Peace Day 2025 — A Doukhobor Manifesto

This year's 'Peace Day' message and title were inspired by the phrase '**Doukhobor manifesto**' used by my friend the late Professor Beissel, an international poet and Doukhobor in spirit.

While thinking about this year's annual Peace Day, 135 years after our <u>ancestors burned</u> <u>weapons in 1895</u>, I thought of my friend Dr. Henry Beissel who died this January 9, 2025.(1) In 2017 <u>we met by chance at a peace event in Ottawa</u>, and immediately became friends. In the past 7-plus years we often shared how our different life paths shaped our common views of a nonkilling society. I <u>posted 3 of his articles and mentioned his thoughts about peace in several of my articles.(2)</u>

In 2015 I wrote (bold added):


Because we all have the abode of God within us, it is wrong to kill another human being. This idea originates from the assumption that every individual, man, woman and child, regardless of age or sex, has a bit of a <u>Divine Spark</u> in them. Life is to be lived in accordance with the guidance of that Spirit. Herein lay the deep roots for the **Doukhobor manifesto** against conscription and military service.(3) A nonkilling legacy is a recent description of this Spirit.

In 2017, Dr. Beissel, who read that article, replied with his message for the 122nd anniversary of the Russian Canadian Dukhobors destroying weapons, which I posted (bold added):

I applaud the **Doukhobor manifesto** calling for peace and non-violencce among all people. Never has that message been more essential than today, as the newly elected Liberal government proposes to spend several billion dollars to beef up our military to carry its warfare abroad more efficiently. That money would be better spent on such things as health care (including dental and mental care) for all and old age pensions so that all can live with dignity. When our political leaders speak with reverence of "our men and women in uniform", I remind myself that they are speaking of trained killers. Soldiers are killers. Soldiers are killers and we need to replace them with men and women of peace and love. Unless we can find our way to non-violence and peace globally and soon, we shall surely end up in a suicidal massacre.

So congratulations to you on the occasion of the centenary of the <u>Doukhobor Community</u> <u>Home in Veregin!</u> And thank you and your brothers and sisters for so couragiously carrying on the struggle for reason and love. Here is a short section from a long poem I finished last week which I'm sending to honor your anniversary:

The poppy's bloom is a red flag that signals the coming of winter – a fitting adornment for our bloodthirsty romance with killing and being killed the deluded consider dulce et decorum. It is neither sweet nor honourable to die before your day is done, and deafness affords no dispensation. Listen and listen again: every time a bullet flies or a bomb detonates a till rings far behind the far flung battle lines in the counting houses of those you never meet and who never face the clash of battle: war is the apotheosis of consumption. Listen to the concert of ringing tills and know they ring not for thee; they ring in celebration of the glories of maximizing profits.

At a 2017 'Remembrance Day' public meeting in Ottawa, Dr. Beissel said that:

... peace is complicated. Economic corporate interests rule the world including hijacking the mainstream media, and making us consumers of extreme capitalism. 'I despise Remembrance Day because it glorifies wars, resulting in perpetual indoctrination of our youth for wars....What freedoms are we protecting? Canada has not been attacked for 200 years....We are closer to war today than in 1948. I am not sure what to do?' More than ever before, said Dr. Beissel, we need more cooperation to deal with issues of equality, injustice, and local services. To achieve this, we have a huge opportunity if we decide to stop wars and divert resources to urgent human needs.(5)

Dr. Beissel's poem 'Manifesto in Times of War' (1986) is a good example of his masterful use of words (excerpt).

Tell the enemy this: Yes, we're still writing poems, and if the grenades blow off our hands, we'll sing them into the future
