The Dixie Recall Election Amendment

WHEREAS the representatives of Dixie sometimes do things that go against the interests of their representatives.

WHEREAS the people of Dixie need a mechanism for enforcing their will upon their representatives.

WHEREAS there is no such method currently in Dixie.

BE it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Dixie:

ARTICLE IV: SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS

NEW SECTION 8:

"SECTION 8. The Recall Election and It's Requirements. --

- (a) If ten percent of the registered voting population and their signatures are secured in a specific voting district, a recall election will occur within the next three months for Legislatures and Federal representatives.
- (b) If fifteen percent of the registered voting population and their signatures are secured in a specific voting district, a recall election will occur within the next three months for the Governor of Dixie and for either Federal senator.
- (c) In the recall election, in order to be successfully recalled, the representative must receive less than the absolute majority. If, in the first round, no single individual receives a majority, the candidates receiving the two highest amount of votes will be able to go into a second round of voting.
- (d) If the recall election is successful, the elected official is removed from office, and their opponent will be elected to fill the vacant seat.
- (e) This amendment will go into effect on January 1st, 2021
