



LESSON PLAN_C6: Active social awareness

Topic:

Collection for the Danish Red Cross - The Bazaar Days at Provstegårdskolen

Brief description of the lesson:

In the days leading up to the Bazaar Days, students and parents collect clothes to be used for resale on the evening when there is an open house at Provstegårdskoen. All the money earned from clothing sales goes undiminished to the Danish Red Cross.

Prior to the collection, the students have visited the local Red Cross Center

Class duration:

12 hours.

3 hours for the open house event, where the students are responsible for the sale.

The students work with the Danish Red Cross and get an insight into how the organization works and what the funds they collect are used for.

The local Red Cross Center is visited and the students get the opportunity to see what volunteer work consists of.

Posters and Flyers are made advertising the collection. These are hung up and distributed in the local community and containers are set up where the clothes can be handed in. The clothes are subsequently sorted and hung up on racks with prices on.

In the evening for the open house event for all the parents, the clothes are sold.

Subsequently, the earnings are counted up and the money is handed over to the Danish Red Cross

Evaluation

After the event, representatives from the local Red Cross center came and were handed the money. Here the students had the opportunity to wish which charity project the money should go to.

Subsequently, the student group has worked with and gained insight into the exact area they have helped to support.
