Hello all,

On September 24th, 2024, the Chief Returning Officer received reports and evidence that Aarabhi Krishnaumar, a candidate for the Fourth Year Chair position made a campaigning post on their private and personal Instagram account. This is in direct violation of <u>ACM Slide 5</u> (encompassed by bylaw 3, 8.0.7) which limits social media campaigning to approved public accounts with no previous followers before approval. Not only did the account have existing followers, the account was never approved or sent to the ORO for approval.

As a result, the candidate in question will be issued a formal warning which will be displayed on the voter statement page during the voting period on vote.skule.ca. This decision may be appealed as per the process outlined in Bylaw 3, section 10.
