**MISSION:** The Mission of the Upper School Vestry is to assist the chaplain in helping the students and staff of ESD glorify God, by planning, creating, serving, reading, and leading daily and seasonal worship services, in an environment that is rooted in the Episcopal faith, while being inclusive to all participants, and encouraging every person to "ignite a life of purpose through the development of an educated conscience".

**VESTRY ROLES**: You can select the role(s) you would like to play in Vestry for next year. Note that incoming Freshmen (9th grade) can only be Worship Team Members or Acolytes their first year. Also note that EVERY Vestry member will be part of a Daily Worship Team.

## **SERVICE ROLES FOR ALL VESTRY MEMBERS:**

- DAILY WORSHIP TEAMS: For 9-12 grade. All Vestry Members MUST serve on a Daily Worship Team. There are 7 worship teams (one for each day of the schedule rotation). On each day we have chapel, each team will be responsible for selecting students who will CREATE the slides for the day, CLICK the slides, READ the Scripture(s), and LEAD the prayers. In depth information on planning and putting together daily chapel can be found by watching <a href="ESD Chapel Worship Planning Video">ESD Chapel Planning Guide</a>.
- ACOLYTE CORPS: For 9-12 grade. Once a week (on average) we will celebrate Holy Eucharist on Wednesday in Chapel. Acolytes are needed to:

   (1) Vest prior to service in robes;
   (2) Prepare the cross, torches, banner, and Gospel book for service;
   (3) Process in during the Gathering Hymn;
   (4) Lead the Gospel procession in the middle of service;
   (5) Assist the priest in setting the Altar for Eucharist;
   (6) Help with distribution of Communion as Chalice bearers;
   (7) Recess out during the final hymn of Eucharist. In depth details on Acolytes duties can be found in: <a href="Instructions for Eucharistic Ministers and Acolytes">Instructions for Eucharistic Ministers and Acolytes</a>

## **LEADERSHIP ROLES FOR 10-12th GRADE:**

- VESTRY CO-CHAIR: For 12th grade. These Senior Leaders have executive responsibility over the vestry, including: (1) Helping the chaplain recruit, train, and retain Vestry members; (2) Helping the chaplain sort students into Vestry teams at the beginning of the year (including selecting the daily worship teams they themselves will serve on); (3) Calling Vestry meetings and taking meeting notes which will be sent out to all Vestry members; (4) Regularly checking in with Team leads and liaisons, helping them troubleshoot challenges, and communicating these with the chaplain; (5) Helping the chaplain select volunteers to pray at special events, including: Major home sporting events, award ceremonies, and special worship services.
  - NOTE: If you are applying for Vestry Co-Chair you will need at least TWO <u>recommendations</u> filled out and will interview with chaplains.
  - We currently have 4 specialized Co-Chair positions, which can be reconfigured based on need and interest:
    - Co-Chair for Acolytes: Manage Acolyte Leads and Teams
    - Co-Chair for Commitment and Contribution: Tracking points and ensuring everyone is contributing.
    - Co-Chair for Daily Worship: Manage Daily Worship Leads and Assistants.
    - Co-Chair for Special Teams: Manage leaders of special teams for Communications, LS, MS, and Music.
- ACOLYTE CO-LEADER: For 11-12th grade. Acolyte co-leaders will be selected to lead the Acolyte Corps. They will train Acolytes to serve, and will ensure that 5 Acolytes help with every Eucharist service: One cross bearer, two torch bearers, one Gospel book bearer, and one banner bearer. Each of these will also assist each week in communion: 4 to hold the chalice, and one to hold gluten free wafers.
  - NOTE: Application requires at least ONE <u>recommendation</u>.
- WORSHIP TEAM CO-LEADER: For 11-12 grade. A leader and co-leader
  will be selected for each Daily Worship Team (one team for each day of the
  daily schedule rotation). The senior and junior leaders will work together to
  make sure their team is organized for each day they lead worship, and that
  they have members who assist the chaplain in creating slides, clicking
  slides, reading scripture(s), and leading prayers.
  - NOTE: Application requires at least ONE <u>recommendation</u>.
- MUSIC TEAM: For Choir Members in 11-12th grade. They will recruit student and staff musical offerings (singing and/or instruments) and coordinate with Choir Director and Chaplain in scheduling them; Gather

music/hymn requests from students and staff and communicate them with Choir Director and Chaplain; Help find musical coverage of music for times when Choir Director is out. Contact Joe Snyder <a href="mailto:snyderj@esdallas.org">snyderj@esdallas.org</a>

- NOTE: Application requires at least ONE recommendation.
- COMMUNICATIONS TEAM: For 10-12th grade. Liaisons will work with ESD's Communications and Journalism Staff to try to get one item each week (picture, video, quote) into our social media, or other ESD news outlets, to represent our worship as an Upper School. You will be in regular contact with ESD Social Media and Content managers, and communicate any special events or speakers to them.   - NOTE: Application requires at least ONE recommendation.
- MIDDLE SCHOOL GUILD: For 10-12th grade. MS Guild Members will work with ESD's Middle School chaplain to help in any way that fits the guild members gifts and talents, as well as the needs of Middle School, whether in speaking, or assisting, or another form of service. Toward the end of the year, they will come to the Middle School chapel to tell rising 9th graders about Vestry, and how they can be involved when they get into high school. - RENAME the Copied Slide Deck with the format "Year.Month.Day Title" (for example: "2025.08.10 Chapel BCP Rite 2")
- MOVE THE SLIDE DECK to the Worship Archive folder inside the Chapel Planning folder.
- ADD Readings and Hymns and Presenters to your new slide deck. This
  material is found in our <u>ESD Chapel Planning Sheet</u>, and you will be able to
  cut and paste it from the <u>Slide Prep Document</u>.
  - HYMNS can be copied and pasted from their slide decks in <u>Hymns</u>, <u>Songs</u>, and <u>Lyrics</u>.
  - READINGS will usually be in the <u>Slide Prep Document</u>, but if not, you can cut and paste from <u>biblegateway.com</u>.
  - SPECIAL WEEKLY SLIDES will be added from our <u>Special Weekly</u> <u>Chapel Prayers</u>: MON - Birthdays. TUE - Virtue of the Month. THU -Lower School Prayer. FRI - ESD Prayer.
  - ANNOUNCEMENTS can be found in <u>US Announcement Slides</u>.
  - EUCHARIST slides are a little different. There will be 2 readings and 3 hymns. You will COPY a special deck from the <u>Eucharist</u> <u>Communion Slides</u>.
- **SERVE** in Chapel by sitting with your Team in Choir. We will need at least 1 clicker, 1 Scripture Reader, and 1 Prayer Leader. If the readings are long, feel free to split into two readers.

## Welcome to Vestry 2025-2026

Greetings everyone,

I wanted to welcome you all back to school, and thank you for joining vestry this year! As one of the most active and most visible clubs in the school, I look forward to an incredible year of exploring our purpose and expanding our vision in chapel this year.

**WHAT WE'VE DONE:** To get a sense of what we did last year, and what we will do this year, here are some links and stats:

- Last year we implemented a new attendance and point system to ensure better Vestry involvement
- We created and led nearly 200 chapel services (which can be seen on <u>last</u> <u>year's planning sheet</u>)
- We facilitated over 50 student chapel talks, including Senior Advisory talks.
   Additionally 32 US students presented in MS Chapel.
- We organized over 80 students into 7 worship teams and several acolyte teams while <u>tracking points for them all.</u>
- We performed more communications and organizational planning than any other student organization at ESD.

 We received <u>great feedback and ideas</u> from applicants for this year (take time to <u>read it</u>: It is really great feedback!).
