

ELALT 8 Poster Guidelines

The poster session at ELALT 8 provides undergraduate students with an opportunity to present their research and receive feedback from faculty members, researchers, and fellow students.

The date and time of the poster session will be announced on the conference website: <https://sites.google.com/ff.uns.ac.rs/elalt8>

Please note that online participation is not available for the poster session.

To apply, students must submit an abstract in accordance with the abstract submission guidelines available on the conference website. When submitting their abstract via email, applicants should clearly indicate that they are applying for the poster session.

General requirements:

- Posters must present original research conducted by the author(s).
- Posters should be written in English.
- The recommended poster size is A1 (594 × 841 mm), portrait orientation.
- Posters should include:
 - o title;
 - o author(s) and institutional affiliation;
 - o introduction and research background;
 - o research questions or objectives;
 - o methodology;
 - o results;
 - o discussion and conclusions; and
 - o references.
- Visual elements such as figures, tables, diagrams and photographs are encouraged where appropriate.
- Text should be concise, readable from approximately one to two meters away, and supported by clear visual organization.

Authors are expected to:

- bring a printed copy of their poster and display it before the session begins;
- remain at their poster throughout the assigned presentation period; and
- give a brief presentation of their work and engage in discussion with attendees.

Authors are welcome to use the poster template available on the conference website, although its use is not mandatory.
