

ONE SENTENCE JOB DESCRIPTION

To implement and execute the mission and vision of Christ City Church as it relates to leading the church in worship through song, liturgy, and prayer.

TITLE: Director of Worship

REPORTS DIRECTLY TO: Associate Pastor, Christ City South Vancouver

TYPE OF POSITION: Full time, permanent (we are also open to a part-time position for the right candidate)

HOURS PER WEEK: 40 hours*

**It is understood that, like any committed member of the church body, the Director of Worship will give a normal number of volunteer hours to the church each week.*

WORKING HOURS:

- Flexible, based on some ministry needing to be done on evenings
- Regular attendance is required at all prayer meetings as well as all church-wide events
- Sunday morning requirement to lead or, if not leading, participate in gatherings
- Mandatory Sabbath day per week, consisting of a 24-hour period of rest from work related to all aspects of ministry

COMPENSATION: Negotiable based on experience and education, Extended Health Benefits, 5% matching contributions to Pension Plan, and paid vacation.

VACATION: Three weeks floating, upon approval of Associate Pastor, plus flex time* between Christmas and New Year

**minimal duties will be required to ensure the gatherings between Christmas and New Years are well planned and well executed*

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES/EXPECTATIONS:

1. Leading the church to worship well through song, liturgy, and prayer, bringing a Christ-centered, Scripturally-saturated approach to all aspects of the gathered worship of Christ City Church.
2. Raising up, empowering, and equipping worship leaders.
3. Overseeing, training and discipling new and existing members of the band and sound team.
4. Recruiting and developing new musicians to be ready to join the Sunday teams for gathered worship. This should include theologically grounding new members of the worship team in the significance and purpose of gathered worship through song.
5. Participate in a Christ City Church Community Group, with a view towards leading a Community Group where you will be entrusted to shepherd the people in your group along with the other leaders.

Alongside leading the Worship Ministry, there will be other responsibilities based upon particular gifts and calling.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Understanding that no area of ministry at Christ City stands alone, and that all team members lead with a passion for the health of the overall church, you will be called upon to serve in other ministry duties from time to time at the discretion and request of the Associate Pastor, Christ City South Vancouver.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Theological education and experience in vocational ministry are preferred, but not a necessity, as we are a training and equipping church with a skilled team and a developmental culture interested in mentoring the right applicant into a place of fruitful ministry.

ABOUT US

Christ City Church is a growing church, geographically located in the centre of the city of Vancouver, with a vision to establish a network of Neighbourhood Churches. We are currently in four diverse neighbourhoods in Vancouver and Surrey,

We are unapologetically centred on Jesus Christ.

We are grounded in the authoritative Scriptures, the culture of this city, and the history of the church.

We gather as a body of believers every Sunday for worship, Word, and sacrament, and we gather in smaller communities as Community Groups throughout the week for ongoing discipleship, that we might be known and in turn know others.

We believe the church is called *to God* and then sent *by God* to be on mission. We live out that *sent* identity through a life of 24/7 worship in the everyday. We believe the gospel informs our vocational life, our family life, and our recreational life, and that there is no part of our lives that is not impacted by the in-breaking reality of the renewal of all things that has begun in the resurrection of Jesus.

Christ City Church is reformed in soteriology, continuationist in pneumatology, missional in ecclesiology, and complementarian in polity.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a follower of Jesus, having recognized and repented of personal sin and baptized as a sign of death to self and life in Jesus. Life must clearly demonstrate a high level of spiritual maturity.
- Must be growing in Christ-likeness demonstrating a commitment to a transformed life through the work of the Holy Spirit in spiritual disciplines such as, prayer, study, giving, fasting, solitude, confession, unity, worship, etc.
- Must have a clear sense of God's calling to ministry at Christ City with much passion for the calling.
- Ability to relate and work well with team members, whether staff or volunteer.
- Demonstrate a caring heart for others.
- Willing to mop the floor.
- Must agree with Christ City's mission, values, and statement of faith, understanding that all areas of ministry (Service, Kids, Community Groups, etc.) do not stand alone but fit under the umbrella of Christ City's vision and mission.
- Should be an enthusiastic and creative team leader who is willing to work with current staff and volunteers, with an eye to equipping others for ministry through ongoing discipleship.

- In line with Christ City's mission and vision, must live in the broader neighbourhood of the church, committed to reaching the people in that neighbourhood as God gives opportunity.
