

Reading Day (Special Schedule)

Grade 9 Attendance

Only Grade 9 students are required to attend and attendance is taken normally.

Grades 10, 11, and 12 Attendance

All other students may attend optionally and arrive at any time. However, students who leave before 2:45 p.m. are not permitted to return to campus that day.

Attendance is not taken for students in Grades 10-12, and parents do not need to communicate if students in Grades 10-12 are arriving late/leaving early.

Notes:

- ***Period 5 Lunch Shifts:**
 - **1st Lunch: Free/LC, 9th-Grade Seminar, English, History, Innovation**
 - **2nd Lunch: Fine Arts, Science, Languages, Math**
 - Grade 10, 11, and 12 students who wish to eat the school lunch should follow the lunch shifts published above. Even if they are not attending any classes per se, they should go to lunch based on their Period 5 class.
- All classes meet in the order published above for 45 minutes each.
- **9th Graders are required to attend and follow the schedule** as published.
- Grades 10, 11 and 12 students do not have to follow the schedule but should remain aware that their teachers may have 9th-grade classes to manage at particular points in the schedule. If you drop by your teacher's room, that's okay, but realize you will not be the priority during a period where the teacher has a freshman class. You'll have to wait for down time moments to speak to your teacher then.
