Red Friday Folder

Inside your child's red Friday folder, you'll find the work they've completed throughout the week, along with their sight word (fight word) books. We're excited to share that most students are currently in the approaching or proficient range with their sight words! We believe this progress is a direct result of the consistent sight word practice happening at home—thank you! Please continue to read and cycle through the sight word books regularly to keep your child progressing.

Progress Reports

This week, you'll also find your child's progress report. The report shows the proficient standard expectations for the end of Trimester 3 (May). Areas shown as "below expectations" reflect your child's current progress in those academic domains. If there is a check mark or teacher notes in any section, we kindly ask that you provide additional support at home in that area.

The highlighted fluency section indicates your child's current reading level. To keep up their momentum, please have them read books at this level at home. On the back of the progress report, you'll find an attached ESGI report which breaks down which specific items your child got correct or incorrect—this can be a great tool to guide your practice sessions at home.
