



- Concurrent Enrollment (CE) is college-level coursework given to motivated high school students with a desire to get an early start on their career path. With successful completion of each course, students will receive both **high school AND college credit**.
- All Concurrent Enrollment courses require admission to SLCC and/or Weber State and/or U of U and/or SUU. Students and/or USU **will not** have to pay an admission fee for concurrent enrollment to any of the colleges. **Tuition will be due** to the applicable college at \$5.00 per credit hour. For example, tuition for a 3 credit hour course will be \$15.00. Textbooks and lab fees may apply and vary for each course.
- Grades will be given at semester end for semester courses and year-end for yearlong courses.
- Students will be starting their permanent college transcript, and grades will be recorded on that permanent college transcript.
- Strict attendance policies apply. Poor attendance will affect the student's grade. **See each course syllabus for grading and attendance policy.**
- Priority is given to 11th & 12th grade students. 10th graders can take Concurrent classes based on course availability and grade requirement. Courses are dependent on availability.
