Guild: Templars of Aurea

The Templars are the military arm of the Delvan Church - though they only raise their hands and weapons for the holy mission. Each member is devoted to their religious cause, and to the protection of their people, their city and their Dominus - or Oracle. Knights and Mages figure heavily, but only final class members have the honour of the Templar title.

8291-8292 overall: Delverne was on agreeable, allied terms with Miras and aided in many of the kingdom's ventures, including the ley expedition, a warfront against the empire, dealing with the Ash Fever and harbouring refugees from the north.

- Noble, military, religious figures, and Delverne's leader **Dominus Salvai himself** are escorted by Templars.

8291 Jun/July - [Storming of the North](#) ; Aug [After the Fall](#)

- **Empire infiltrates Belport & Valsk**, overtaking the North.

- Evacuation is priority. **Emergency agreement struck with Delverne to receive Valski refugees upon their shores**, where a Cantish convoy will collect them for permanent refuge in Cantish lands.
 - The call to aid is met excellently, **strengthening diplomatic ties** between Delverne and Miras!

8291 July/Aug - [Mutiny](#) [linhythe]

- 14th Harvest. **Kingdom retaliates with Delverne's aid** and attacks Linhythe & Song-Lu's docks and naval bases.



Aug - [Poisoned land](#) [nivalvini]

- Meanwhile, **black, fast-growing parasitic growths** - thorned vines, persistent creepers, and dark leaves and toxic berries have sprouted up on Nivalvini. Researchers attempt to stave off the sudden and invasive growth and find out what is the cause...

8291 Aug - [March of Saints](#)

- 23rd Harvest. After aiding Miras' war efforts, Delverne celebrates a national holiday, **Cyndril's Respite**, an annual **festival of redemption**. While the day is dedicated to examining the past, sunset looks towards the future.

Delvans write down their misfortunes, sins, and fears from the past year on slips of paper, and then cast them into the **cleansing fire of Aurea, freeing them from their regrets**. Children put on pageants to recount the **tale of Cyndril**, a mythic figure who famously toiled to redeem an immoral, ancient elf king.(...)



- This year, Dominus Salvai addresses the people after the service. After turmoil in the North and consummating its alliance pact with Miras, **Templars will be sent forth into the Kingdom** to root out enemy spies and bolster their allies.

Sep - [Trouble in Paradise](#) [amedra]

- Templars arrive in Amedra, and set to work **purging the port city of spies**.



- **With some acting in zeal & religious reasoning, the mission begins to resemble an Inquisition...**
 - Empire merchants are keenly targeted. Some Amedrans take advantage of the scene to rid their competitors! u crafty lot

8291 Sep/Oct - [Forest's Deep](#) [cantor]

- **The first Leywood expedition.** Nisalvini struggles with its infestation. But historical records show a similar infestation of **white thorns** happened long ago, dealt with in the northern forests of Cantor, the sacred and magic-abundant **Wild Ley**.

- Delverne aids Kingdom searching for solutions in Leywood, discovering the [Ley Elk](#) & ruins of **ancient civilisation!**



- But leaving the Leywood with treasures yet no cure, the **black thorn plague** in Nisalvini **becomes disease...**
 - **Ash Fever.** Striking **light elves with fevers and fatigue**, particularly the very young and the elderly.

Dec - [Murky Paths](#). Quarantined, **Ash Fever spreads in Nisalvini**, progressing from fever, heavy fatigue, to coma & death.

◆ Treasures of the Leywood

Soon after the expedition into the Leywood, Kyrie has received a new order from the Templars - **to take possession of as many of the items discovered there for Delverne as possible.** They are currently being kept by Cantor Abbey, and most are earmarked to be transported to Nisalvini for research despite the growing epidemic.

The urgency of the situation on the ill-fated island means that it will be very difficult to gain possession of them, however she has been told that the order is of utmost importance and [permitted the use of whatever force and/or trickery is necessary.](#)

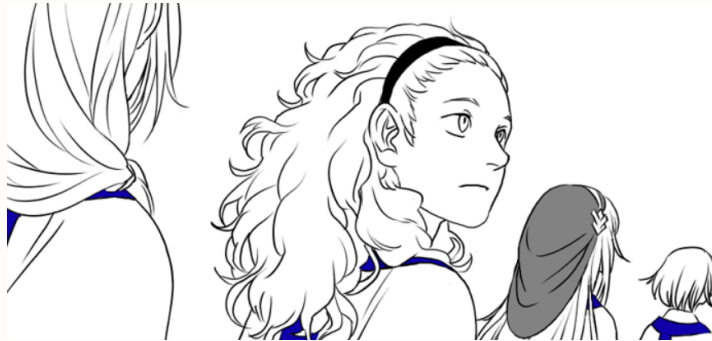
- While officially at war, Miras & Koben have no further conflicts since the peace talks at Estraude, but...

- **Triss is among the oracles** - Triss, a human girl who a [few years ago also possessed this gift of prophecy](#), yet strangely disappeared a while after Cantor's Abbess Karmenie's death...

- Delverne is **uninvolved**, but between kingdom and empire coasts, a **new landform suddenly rises from the sea** - the [Citadel of Crowns](#) ! Stuff of fairytale and myth yadda yadda. Why? Who knows.
- Meanwhile, Nisalvini became Atlantis. Why? Who knows. Bye.....



- Afterwards, a mist descends upon all alva, and... faces appear in the trees, the water, the clouds!
- **The [race of Oriads](#) appears on Alva.** Why? Who knows.

and **very human Triss becomes... a light elf** ?!  ????



Oracle Triss becomes Delverne's new leader, as Aurea's own vessel.
elfpope went to grampa heaven and Triss will be Aurea's mouthpiece to Her people henceforth.

8294 July/Aug - [Playing Gods](#)

- From the miracles & Triss' guidance for Auwea's faithfuls, **Delvans can now swear an oath... blood for ambrosia**, that makes them Physically & Magically Strong, blessed with **flame** for they are now **Oathbound!**

As the flames of the Oathbound dance to life upon more and more foreheads, flickers of memory tickle Bee's mind. She saw it once on a silver staircase, and felt pity. She saw it another time in a room of clouds and travellers, and felt awe. There were serious voices and images of faraway people painted in the air. Perhaps if she were to find that room again or one like it, she could grasp the thought... understand why it feels so strange to see so many flames around her.

*In a forgotten tower of Delverne's oldest cathedral, Bee finds the place she was looking for. It's dark and dusty, but the curve of the stairs and the light from the windows call to her memory... and the ghosts of people she once knew return to her. Three names come within her grasp - **Imyris**, **Aelende** and **Eirene**. She was with them in this very tower.*

She saw a sick child, a companion of one, drink from the boughs of a white tree dripping with golden oil. She saw him be healed and a flame flicker above his brow. The tree explodes into a massive pillar of light, but magic goes wack and so does the Leywood!



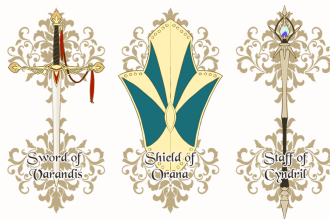
- Kingdom & Delverne fight again as Kingdom wouldn't yield to Delverne's damage control request.

- Reluir too had their [Legendary Weapons...](#)

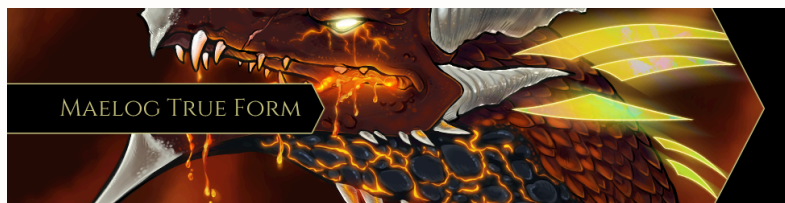
- But [Koben empire becomes involved](#) ! They launch a Massive spell that breaks both Aurea & Atros apart, their barbie body parts scattering across Alva

Heartland

Delverne is alive with festivity. The return of their Oathbound warriors, combined with the return of Delvan expatriots from all over the rest of Alva, sparks an enormous celebration - dubbed the Festival of Blessings. With their glorious heroes among them and 'long lost' fellow light elves home, the streets of Delverne come alive with hope and togetherness - including the Cardinals of the Dominate. It's a rare occasion to mingle among the highest, and to play a part in the power games of Delverne's elite.

But unbeknownst to them, not all are here for the Delvan dream. After a harrowing journey through underground Telurea, those seeking to revive Therras lurk among the merry-makers. To complete the rebirth of Tharoneos, the essential link between mortals and Therras who the Delvans slew themselves, they must infiltrate the secretive Heart Sanctum of Delverne Cathedral. And to infiltrate the Heart Sanctum, they must find the way in through the Delvans...

Revelry RP

*The Revelry main RP was run from **19 - 24 April 2022**, and epilogue was run from **25 April - 1 May**.*

The celebrations end in chaos. Just as Delverne is resting after a full night of hot-blooded fun and political revelations, their own mysterious Oracle Triss appears to wreak havoc and betrayal as a parting gift. Not only that, the Kingdom attacks while they are still reeling as part of the infiltration plan. The Therras questers swarm the Cathedral on their cue - and at long last, after trial upon trial, they reach their goal. From the depths of Delverne's ancient ether well, Tharoneos opens his eyes and bursts to the surface - Therras' child and hope reborn.

But success comes at great cost... for Delverne. Tharoneos' revival right beneath the waterfall of Delverne city destroys it in an instant. Yet even then the destruction does not end. From the Radiant Peaks, to the coastline, to the Tira Forest, all of it crashes and folds into mountains that climb higher and higher as Tharoneos grows into his true form. All of this is now *his* domain - home for the scions of Therras, and death for any mortals who enter. Had the Delvans not killed Tharoneos' former body, the new one's domain would not have spread so far - so in the cruel and beautiful way of nature, this is the harvest that was sown.

For the Delvans of the countryside, who know nothing of what has transpired, it is simply a terrifying disaster. Most perish in the land's transformation - but some make it to the coasts where the mountain domain falls away to ocean. Now bereft of home, land and living, they are swept under the wing of **Zefiel Sarabrea** and his sprawling band of warrior loyalists.

Some escape across the Tira forest into the only untouched land in this part of the continent - annexed West Cantor, now known as Alesse. Among them is a simple but increasingly beloved priest determined to protect the innocent from both the rotten humans and the corrupt old guard of Delverne - **Renard Renne**.

Of the many Delvans drawn to the city for festivities, a great number escape into the portal to Riag thanks to the advice of one Therras quester. The portals no longer work and Therras' stirring has caved in the only other entrance at Soloros, so they are sealed underground - but there is a silver lining. They are now at the place where long lost gifts from Aurea are buried... gifts that, if they are found, may give them hope of reviving Delverne. Led by **Lumis Dormona**, they delve into their past to seek out their future.

And as for the Therras questers, they are safe on the Mirian skyships sent to aid them. Their homes in Cantor are gone but their Kingdom will give them a place. Among their number is one extra person. Officially, she is a servant of Cantor Abbey who was retrieved from Delverne along with Tory - but those who took part in the Heart Sanctum infiltration will know her as **Solenie Benoit** in disguise. Whenever they go to rescue Alis from the survivors of Delverne city, Solenie will go with them.

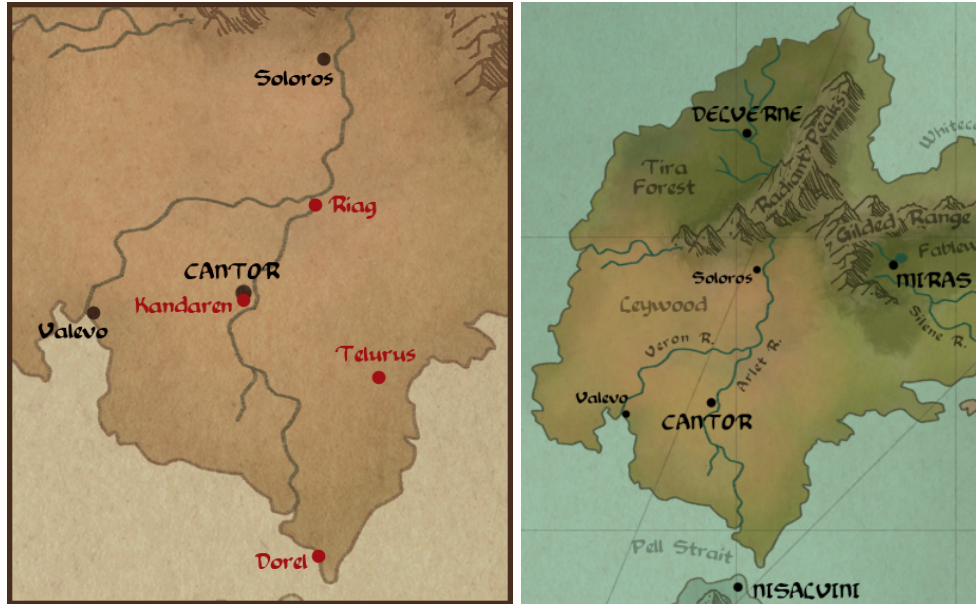

Likely a **Light elf** all along, with **Enchanter** abilities [\[enchanter on alvapeda\]](#)



- She was the daughter of **Lumis Dormona**'s childhood friend-turned-templar squire **Cleya**, who the Dormonas had supported after an [accident] caused the demise of their servant parents
- **Triss** was given up to an orphanage when born, when Cleya was wrongfully accused of treason in a scandal
- Lumis found **Orichar**, Cleya's brother who had left, and aided in his templarhood per Cleya's last request
- Triss was happily adopted by a farming family when Lumis found her, but a year afterwards **a landslide** took them. She was the only survivor.
- Lumis suspects **the demon that misled the Delvans** had already possessed Triss by then, or caused the landslide.
 - **Triss herself may have been a genuine vessel for Aurea**, given the oaths and forced ascensions. Who knows...
- Brought into **St. Cyndril's** as a ward, Triss was able to involve herself deeply with Delverne's government. Her gifted smarts & supposed visions lent to her position.
- **Solenie**, who was familiar with Cleya and met Triss several times, began to question who Triss actually was.



- In the **Miras Kingdom**, with the **Gladius family** looking after her, [alongside certain other noble elven households](#), Triss was able to somewhat control the narrative in the human lands in an effort to allow Delverne's spread over the continent:
 - With her first appearance in **Cantor, and Karmenie's passing**; the **White Oracles** in Miras, the **prophecy** she conjured to spur Delverne's general populace into action.

Triss has since said farewell to Delverne with her betrayal, for whatever her purpose is truly about...

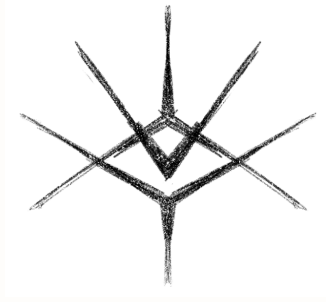

Wymara, the King of Night (atros), Maelog, his servant of darkness, and Valawr, a human daughter of light (aurea)

- **Margrave Alis**, currently a prisoner of the underground Delvans after being captured in battle, recognised [the sigil](#) that the (previously)-unconscious [Hyacinth Elestae](#) carved upon their forehead to summon earlier –
 - And believes that the Elestae's familiar, the Slumbering King, is related to none other than **Wymara**, the King of Night with a crown of gold and ice... gasp.....

*For generations stretching back to Delverne's nascence, the **Elestae** family has been one of its most powerful families for one reason - they possess and pass down one of Delverne's most important weapons - a familiar of terrifying scale, the '**Tears of Aurith**', or the '**Slumbering King**'.*

Some call it the Tears of Aurith for its form, of liquid gold encased in ice. Others, especially the Elestae themselves, call it the Slumbering King - for to use it, the summoner must awaken it from an ice-bound slumber. Many Elestaes of the past have gone down as heroes in history for calling upon its power in times of need, yet none have managed to waken it fully, and so its true power is a mystery.

It is, they say, an S-class familiar with powers that defy the rules of magic.

Earasath poison

Now I can write about this since Delverne has been Made Aware

- Delvans wouldn't necessarily know the details of this poison,
 - except that **Miras used this Terrible Weapon** on delvan civilians during the diversion, and that it is **designed to kill light elves specifically** [re: *captives in the dark*]
- Infiltrators meanwhile mostly would not know the details of Miras' distraction tactics or even poison use.



Earasath

A common, climbing blue rose. Found in abundance in Iadlain. It grows freely throughout the town, planted long ago as a deterrent for light elves, as its pollen triggers an allergenic reaction in them. Due to the rarity of light elves in Iadlain, it has never needed to be refined to a deadly poison - though research was done into this equally long ago, with success, and this information still exists in Iadlain's libraries.

Iadlain developed the Earasath poison to trade with Koben for the **Adabrene poison**, the poison created by the **Miras Kingdom** with the **adabrene fern** that burns and boils all – and only – those of dark elven lineage. [\[firefall\]](#)

- Like how adabrene affects dark elves, earasath is a weapon against light elves, **freezing them to death**.
[sounds awfully familiar to a certain oath, huh... guess lighties prevailing nemesis is the Cold– jk]
- While it was possible to emergency treat Adabrene with [kralspitzer wyvern](#) parts' dark essence to draw out the poison, whether there is an equivalent for earasath, or if it'd have the same effect that causes formerly **adabrene-afflicted (half) dark elves** to be affected by **Huozei's shards**, ascending as a fire god's Apostles in Song-Lu currently... who knows!!!!

Regarding the connection between the recent years' Black Thorns and the Leywood's White Thorns

From the stolen Ley Relics' [Vellum Scrolls](#)

After translation thanks to other more mundane scrolls taken from the ancient city, it was found that these scrolls held the information so dearly sought after - a passage inserted between descriptions of religious ceremonies speaks of the white thorn infestation that gripped the ancient world.

The cause is recorded a huge excess of light elemental energy from a magical experiment gone wrong. This fed the mutation of a certain innocuous and common weed, into thorny spirals which lived not off the earth but rather the excess elemental energy trapped in the earth.

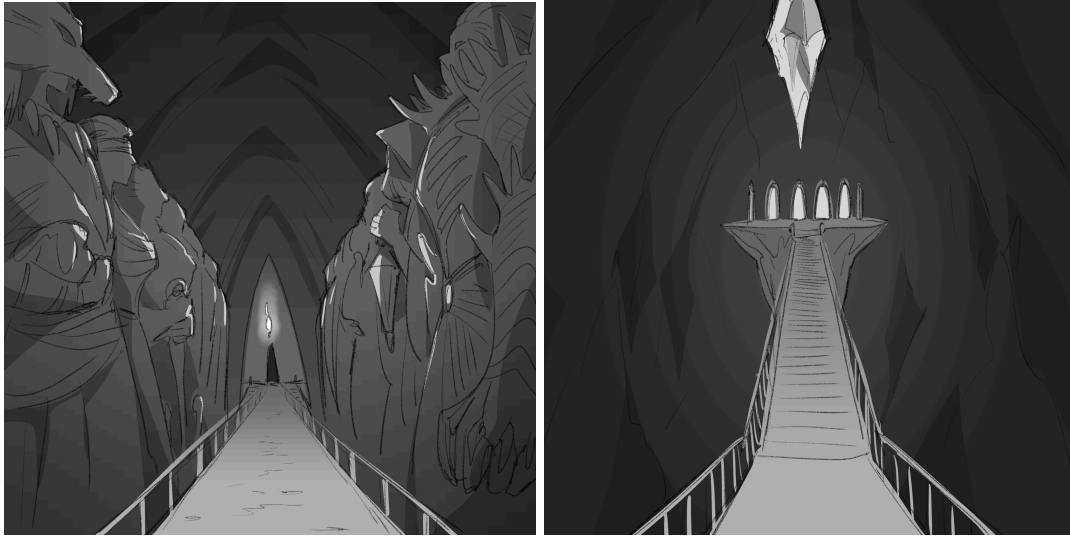

Saints in the Light Elves' history ... appropriated in Telurea?

- **Saint Zeredyn**, the hero **Eresfael** with his Staff of Thousands, bearing great dragon gauntlets
 - [repurposed as **Zerden the Dragon's Arms** in Telurea:
 - A legendary warrior, strong enough to pull down beasts and golems with his bare arms. He wore immense gauntlets of dragon scale and dragon steel.]
 - **Calliste**'s chosen honour name

- **Saint Talrade**, a robed woman carrying a lantern [[hyacinth deito](#)]
 - the princess of the lost northern tribe, who led these northern elves back home to Delverne, with a holy lantern that she lit with own soul.
 - **Solenie's** chosen Cardinal name
 - [repurposed as **Toloryd, the Heart of Fire?**
 - Daughter of Tolomon, granddaughter of Tolochor. When the Great Frost (**Harul**) tried to consume Tolochor's soul fire, she merged her own soul with it to save it, and scattered into the hearts of all people so that he could not take it. It is said that hope and kindness in the face of adversity is her gift to humanity.]

◆ Aurea & the Lady of Soloros

One thing that Delvan characters may note is that while their humanoid forms are described similarly (i.e. flowing hair of light, eyes like suns), their creature forms are very different. The **benevolent Aurea of current Delvan belief is depicted as a large snake**, whereas the **Lady of Soloros was depicted as a winged cat**. Whether that actually means anything is unknown.
