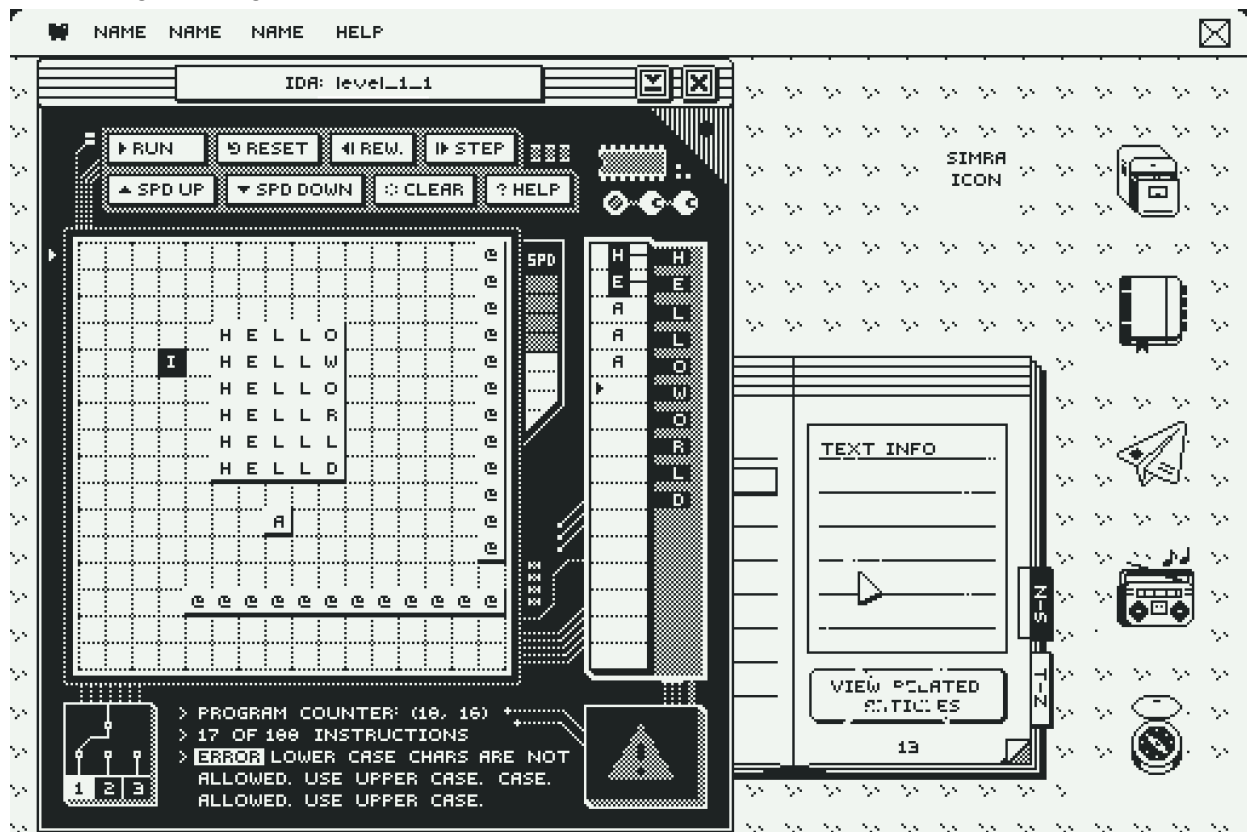

Gameplay Overview

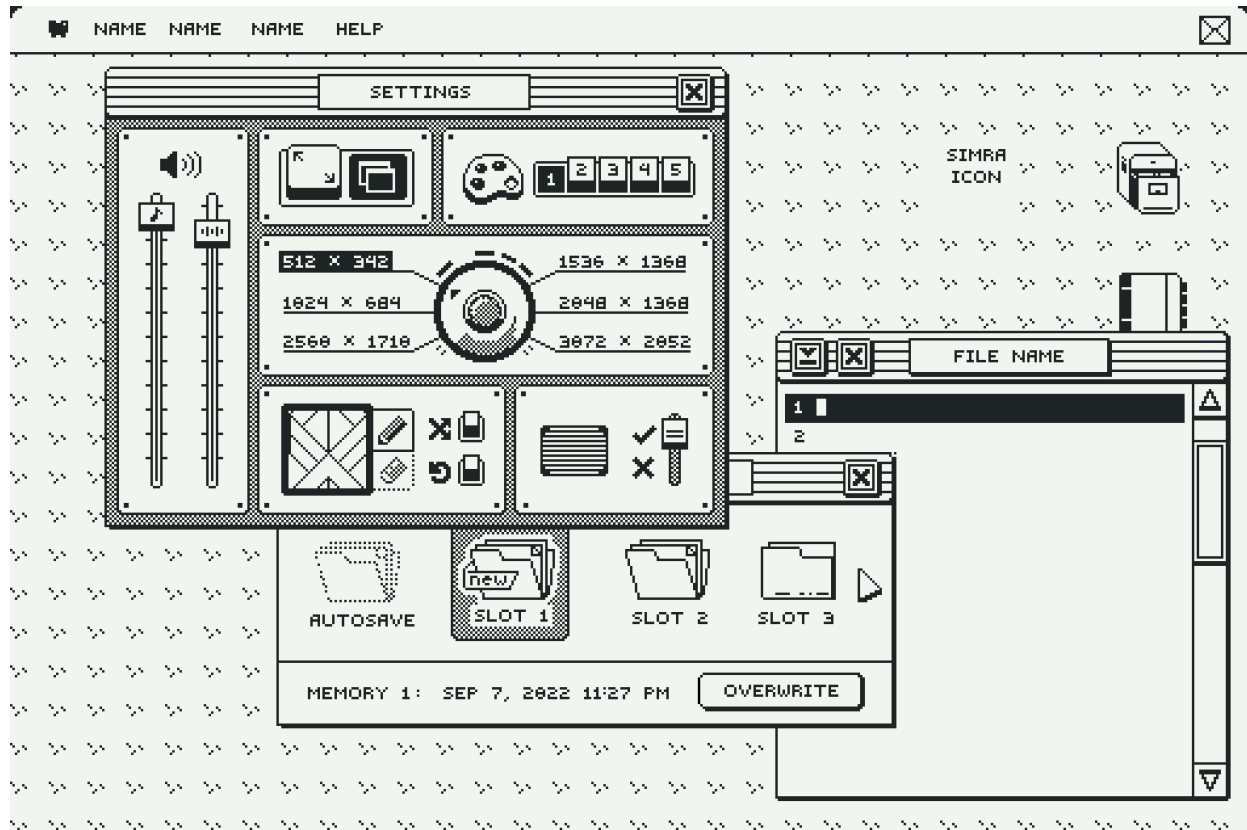

Story
