- (1) MTSS: Data-driven decision making through a culture of collaboration

 After three successful years with a math interventionist, the BLT expressed their desire to maintain this position. Based on the noted academic improvements since implementing this position, a math and literacy interventionist will continue to be funded. This individual will continue to provide academic interventions, extensions, and supports, as needed by students. In efforts to continue to improve student achievement, teachers will participate in a 2-year LETRS training, where support for literacy instruction will be provided. Textbooks will be purchased for PD purposes.
- (2) MTSS: Culture of Collaboration, Social Emotional Learning & Future Ready Education ICSD has a school-wide focus on trauma informed care and PBIS. Escalante Valley Elementary saw an improvement in student behavior as a result of implementing both into our school. Student behavior data was tracked through Educator's Handbook, and reviewed during quarterly BLT data discussion meetings. In respect to the data collected, Escalante Valley would like to continue to improve student behaviors through our school-wide PBIS system.

(3) MTSS: Future Ready Education, Community Connections

The students at Escalante Valley School will further develop their academic learning by implementing 21st century skills through the use of blended learning tools, Waterford licenses, Amplify (Acadiance Reading), iPads, and other technology related tools.

(1) Upcoming School Plan:

We will increase our beginning of year Acadience (formerly DIBELS) scores in grades K-6 from 51% proficiency to 70% proficiency by the end of the year assessment. (These goals were determined during our School Improvement Plan planning meeting.)

We will improve in these academic areas by maintaining a paraprofessional for 4.5 hours per day, for a total of 22.5 hours per week. This individual will specialize in math and reading interventions for our at-risk students.

Describe how each SMART goal will be measured:

- (Goal #1) Our students' academic growth will be measured through the use of various assessment tools, including:

 RISE scale scores, DIBELS Acadience Reading assessments, progress monitoring, and iReady Reading Diagnostic Assessments.

 Measurements will be compared from the beginning of the year to the end of year to gauge academic progress.
- (**Goal #2**) Student behavior will continue to be tracked using Educator's Handbook. Furthermore, behavioral data will be discussed during quarterly BLT meetings to decipher if adjustments to our PBIS system will need to be adjusted to better meet our school's needs.
- (Goal #3) Funding for technology related tools will help the teachers at Escalante Valley School prepare the students with necessary 21st century skills, as well as tie into ICSD's Essential 8. Program licenses will additionally help teachers with the expectations of blended learning.
