Pronouns

Pronouns are words that are used to replace nouns in a sentence.

- **Personal Pronouns** – They are used to replace people, animals and objects. For ex- She, He, Him, Her, You, I, Me, They, Them.
- **Possessive Pronouns** – They are used to show that something belongs to someone. For ex- Mine, his, hers, theirs, ours, yours.

- **Emphatic Pronouns-** They are used to emphasize the action of the subjects.
