- 2. Play through measure 70 to the end- Notice the pattern that it repeats every 4 measures just like measure 1-27
 - 3. Start at measure 28: cellos and basses pizzicato while violins play cellos and basses play just the first note of every pair of eighth notes
 - 4. At measure 54, speak your rhythm. Notice the conversation happening between the violin sixteenth notes.
