet in which he can gain acquaintances and take up more of his time so escapism from daily routine doesn't completely dictate his experience.

Venus in Pisces in 6th house:

With his Venus in Pisces, Robby is attracted to people who are known for being compassionate but also have a dreamy aspect to them. Again this placement reinforces his love of escapism through movies, music, parties, games, substance abuse, and art. Yet placed in the 6th house, it is not through the expected routine escapist activities where Robby will find love but rather someone who will accompany him on daily routines. With Venus in the 6th house, daily routines such as exercise, schoolwork or a job are where Robby will find love and if he is in a relationship those factors will form the foundation of it. When in a relationship, daily health tasks, chores, and work must be balanced with escapism. Escapism in moderation is not a bad thing as it will not affect your health that much if done at a level less than compulsive.

Jupiter in Aries in 7th house:

When Jupiter is in the 7th house, you grow and expand through relationships. Robby's perspective on relationships with other people is that it can only cause his quality of life to expand, therefore he tends to be very social and keep many acquaintances. However, from hitting up too many people, there are bound to be some who teach Robby a lesson that when you have a lot of friends, not all of them are going to be sincere so some loss is expected in this area as well. The key for Robby is to be open with others and work to build trust in relationships so that when people are insincere, he doesn't get blindsided. Yet being an Aquarius, if he still is doing well enough with his relationships to attain a constant social life, he can rationalize others' insincerity towards him and take the agency off of himself, making him less prone to emotional suffering through loss of relationships. Jupiter in the house of relationships can give Robby some luck if he attempts to turn some of his acquaintances into better friends, but also some loss. His ability to detach himself from loss in relationships when others are insincere gives him confidence in trying to make new friends making him a social pioneer with many battle-tested relationships, but he may have to drop some people simply for the reason that they aren't vibing with them.

Saturn in Aries in the 8th house:

When Saturn is in the 8th house, issues may pop up with borrowed resources. When the line on how many resources to take from another person is blurry, there is a tendency to over-take.

Robby needs to be better with transactions, and make sure that he is providing fair enough deals that people continue doing business with him. If he can make sure that he always has something to bring to the table and has enough for himself as well, then the urge to over-take from others will disappear. This change may be difficult especially when Robby is such a social person and many people are willing to give him resources for free, but others will grow tired of his tendency to over-take. He can always stay socially afloat while using borrowed resources at a moderate rate, but in situations where there are no borrowed resources to use, he will need to learn how to provide for himself to quell the inner urge to get by using free stuff from other people.

North Node in Leo in the 11th House:

Robby's destiny in life coincides with his sociability, with the north node in the 11th house of social groups and associations. Sometimes he prefers to keep relationships Platonic even if it seems compatible, and can gain a lot of treading on the tires to establish great friendships rather than falling for every romantic impulse. With Robby valuing having a lot of acquaintances, he tends to prefer keeping things chill with people rather than falling into impulses which can actually lead to more overall affinity towards him. By gaining treading on his social tires while others take a more hot and cold approach, it leads to a very solid reputation and rich relationships that other people can even envy.
