



I use a #4 worsted weight (HL ILTY in Glacier was used for this one). I use a 5.0 mm Crochet Hook.

## Terms:

YO: yarn over

HDC: YO, go into stitch, YO and pull up with 3 loops on your hook, yo and pull through all 3 loops.

DTR: YO 3 times, go into stitch, YO and pull up a loop (you will have 5 loops on your hook), YO and pull through 2 loops (continue to YO & pull through 2 loops at a time until you have one stitch left).

## **Crochet Scarf Hat Pattern:**

Crochet in a spiral. Mark your first stitch with a stitch marker or piece of yearn so you can see your starting stitch.

- 1. Make a magic ring with 10hdc
- 2. 2hdc in every st. join round with sl st, 20 stitches
- 3. \*1hdc in first st, 2hdc in next st. Repeat from \* around. join round with sl st, 30 stitches
- 4. \*1hdc in first st, 1hdc in next st. 2hdc in next st. Repeat from \* around. join round with sl st, 40 stitches
- 5. \*1hdc in first st, 1hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st, 2hdc in next st. Repeat from \* around. join round with sl st, 50 stitches

- 6. \*1hdc in first st, 1hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st, 2hdc in next st, Repeat from \* around. Join round with sl st, 60 stitches (your diameter at this point should be 5.25" to 5.75" to fit a 22-23" head circumference.
- 7-15. HDC in each stitch around (on row 15, the last 2 stitches should be SC and SL ST to bring the HDC back into alignment. You will SL ST into the stitch just before your stitch marker.
- 16. In the same stitch you slip stitched into, chain 4 (loosely) or chain 5 if you are a tight crocheter and DTR into the same stitch. DTR in every stitch (60 loops + your 1st chain = 61)
- 17. Ch2, HDC around, join into your first DTR (60)
- 18. Ch1, SC in joining st, sk 1 st, 5 HDC in the next st, sk 1 st, \*SC in the next st, sk 1 st, 5 HDC in the next st, sk 1 st, repeat from \* around, join, then make invisible finish (as shown in video). 15 shells total There should be 1 stitch left after your last shell, then join to your first SC.
